Re: Transitions and Open Matters

Date: December 22, 1994 revised January 5, 1995

This memorandum should be read in conjunction with my November 23rd memo on the DPC and Disability Policy which outlines ongoing projects and the work that someone here needs to pickup.

This is a followup to the meeting on January 5th where Jeremy and I orally briefed Diana and Lynn.

1. National Disability Policy Review (NDPR)

See notebook on desk and tray for background materials.
Contact Ruth Katz 690-5746 at HHS re outcome of Childhood Disability subgroup meeting on Jan. 4th.
Contact Bob Williams on status of his redraft of Guiding Principles. File on surface topic on "Guiding Principles".

2. Federal Disability Accommodations Working Group

See notebook on desk, tray, and four large accordion files (bottom left file cabinet).
Contact Deval Patrick re folding in this group into the Accommodations Group of the NDPR.

3. Appointees with Disabilities Group

See multiple files labeled "Disability Appointees Group" for names, addresses, past agendas, etc. (top left file cabinet).

This group meets every 6 weeks or so and is about due for another meeting. Last one was held on November 8th.

4. ADA Alert and Preservation

Bobbie Silverstein has requested a meeting with Carol (or a phone call) to develop better lines of communication with the affected Federal agencies should the ADA come under Congressional siege.

Mixed signals from the Hill on the likelihood of such a rollback on ADA. Alex Vachon, Sen. Dole's disability staffer, reassured a visiting delegation that they had no plans to alter ADA. The Speaker, however, has toyed with the idea of turning

back such nondiscrimination matters to the states in an interview with George Wills. Constituency groups are very anxious. National Council on Disability is now focusing on continued need for the ADA in outreach forums.

5. PCMR Executive Orders

PCMR is seeking any comments on a proposed executive order on their mission. I received this on Dec. 19th. Any comments are due them by Jan. 20th. I may offer some after I leave here as one of their so-called "PCMR Associates." If anyone here wants to weigh in, see file on surface top and/or fax PCMR at 205-9519.

6. Hamp's article

ASHA has accepted it; Carol needs to provide them with a photo of Hamp for the cover. See file on surface top.

7. Sandy Turner

This is a semi-closed matter involving a friend of the First Family seeking links as a newly disabled person to the disability rights movement, etc. I successfully introduced her to the head of the Arkansas P & A program, and for now she seems quite satisfied. You can close the file if she makes no further contact here in 6 months.

8. Ginny Heiple correspondence

There is a file on the surface top that probably can be closed since I wrote her on december 9th and heard nothing further.

9. Speaking engagement with the American Foundation for the Blind

This group would be fine to schedule. Last month I passed on some information on the desirability of speaking to this group. I don't know whether or not Carol accepted or will need talking points at some point.

10. "Mothers of Invention" Reunion-- Mattell Foundation

This project is in limbo. Mattell Foundation representative did not return my phone calls after an initial interest in co-sponsoring a meeting between Carol and the mothers of other children with disabilities featured in US NEWS & World Report. I'm not sure if its still worth pursuing. File on surface top.

11. Over-the-Road Buses

ADA issue to follow. No intervention appropriate from here. See

file on top.

12. Childhood Disability Commission

Potentially very sensitive; waiting for names to be announced from HHS. See file on top. Jeremy can also brief you on the backlog/reengineering issue at SSA in general.

13. FYIs from Carol

See file on top so labeled re matters from Carol.
Good background material

14. Key papers

See tray marked "Priorities" for the key papers you requested, including my comprehensive memo on the Status of the ADA, and various statements by the President on disability policy.
