Poverty levels for the Kentucky schools with the 20 highest Content Indexes in Reading on the 1999 4th Grade Kentucky Core Content Test.

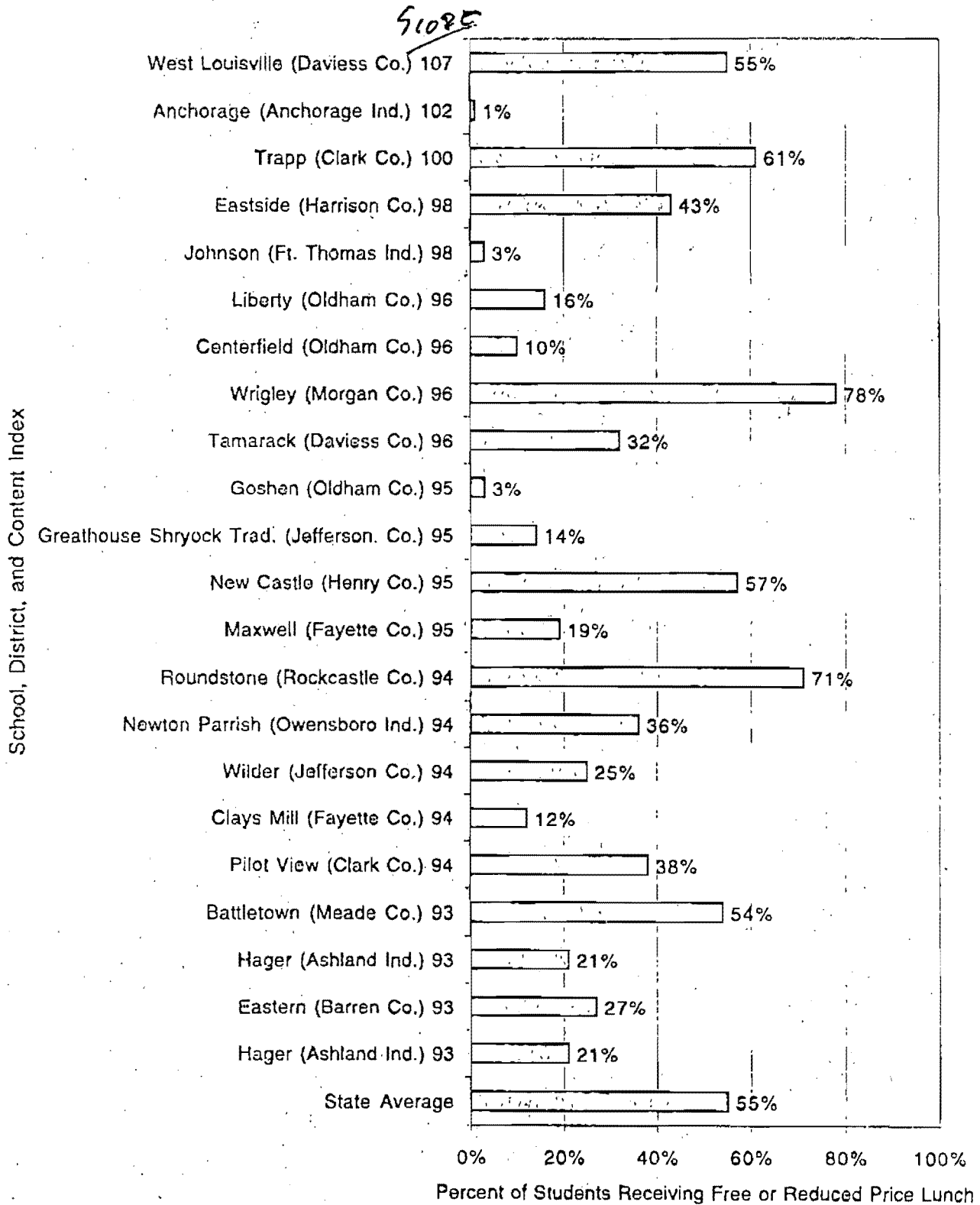


Chart 2.2**Who Excels in Elementary Mathematics?**

Poverty levels for the Kentucky schools with the 20 highest Content Indexes in Mathematics on the 1999 5th Grade Kentucky Core Content Test.

