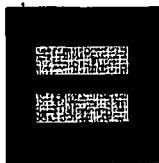

Although I intended for you to receive this copy of a letter to Attorney Janet Reno via the mail in late May, it has come to my attention that some of you may have not received the letter. Therefore, I wanted to ensure that you did receive the copy by resending via facsimile.

As you are aware, violent hate crimes committed against gay and lesbian Americans occur all too frequently. The FBI consistently reports, through the Hate Crimes Statistics Act, that bias crimes based on sexual orientation are the third-highest reported crime. Yet "sexual orientation" is the only category authorized under the Hate Crimes Statistics Act that is currently not covered under 18 U.S.C. 245.

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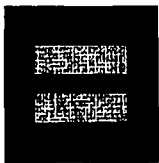
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
