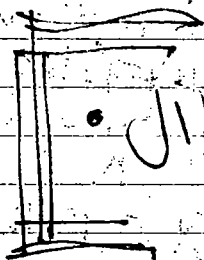

ARKids. After careful consideration of policy & its implications, HHS has concluded that it should deny gov H 1a to allow parents the option to choose ~~by passing~~ to not enroll in the trad MC prog & instead enroll in less generous, more costly ARKids plan. They have made this decision b/c:
