WORKING GROUP TO SUPPORT POST-BERLIN
ANALYSIS AND ASSESSMENT

Recent conversations with people from a number of agencies have indicated considerable support for a technical group that could provide advice and support to the US analytical and assessment efforts under the Berlin Mandate. We would therefore like to invite you to an initial organizational meeting of such a group. We have scheduled the meeting for 2.00-4.00 this Friday, August 4, in the Jackson Room of the White House Conference Center.

In broad terms, we see this group as serving three purposes: (1) working with US representatives to the international analysis/assessment process to help refine the analytical issues and questions that emerge as the US engages in the process; (2) identifying and coordinating analytical resources as the US develops its own analyses/assessments and participates in corresponding international efforts; and (3) providing quality control for US submissions, and technical review of submissions by other participants. In light of the fact that the first international organizational meeting for the analytical/assessment process will occur in just a couple of weeks, and the target date for wrapping up the process is mid-1996, it seems important that we meet soon in order to develop a more detailed understanding of how our technical efforts can best be organized and to initiate some thought and discussion in support of US ideas on the content of the process.
