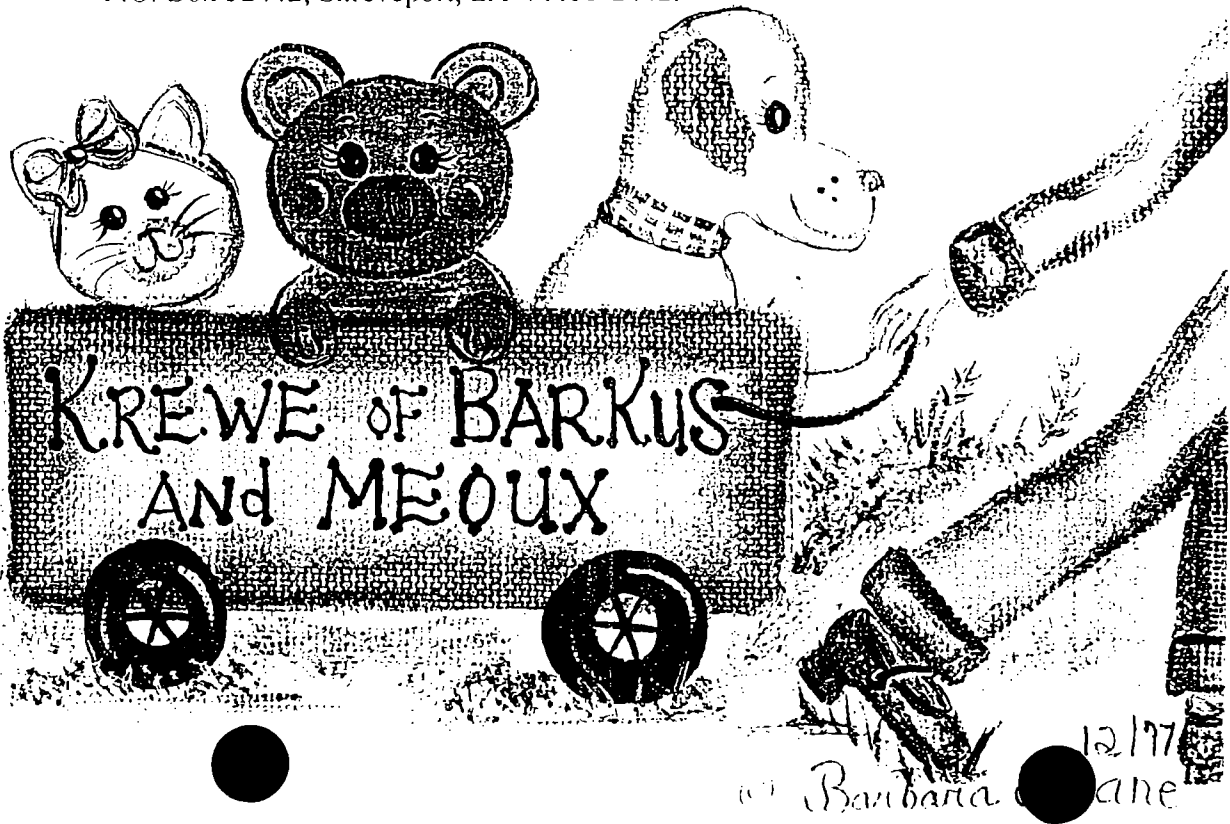

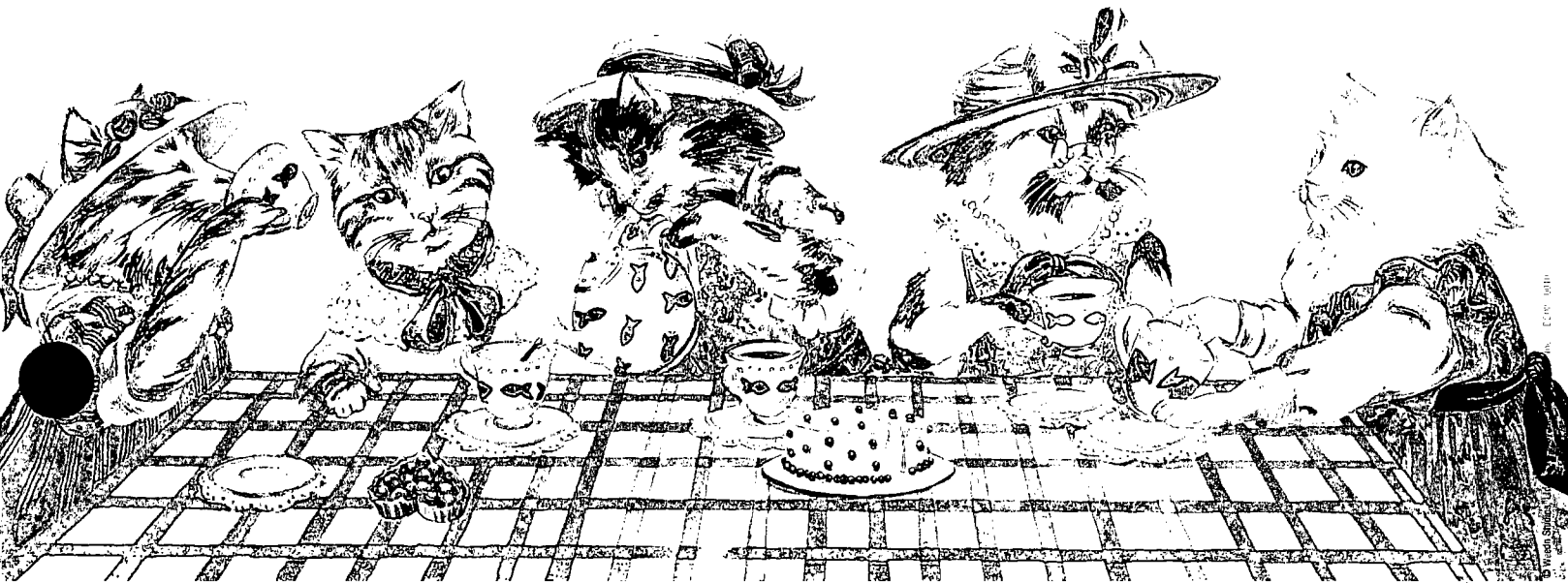
RE: KREWE OF BARKUS AND MEOUX...MARDI PAW PARADE