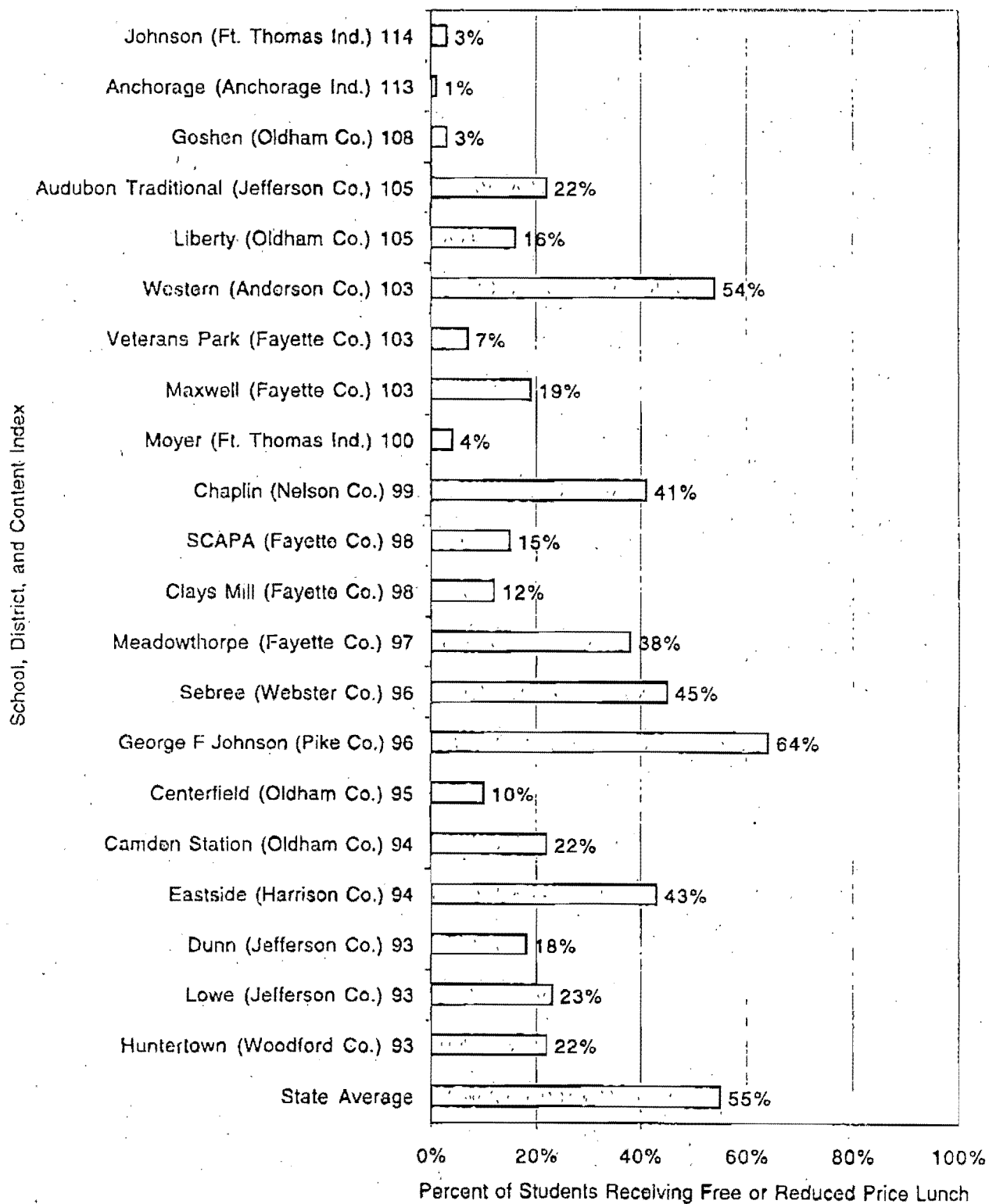

Poverty levels for the Kentucky schools with the 20 highest Content Indexes in Science on the 1999 4th Grade Kentucky Core Content Test.

