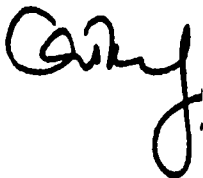
I was honored to meet you, a lady I so admire, in Davos at the dinner on Sunday night. Perhaps you may not remember me, but I had presented you with a scarf.
