Dear Lisa:

First off, we all want to thank you and Mrs. Clinton so much for coming to Redbook with this piece, which is warm and inspiring and full of insight and humor. Indeed, Ellen Levine, the editor in chief, asked that you tell Mrs. Clinton that reading her piece yesterday really helped her keep perspective during what was an otherwise not very good day. So, our personal thanks as well.

We do have some questions, places where we feel the piece is crying out for specific examples, where it needs to show more than tell. A number of key points are only alluded to, and much of the action remains off-stage. Bringing these to life a bit more will make the evolution of their relationship that much more vivid. I've written these right on the page, and while it looks like a lot, many of them hit on the same themes: characterizing more fully why Mrs. Kelly seemed not to like Hillary Rodham in the beginning, characterizing in more detail what was so chilly about their early meetings. We're not looking to add pages of length to this; a number of well-placed clarifications and amplifications throughout, sentences or paragraphs at most, should do the trick.

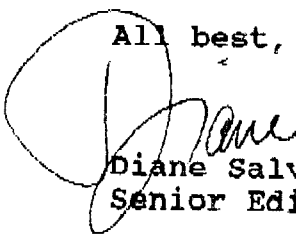
We are committed to getting this into the July issue, (which will also keep us clear of any timing conflict with S&S) so the clock is now ticking very loudly. It would be wonderful if we could have these additions by the end of this week (4/8). Is that within the realm of possibility?

That also brings us to the photos. We'd love to have a selection--with an eye toward ultimately running perhaps 4 or 5. Is there a photo with Mrs. Kelly from the very early days, before Mrs. Clinton was married? Is there a wedding photo? Is there a photo of Mrs. Kelly with Mrs. Clinton holding Chelsea as a newborn? Our aim is to try to match the chronology of their growing bond in photos, as the piece does in words. Again, you have my word that we'll handle the photos with the utmost care and return them--each and every one--as soon as they are back from the printer.

Please give me a call when you've had a chance to read this and let me know if there are any problems or questions, and how you think we'll fare with our deadline situation. I so appreciated your keeping me updated all last week and this weekend. We're so much better able to cope--especially down to the wire like this--if we know what to anticipate.

Again, we're so pleased and honored to be able to have this piece by Mrs. Clinton. We feel sure readers will warm to its timeless message.

Dear Lisa:

Let me say again how delighted we are that Mrs. Clinton will be writing a piece about Virginia Kelly exclusively for Redbook. We agree that it's a perfect match.

We know our readers will be very interested in the First Lady's observations and insights about Mrs. Kelly as a grandmother, a mother in law, and a mother, along these lines:

What kind of relationship does Mrs. Clinton feel Chelsea had with her grandmother? What was the quality and texture of their relationship? In what ways was it formative for Chelsea? Did she come to see her father in a different light through her relationship with her grandmother?

Mother and daughter in law relationships can be tense, at least at times. Were there ever emotional struggles between Mrs. Kelly and Mrs. Clinton? Did Mrs. Clinton address her mother in law as "mom" or by first name? What did Mrs. Kelly think of the increasingly public role Mrs. Clinton played? Was Mrs. Kelly a particular source of strength during difficult times in the Clinton's lives? What did Mrs. Clinton learn about the president, as a man, from the relationship he had with his mother? What did she learn about parenting?

Finally, what lessons does Mrs. Clinton take away from Mrs. Kelly's brave struggle with cancer? In what ways did she enrich Mrs. Clinton's understanding of life? How profoundly different will her and Mr. Clinton's lives be now that Mrs. Kelly is gone?

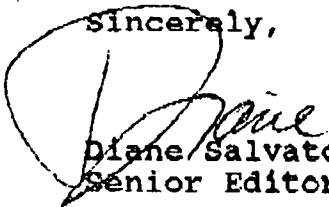
As I mentioned, our feeling is that Mrs. Clinton should write the piece at whatever length she feels she needs to cover the points she wants to cover. We'll be glad to work with her in the editing process if space becomes a concern.

At this point, the plan is to have the piece by mid-March, to make July publication possible.

We'd be delighted if some candid family photos could accompany the piece. They will go a long way to help make it warm, intimate and personal.

Thanks so much for thinking of us, and we very much look forward to piece.