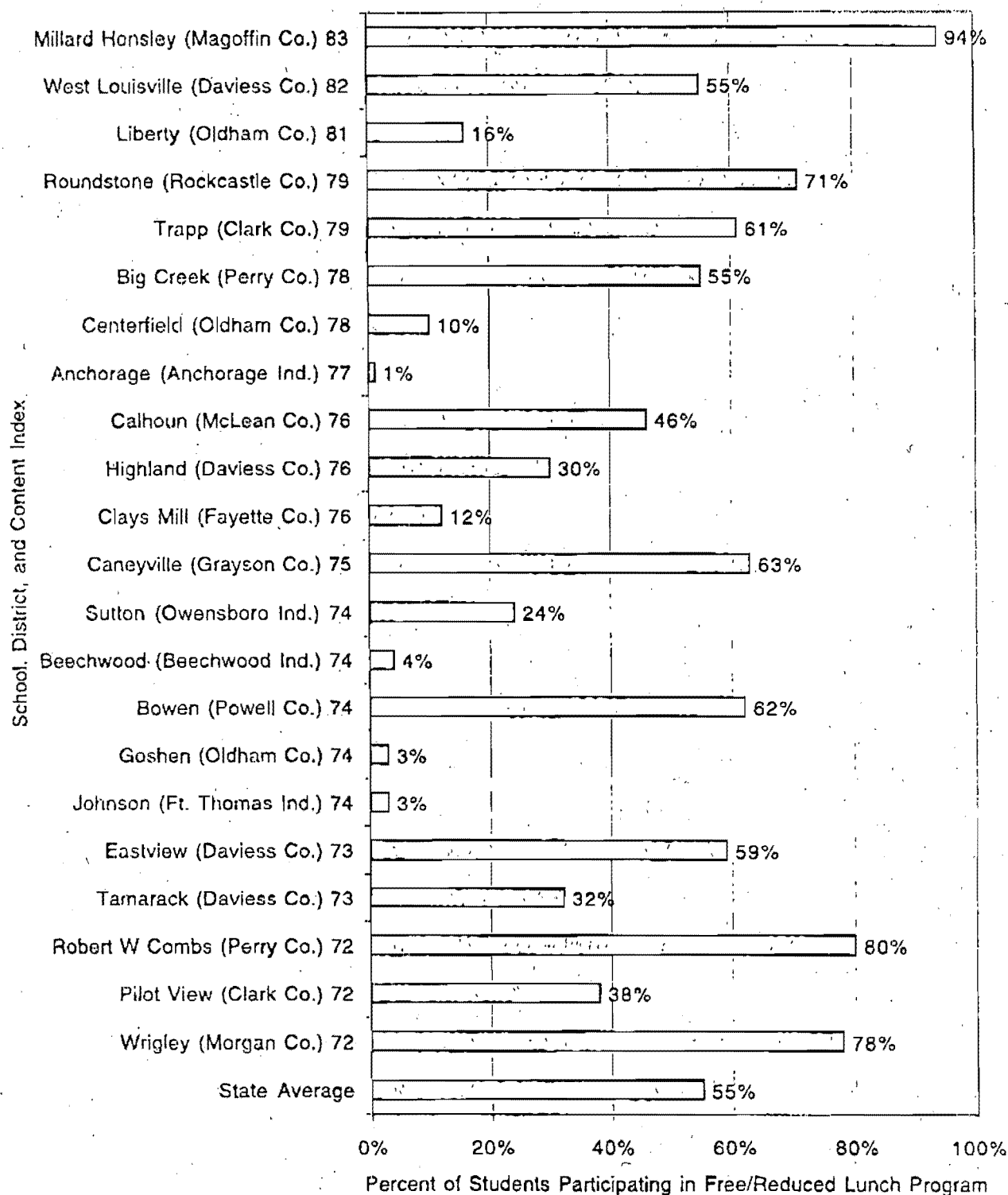

Poverty levels for the Kentucky schools with the 20 highest Content Indexes in Social Studies on the 1999 5th Grade Kentucky Core Content Test.

