On March the twelfth, On Interstate I-95 in Greenwich, 50 puppies were burned to death in their cages. They were being transported to pet stores in New England. According to newspaper accounts, fellow motorists alerted the truck driver to the fact that his trailer was engulfed in flames.

There is no way I can express how sad and deeply disturbed I am about this horrific incident. However, it is probably nothing less than a miracle that no other motorists, the driver, and his passenger were not harmed or fatally injured.

I firmly believe that David Cook and Edward Ruyle who were transporting these puppies, have participated in a crime endangering anyone driving on I-95 that Thursday night on March twelfth. From what I have heard, these men were using a heater which was hooked up to a tank of propane gas. I have no clue as to what kind of ventilation was provided inside the trailer or even if there was any ventilation at all. Obviously these drivers had no means of monitoring the heating device or the trailer itself either inside or out. Their lack of responsibility concerning safety and their participation in this inhumane treatment of these puppies who were caged since leaving Arkansas, calls for nothing less than a jail sentence, in my opinion.

The perpetrators of this crime are due in court on April twenty-second. I urge everyone to contact their State Representatives and encourage them to seek justice concerning this case. In the future we must pass stricter laws to prevent this sickening crime from ever happening again.

Please accept my thanks for your support and please express your indignation for this sad state of affairs.

Pet Sales Measure Called Too Weak

50 Puppies' Fiery Deaths Could Happen Again, Say Animal Rights Activists

Despite the deaths of 50 puppies Thursday night in a truck fire in Greenwich and an accident last October involving a truckload of puppies in Bridgeport, animal rights advocates say a legislative proposal regulating pet store sales is too weak to prevent such incidents in the future. *March 12*

The Greenwich fire started about 10:30 p.m. on I-95, in a propane heater in a trailer being towed by a pickup truck. State police said puppies were being transported from Arkansas to pet shops

in the Northeast.

David Cook, 48, of Jonesboro, Ark., and Edward Earl Ruyle, 37, of Filley, Neb., were charged with a single count of failing to have proper health certificates to transport one of the dogs, a white boxer puppy, police said.

Both were also initially charged with 68 counts of cruelty to animals. Prosecutors, however, said they did not have enough evidence to press those charges. Cook and Ruyle posted bond late Friday. They are due back in court April 22.

Prosecutor Steven Weiss said it appears that it is not a case of animal cruelty, but simply an accident. But, he said, the deaths were still being investigated and the cruelty charges could be reinstated later if additional evidence is found.

Proposed Pet Sales Law Too Weak, Animal Advocates Say

The accident took place only days before a pet-shop bill will be considered by the legislature's environment committee. On Monday, the committee will consider a bill that requires kennel licensing, among other measures, but would not ban sales. The original proposal, by state Sen. Fred H. "Ted" Lovegrove Jr., R-Fairfield, unsuccessfully recommended a ban on puppy and kitten sales in Connecticut pet stores.

State Sen. Eileen M. Daily, D-Westbrook, co-chairman of the environment committee, said she doubted there would be enough votes in the legislature to approve a ban. She also said she has received few complaints from constituents about pet store animals.

"I think [legislators] would be as unlikely to ban pet stores from selling pets as they would to ban hardware stores from selling nails or dairies from selling ice cream. What we're doing is the best we can do," she said.

Of the 68 animals being transported Thursday, 44 died immediately of severe burns or smoke inhalation. Twenty-four injured puppies were taken to the nearby Veterinary Referral and Emergency Center in Norwalk; six of those died of smoke inhalation and shock. An additional five were taken to the Connecticut

Humane Society in Newington.

The dogs included cocker spaniels, German shepherds, dachshunds, pugs, schnauzers, boxers and Australian shepherds. State police said they were destined for pet stores in the Northeast, and possibly one in Connecticut, but the store name was not available Friday night.

Veterinarians and others at the Norwalk emergency center had worked throughout the night to save the puppies. Dr. Larry Berk-witt said that of the 13 puppies now being treated there, 10 probably will survive. Besides suffering smoke inhalation, several had corneal edemas, Berk-witt said.

When the dogs recover, he said, they will be taken to the Connecticut Humane Society.

Richard Johnston, humane society president, said some of the dead puppies were taken to the state pathologist for examination, to determine their pre-accident conditions.

On Friday, Friends of Animals, a 200,000-member group based in Darien, called for a boycott of all stores that sell puppies and kittens. The boycott, originally planned for May, was moved up in response to the Greenwich accident. At a public hearing on the issue last month, the group submitted petitions from 7,000 state residents calling for a ban on pet shop sales of puppies and

kittens.

"This ghastly incident is shedding more light on the horrific puppy mill industry, for which Connecticut provides a market," said Friends President Priscilla Feral.

The Greenwich incident follows an accident in October, in which 96 puppies were found packed inside a truck that crashed in Bridgeport. Five of those puppies died, and the rest were adopted through the Connecticut Humane Society.

Wayne Keeney, a lawyer for Cook and Ruyle, said they took good care of the dogs. He said Cook works for a puppy breeder in Arkansas, Ruyle works for a puppy broker in Nebraska.

Keeney said the men were attempting to keep the animals warm by putting a propane heater in the trailer. "These animals were well cared for," he said. "This situation is in no way analogous to the Bridgeport incident."

The current legislative proposal also calls for licensing for breeders whose dogs produce more than one litter a year; a reimbursement of up to \$200 for people whose pet-store pets have died within 15 days of sale; and the posting, on each cage of a pet shop animal offered for sale, of the breed, the state in which the

dog was born and health information.

Arnold Baer, director of the Northeast regional office of the Humane Society of the United States in Jacksonville, Vt., said the puppy-breeding industry, largely based in the Midwest, is based on volume.

"It's just a commodity to them,"

Baer said. "They are shipping animals as if they were boxes of salt with no regard to their needs. It just has to be stopped. We support the strongest legislation that can come out of this."
