Dear President Clinton:

We are writing to invite you to participate in City Year's national convention, *cyzygy 2000*, which will be held from May 30th to June 3rd, 2000 at San Jose State University in California. We would also like to thank you for attending our national convention for the past 2 years – your presence, leadership and vision in these conventions has been the highlight of our 10 years of work. In particular, we deeply appreciated that you mentioned in your speech at *cyzygy '99* that “when [you] saw City Year [you] knew that [you] had found the concrete, living, breathing embodiment of what [you] thought politics ought to be about” – your words were a tremendous honor that we strive daily to live up to.