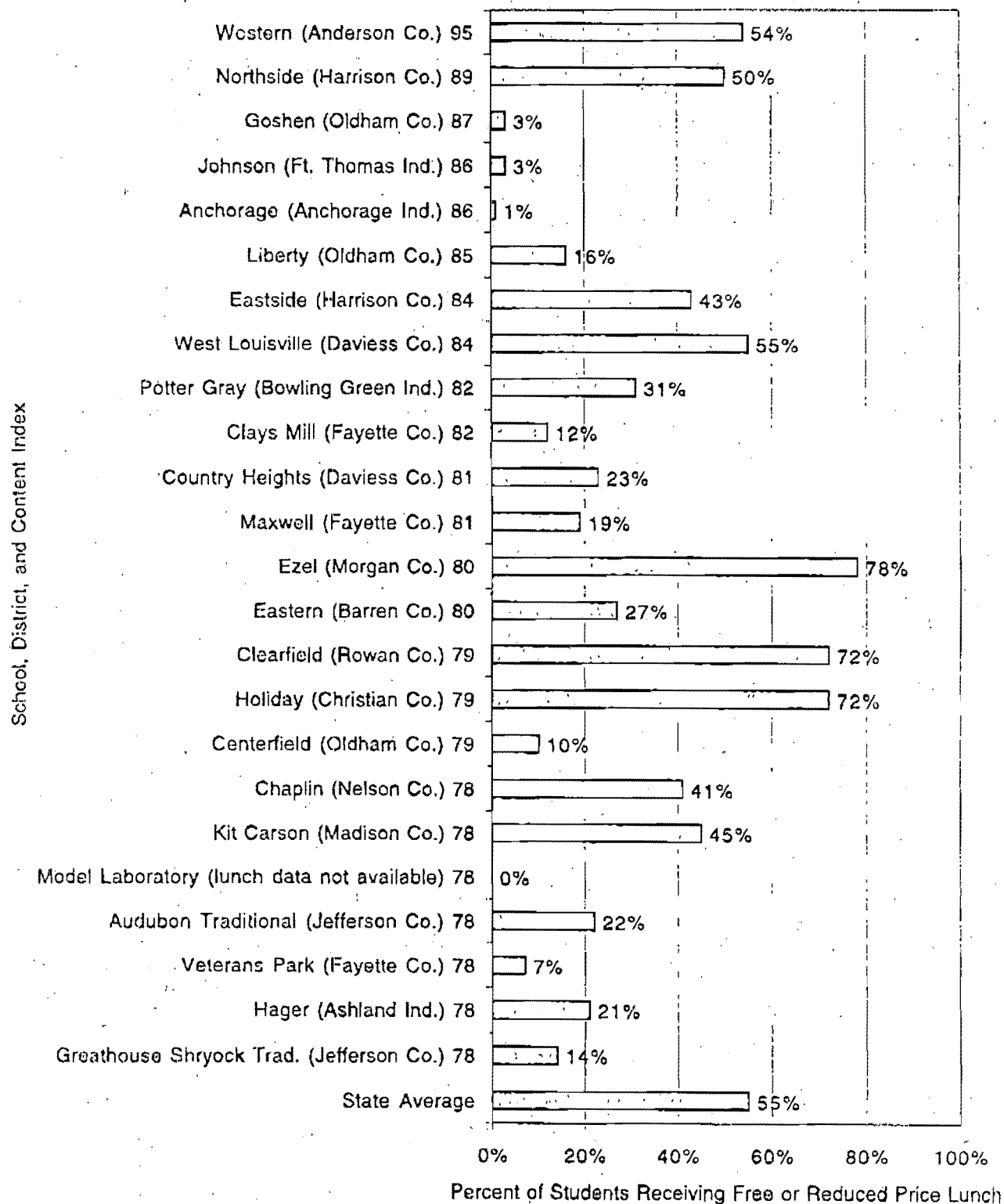

Poverty levels for the Kentucky schools with the 20 highest Content Indexes in Writing on the 1999 4th Grade Kentucky Core Content Test.

