time in prog hist, overall
spending declined by 1%, from
200x to 2004 billion-dollar.
After sig increased in MC
exp during the early 90s the
report is sig. not only 5%
it shows that prog spending
appears to be under control
but b/c the result of these
dec. will have a sig. impact
on the health of the MC
trust fund. We will not
know for certain how long
this report will extend the
life of the trust fund until

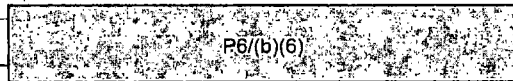

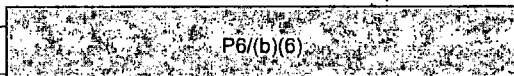

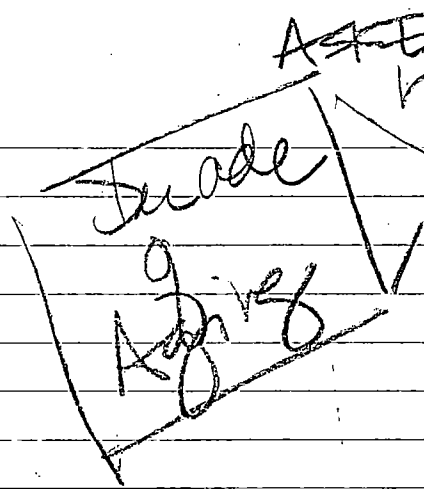
