The following is the treatment as promised...

Format of opening video for The White House Conference on Raising Responsible Teens

The video produced to open the conference will run between three and four minutes and highlight four families and a handful of additional teens speaking about their lives, relationships, concerns, fears, frustrations and hopes for the future.

The four families, per our conference call, will include an ethnic and socio-economic mix of the following: the so-called "traditional" family; a non biological-parent family; a dual working parent family and a single mom. In addition we will talk with four or five more teenagers (without their parents present) to add more voice and diversity to the piece.

We propose using two cameras to shoot the subjects from different angles. One camera will frame the individual in an extreme close-up, a most compelling shot. The other will alternate between a looser shot and close-ups of lips, eyes, hands, etc., all of which will be edited together to keep the piece visually as well as editorially interesting.

We plan to have each person complete a full sentence, for example, "My hopes for the future are ", or "I wish my son would talk to me about ". We will then edit the best and most topic-inclusive answers together to best exemplify what is going through the hearts and minds of today's teenagers and their parents. We expect to be extremely creative with the shooting, editing and graphic transitions to add flavor to the subject matter and provide a visual break to the "talking heads."

We will use music as a soft bed behind the interviews, raising it briefly during transitions to keep the video paced properly. The piece will end with the most meaningful and compelling soundbite we have, and then fade to black silently for effect.

We hope this meets with all your needs and expectations. We look forward to making it happen.