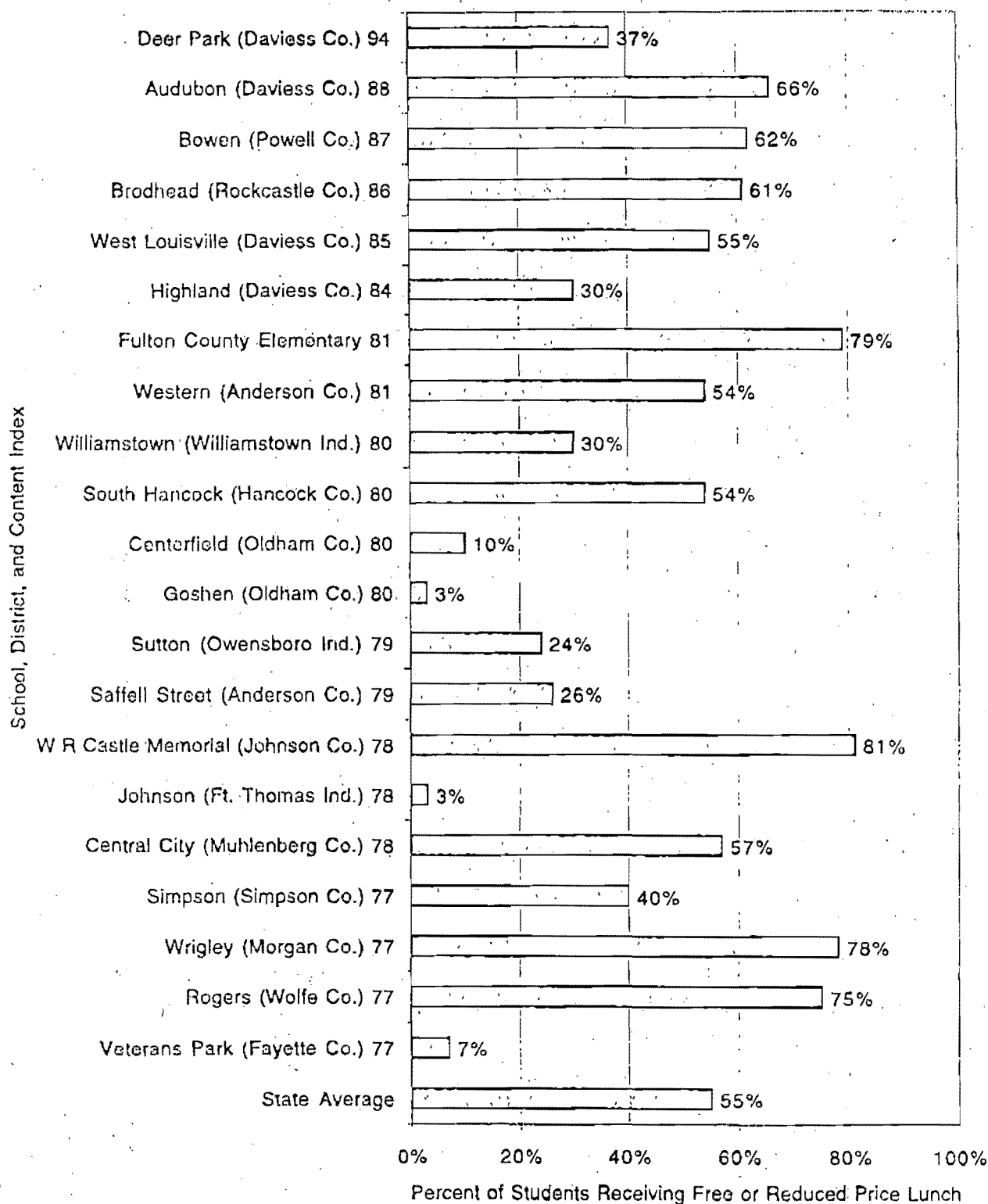


Chart 2.6**Who Excels in Elementary Arts & Humanities?**

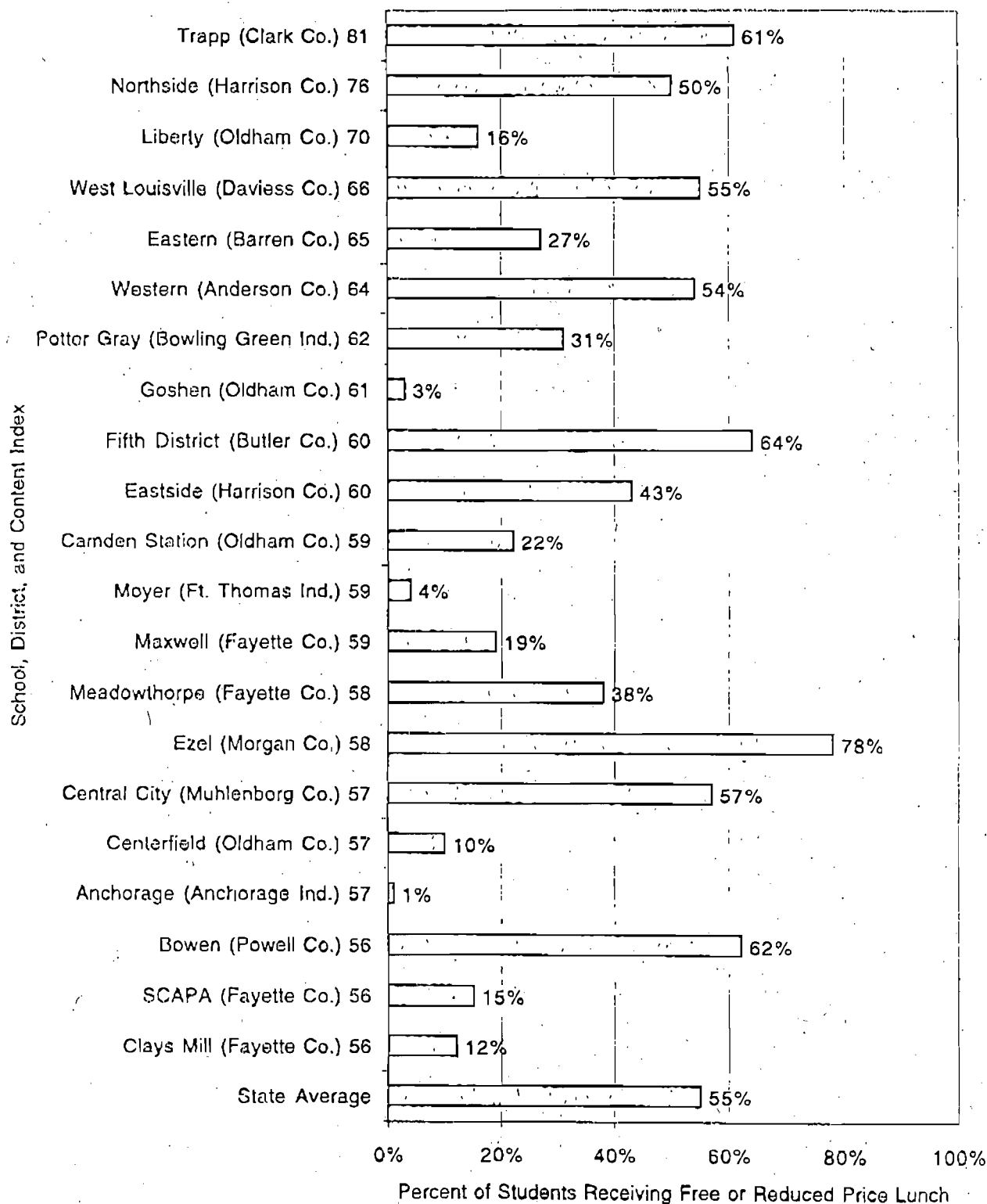
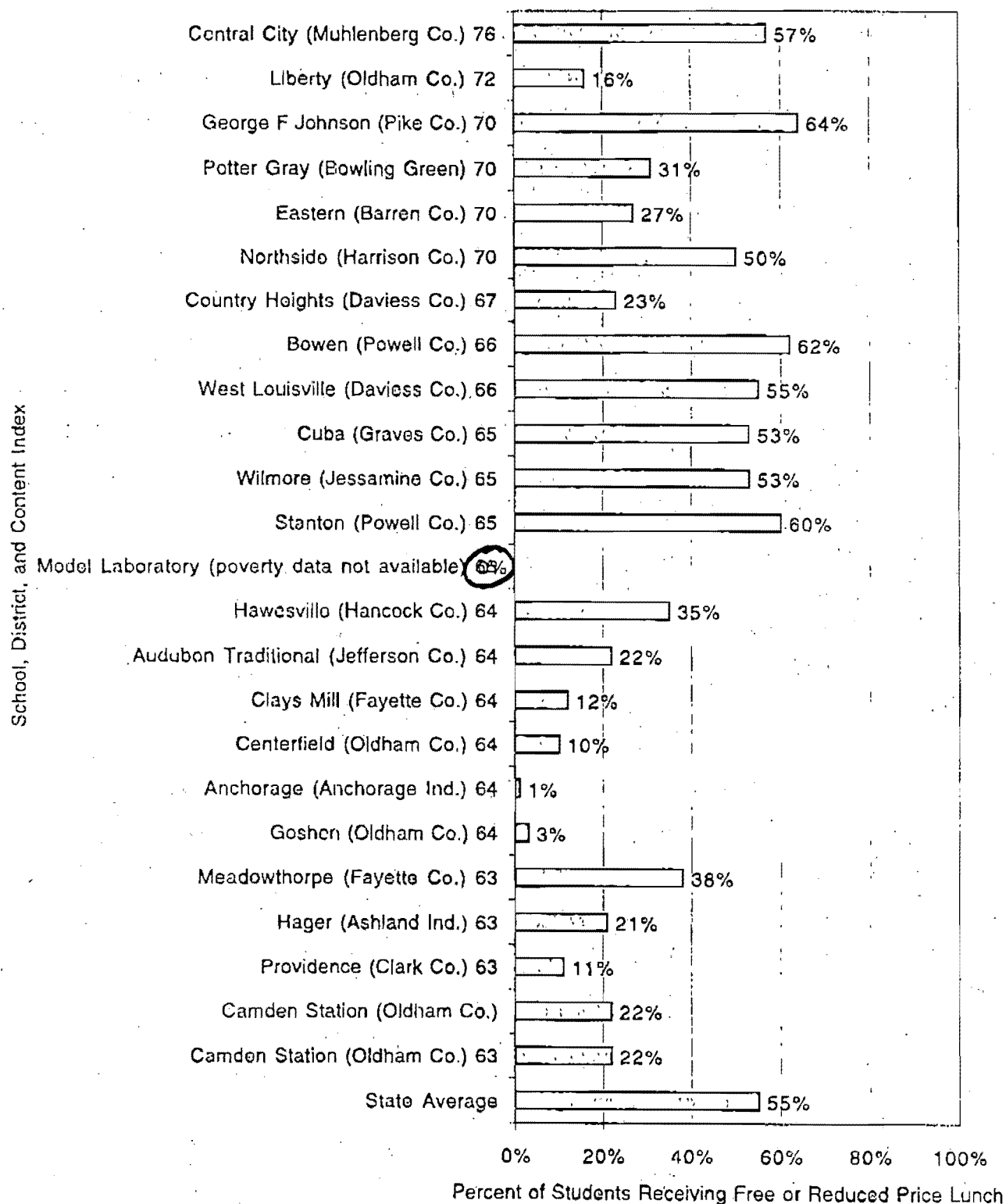


Chart 2.7**Who Excels in Elementary Practical/Vocational?**
