Take 495 towards Rockville to 270 North, towards Frederick.

Take the first exit, Montrose Road, Exit #4.

Stay in the left lane going towards Tower Oaks Blvd.

Make a left at the stop sign.

At the first light, make a right onto Wooten Parkway.

Travel approximately 3 miles. You will cross over Rockville Pike and Viers Mill Rd, pass through another traffic light. Make a left at the next traffic signal, East Gude Drive.

At the first light, take a right onto Taft Court.
