Dear Ms. Rasco:

I seek your help to solve a problem that needs legislation to correct.

Wesley Housing Development Corporation has a HUD reservation of \$1.650 M to develop 12 apartments for people living with AIDS. The money pays for acquisition, construction and 20 years of rental assistance to cover operations and maintenance.

HUD requires individualized supportive services for residents and services, which indeed, are a necessity. But under this 811 program - Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities - HUD does not include funds to pay for services.

HUD does have several other programs, the supportive Housing Program and HOPWA (Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS), which provide these funds. They are competitive and must be applied for every year. Ryan White funding is available through HHS.

My volunteer board is nervous about being successful in raising from \$30,000 to \$75,000 every year for 20 years to provide services. My leap of faith speech is getting old.

In Raleigh, N. C. one weary executive director has burned out two volunteer boards and is working on the third to raise funds for supportive services at one of the few facilities of this type which has been built in the nation.

It makes common sense that if a proposal warrants capital and rental assistance funding, it also warrants funding for services.

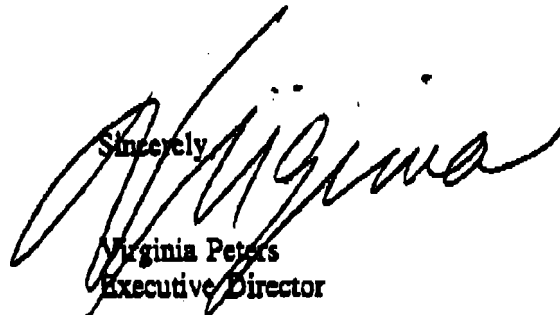
We need federal legislation to piggy back funding for supportive services onto capital and rental assistance in the 811 program.

Your help would be greatly appreciated. May I meet with you to discuss how this can be addressed through the legislative process?
