REMARKS BY RON MACHOS

Good morning, Ladies and Gentleman. A question often asked during a political campaign is: Are you better off now that you were eight years ago?

Am I and my family better off today than before the Clinton-Gore Administration? I'll let you be the judge of that. Before Bill Clinton, we had no health insurance.
