SUBJECT: Meeting June 30

There will be a meeting of the IAT at 9:30 in Room 324 of the OEOB on Wednesday June 30. The topics will be further attention to baselines, initial screening of options, translating option descriptions into IDEAS modeling framework, and next steps.

- 1) Baseline issues:
 - a) Richard Howarth and Lee Shipper from LBL will be in town on June 30, and will give a brief presentation on industrial energy efficiency trends which may help us interpret the IDEAS baseline and may have some implications for the analysis of industrial energy demand policy options.
 - b) We must reach closure on other baseline issues -- emissions of CO₂ from transportation, baseline emissions for other greenhouse gases, and the estimation of the impact of voluntary efficiency improvements in the baseline.
- 2) The working groups will perform an initial triage of options -- non-starters, no-brainers, and tough choices. *This is merely a straw proposal that will help benchmark our deliberations* -- we can revisit all of the initial rankings, and consider additional options as they arise. However, we need to examine the list of likely options in order to determine whether or how these might be incorporated into the IDEAS modeling framework. This will test our ability to model options, turn around analysis, and interpret results.
- 3) We should begin to model the list of "no-brainers" from the working group chairs and OEP. This exercise will test our ability to take input from the working groups and help us identify areas for improving the flow of information. In the probable event that these options do not achieve the President's goal, we will get additional options from the "tough choices" list to integrate into policy packages.
- 4) Additional steps: the IAT should begin to consider cross-cutting policy options that do not fit into particular working groups (e.g. emission caps, taxes, emissions reporting).
