MOUNTAIN LION

(*Felis concolor*)

The Mountain Lion is the largest of North American cats, and is known for its tawny to grayish pelage, and lengthy (30 – 36") dark-tipped tail. Depending upon its range, the Mountain Lion is named *Cougar*, *Puma*, or *Panther*. Mountain Lions stand 2 ½ feet tall at the shoulders, are 3 ½ to 4 ½ feet long and weigh 80 – 260 pounds. These big cats feed primarily on deer, rabbits and rodents. They are extremely shy of humans, retreating up trees when chased by hunters' bloodhounds, where they make easy targets. Because of the rare opportunities for consistent Mountain Lion viewing, little is actually known about their behavior. Mankind has a great deal of dedicated work ahead to prevent the Mountain Lion from becoming an endangered species.

Government says fat is our fate

The government has just made millions of us overweight — overnight. It has published a study that redefines the term, lowering the standards so that an estimated 29 million Americans who weren't overweight last week now are.

They have come up with a guideline they call "body mass index" (BMI), which throws height and weight into a blender and comes up with a body fat figure. Don't ask how it's computed — it involves figuring your height in meters and your weight in kilograms — but a BMI of 25 is considered fat.

The government (naturally) says it's doing this for our own good. Carrying more weight than you should can lead to high blood pressure, elevated cholesterol, diabetes and all manner of disagreeable things, it says.

"We felt that the record was clear and the risk was there," said one of the doctors on the panel who revised the guidelines. "We felt that we owed it to physicians and their patients to alert them to this fact, although it doesn't mean that everyone needs to go on a diet."

Maybe not, but almost everybody does.

If you're 5 foot 4 and weigh more than 145 pounds, you're overweight. If you're 5-10 and over 174 pounds, you're fat. (And you thought, perhaps, that the

government was supposed to make you feel better about yourself? Think again. It dreams up things like BMI and wind chill factor to make you feel worse than you otherwise would, if left to your own devices.)

According to these guidelines, about 55 percent of the population — 97 million adults — are overweight.

As a fellow who answered to the nickname "Slim" when he was a lad, then slowly grew into the heavyweight division, I object to the new guidelines.

In the first place, you don't need guidelines to tell you whether or not you're fat. A full-length mirror will get the job done.

In the second place, if you really are fat, these guidelines are so tough, they'll discourage you from even trying to lose weight. What's the sense of trying to drop 10 or 15 pounds when you'll still be 25 pounds overweight?

In the third place, the guidelines help feed the mania this country has developed for thinness, particularly among women.

Look at the role models given us by Hollywood. The great beauties of the day are actresses like Gwyneth Paltrow, Meg Ryan, Uma Thurman, Sandra Bullock, models like Kate Moss — women who, while pretty enough, have the figures of rolled umbrellas. (A few years ago, several famous

models fronted for a new restaurant in New York, and I remember thinking: "What's going to be the specialty of the house: iceberg lettuce without dressing?")

The other thing the government did for us last week was make things clearer; at least they promised to.

Vice President Al Gore announced that by October, all new documents and forms produced by the federal government would be written in "plain language." By 2002, all documents, new and old, will be so written, he said.

I wish Mr. Gore well, but I don't give him much of a shot. The object of plain language is to say something. When you do that, there's always someone who will hold you to it. Say it in murky, jargon-laden phrases festooned with dependent clauses that further cloud meaning, however, and no one will ever be able to blame you for anything.

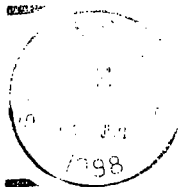
Which is pretty much the theory Gore followed when he said, of his White House fundraising, "There is no controlling legal authority that says this was in violation of the law."

Basically, plain language is like the weather. Everybody talks about it, but nobody does anything about it.
