VAWA GRANTS FACT SHEET

The Violence Against Women Office (VAWO) in the Office of Justice Programs (OJP) at the Department of Justice administers one formula and five discretionary grant programs authorized by the Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) and the Higher Education Amendments Act. The grant programs are designed to help prevent and stop violence against women, including domestic violence, sexual assault, and stalking.

S•T•O•P Violence Against Women Formula Grants Program

The S•T•O•P (Services, Training, Officers and Prosecutors) Violence Against Women Formula Grants are awarded to states to develop and strengthen the criminal justice system's response to violence against women and to support and enhance services for victims. Each state and territory must allocate 25 percent of the grant funds to law enforcement, 25 percent to prosecution, and 25 percent to victim services. The remaining 25 percent are discretionary within the parameters of the Act.

Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies

The Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies are designed to encourage state, local, and tribal governments to treat domestic violence as a serious violation of criminal law requiring the coordinated involvement of the entire criminal justice system. Grant funds may be used for implementing mandatory or pro-arrest programs and policies; developing policies and training in criminal justice agencies to improve tracking of domestic violence cases; and creating centralized domestic violence units consisting of police, prosecution, or other criminal justice agencies.

Rural Domestic Violence and Child Victimization Enforcement Grants

The Rural Domestic Violence and Child Victimization Enforcement Grants are designed to enhance services available to rural women and children by encouraging community involvement in developing a coordinated response to domestic violence and child abuse. A state is considered rural if it has a population of 52 or fewer persons per square mile or the largest county has less than 150,000 people. In rural states, eligible applicants are state and local governments and public and private entities. Non-rural states may apply on behalf of rural jurisdictions in their states. Eligible applicants also include tribal governments in rural and non-rural states.

S•T•O•P Violence Against Indian Women Discretionary Grants Program

The S•T•O•P Violence Against Indian Women Grants are intended to develop and strengthen tribal law enforcement and prosecution efforts to combat violence against Native women and to develop and enhance services for victims of such crimes.

Domestic Violence Victims' Civil Legal Assistance Grant Program

The Civil Legal Assistance Grants are designed to strengthen civil legal assistance programs for victims of domestic violence. Eligible applicants include victim services programs, law school legal clinics and other legal services organizations that assist battered women, and other entities involved in addressing domestic violence.

Grants to Combat Violent Crimes Against Women on Campuses

The Campus Program is designed to strengthen the higher education community's response to sexual assault, stalking, and domestic violence crimes on campuses, and to enhance collaboration between campuses and local criminal justice and victim advocacy organizations. Eligible applicants are institutions of higher education.

STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grants

STOP funds are awarded to states to develop and strengthen the criminal justice system's response to domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking and to enhance services for victims. The state agencies which receive the STOP funds must award 25 percent to law enforcement, 25 percent to prosecution and 25 percent to victim services' programs. The remaining 25 percent of the funding may be allocated at the state's discretion for other STOP program purposes. Victim advocates now work hand-in-hand with community police officers, prosecutors and others to prevent and respond to violence against women.

Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies

The Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies Program fosters collaboration among law enforcement officers, prosecutors, judges and victim advocates to investigate and prosecute domestic violence as a serious criminal offense.

These funds must be used to implement policies that encourage or mandate the arrest of batterers and enforce protection orders. Funds can also be used to combat stalking, provide for the education of judges and others about domestic violence, develop systems to track domestic violence cases and strengthen services for domestic violence victims.

States are also using the funds to train state and local police, prosecutors, judges, and victim advocates so victims know that protection orders can be used in another state. Before enactment of the full faith and credit provision, victims with protection orders in one state could not use that order if the victim went to work, traveled to, or moved to most other states. Now states must honor other states' protection orders. Funds are also being used to improve and establish state-wide protection order registries.

Santa Fe County has used these funds to develop and implement a judicial oversight program to enhance offender accountability. They have also used the funds to develop an integrated network of service providers and criminal justice system agencies responding to domestic violence and stalking. This cooperation has improved the tracking of domestic violence cases and enforcement of protection orders. The County is also working with law enforcement agencies, the courts, and victim service providers to assist stalking victims. Santa Fe County has also developed policies and procedures to address the problem of police officers who are domestic violence perpetrators.
