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THREATENED SUICIDE

If a person is in immediate danger:

1. Notify Principal/designee
2. Principal/designee should assign someone to call 911 to apprise of situation
ASK THAT POLICE OR EMERGENCY RESPONSE BE MADE WITHOUT SIRENS
3. Talk calmly with the person until appropriate personnel arrive
Remember...
 - Be Positive
 - Engage the person in conversation
 - Do Not** become confrontational
 - Do Not** make fast movements toward the individual
4. When trained personnel arrive, defer to their judgement on the course of action to be taken
5. Advise district administration of the situation and the actions being taken
6. Principal/designee will be responsible for a written account of the event

If the person is not in immediate danger but has expressed the thought of suicide:

1. Escort person to trained school counselor/psychologist or have counselor/psychologist come to escort person to their office for appropriate intervention
2. Notify principal/designee of the situation and actions taken
3. Principal/designee will assure that the situation will be documented
