SUBJECT: Foreign Competitive Practices Report

Attached please find a copy of the Foreign Competitive Practices Report which I mentioned to you the other day. This is the first time the United States Government has taken a systematic look at what competitor governments are doing to create jobs for their workers through increased exports. It is really quite startling, and I think you will find it interesting.

I presented this report to both the House and the Senate in closed hearings yesterday. There was bipartisan enthusiasm for the report and concern regarding the issues it raises.
