Sen Patrick Leahy, Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Foreign Operations Subcommittee, has requested a face-to-face meeting with the President to discuss Russian Aid legislation. Since the funding package relies almost entirely on FY 93 Budget Authority, this legislation must be passed by the Senate, conferenced with the House and signed by September 30. Leahy is the key to getting this legislation through the Senate quickly. Therefore, its essential that we schedule a meeting as soon as the President returns from vacation so that Leahy will be ready to move when the Senate returns from August recess.
