Requesting Presidential Proclamation
Commemorating the 100th Day of the Death of
Emperor Bao Dai

NSC/Asia has informed Representative Sanchez' office by telephone that we cannot agree to send the requested presidential proclamation. Many Vietnamese expatriate groups, which support the Vietnamese monarchy, are not reconciled to the unification of Vietnam as the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (SRV). We have diplomatic relations with the SRV and are committed to a policy of normalizing our ties with Vietnam. We, therefore, do not recommend sending a presidential proclamation to a group that might be opposed to our current policy or might use it to make political points undermining that policy.

The VCHG has contacted my office to request a presidential proclamation from the United States government commemorating the 100th day of the death of the Emperor Bao Dai. Emperor Bao Dai was the last emperor of Vietnam, who passed away on July 31, 1997, in Paris, France, at the age of 84.

As an enthusiastic reformer, Emperor Dai was a pioneer in building independence, improving international diplomacy and industrializing the nation of Vietnam. I would appreciate it if you would consider issuing a Presidential proclamation on his behalf.
