Telephone Call to Senator Daniel Inouye on Russian Aid

CHRON FILEPurpose

To discuss funding for the Russian Aid Package.

Background

During your meeting with Senator Patrick Leahy on Tuesday, September 7, you agreed to call Senator Daniel Inouye to ask his assistance in resolving one of the obstacles to funding the Russian Aid Package in the Senate. Suggested talking points are attached.

That you call Senator Daniel Inouye and ask his assistance on the Russian Aid request.

POINTS TO BE MADE FOR CALL TO
SENATOR DANIEL INOUE

- I am calling to discuss the Foreign Operations Appropriations bill and the aid package for Russia and the other new independent states.
- I know you are supportive of that package. I understand you face severe funding problems in the Defense subcommittee. I have asked OMB Director Panetta to do all he can to assist you in finding some relief from the difficulties you face.
- Unfortunately, we will not be able to resolve these issues before the Russian aid package is ready to move to markup.
- What I can do today is to give you a commitment that we will not come to the Defense Department to bail us out of funding shortfalls for initiatives not related to national security.
- I am asking everyone involved in this process to play their part to make this effort work. I will be asking the Budget Chairs to help with the Defense Department's scoring problems. I will be asking for help from various Senators to solve some problems related to Israel's loan guarantees.
- Now I need your help as well. I would very much appreciate it if you would let Senator Leahy and Senator Byrd know that you are prepared to let your funds be marked up this week in the assistance package for Russia.

SUBJECT: PRESIDENTIAL CALL TO SENATOR DANIEL INOUE

During his meeting with Sen. Patrick Leahy on Sept. 7, The President agreed to call Sen. Daniel Inouye to ask for his assistance in helping to clear one of the major obstacles to funding our Russian Aid request. Although the aid package relies heavily on using last year's budget authority, it has a \$200 million impact on this year's already stretched DOD budget. A call from the President would underscore the importance he places on Russian aid and assure Inouye that we will not keep coming to the Defense budget to fund initiatives not related to Defense.
