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Q&A: Success of Japan Trade Policy

Q: Senator Dole recently noted that the bilateral deficit with Japan fared better under Republican Administrations than under President Clinton. How can the Administration be taking credit for success on Japan when our bilateral deficit is up?

A: Let me start by saying the bilateral deficit is not a good scorecard for our trade policy. Nonetheless, even on that measure, the record is better than Bush-Reagan.

- The deficit deteriorated an average of nearly 150 percent in each of the two Reagan Administrations.
- Under 12 years of Reagan-Bush, the bilateral merchandise deficit with Japan deteriorated an average of 14 percent per year. We have cut that rate by over half.
- And since last year, the bilateral deficit has been declining. In 1995, the trade deficit with Japan declined by nearly 10 percent--the first decline in five years. Despite slow growth in Japan during 1995, U.S. merchandise exports to Japan grew five times faster than our imports from Japan.

But let me emphasize that the goal of our trade policy is to improve the economic well-being of Americans by expanding trade. And on that front, President Clinton's record is unequalled.

- Since taking office, President Clinton has made opening the Japanese market a touchstone of his trade policy. He has been unwavering in his commitment to secure tough but fair trade agreements -- and to make sure that those agreements are enforced. The Administration has concluded 20 trade agreements with Japan--more than any previous administration. And we have followed through on implementing, reviewing, and enforcing these agreements.
- We are beginning to see some positive results: exports to Japan have grown by one third under President Clinton, compared to ___ under Bush-Reagan [checking].
- And exports to Japan in the goods sectors covered by our trade agreements, have grown even faster--by over 85 percent since the beginning of the Administration--3 times greater than growth in other U.S. exports to Japan.
- Since we signed an auto and auto parts agreement with Japan, U.S. auto and auto parts exports to Japan have risen over 35 percent, totalling \$3.8 billion in 1995 -- already exceeding exports to the European Union. Monthly car exports were up 50 percent in the first few months after the agreement was signed compared to the months preceding the agreement.

Q: Is there a deadline for sanctions?

A: Right now we are working hard with the Chinese government to ensure it fulfills its IPR obligations.

Iran/ Libya Sanctions Legislation:

Q. Will the Administration support the legislation in Congress imposing economic sanctions on third country firms doing business with Iran and Libya?

A. As you know, we supported the D'Amato bill in the Senate. But we are concerned that a number of the provisions in the Gilman bill would inadvertently hurt U.S. interest. We are working with the relevant House committees to address these problems and hope to shape a bill that best promotes our national security interests.

Dear Laura,

The three folks listed below are interesting and enjoyable, but they can also answer three questions about Japan we all need to know. The questions on my mind are:

First, what model or conception does one hold about the operations of the Japanese political economy in the heyday of the developmental state. The reference point of our model was the period 1975 or so before the formal instruments and protections began to be dismantled as Japan joined the OECD and the GATT. *Second*, Japanese institutions and practices have evolved since the developmental heyday baseline, but which changes are significant? And how substantially has the market logic that characterized that period changed? The rise in the value of the yen has driven producers to reorganize production with significant operations outside of Japan, and some Japanese auto-producers are buying Korean steel, for example, but the tightly woven supply networks are for the most part still firmly in place. *Third*, how does the story of Japan intertangle with the story of the rest of Asia. The period immediately after the war was one of domestic reconstruction and isolation albeit insulation from the regional politics under the American security umbrella. Moreover, America provided a model of successful capitalism. Asia was neither a significant market nor a significant source of under components and subsystems that would contribute to the market position of Japanese firms.

The people:

Fukukawa, Shinji. He is a former Vice Minister of MITI who has a clear understanding of how Japan worked in the days he was in power. Whether he will discuss the changes in a systematic way is another matter. Both Steve and I have met him. Now he heads the research institute of a big advertising agency. I am told he is one of the most influential "private" figures in Japan.

Tanaka, Nobuo. You know him. He is a real pleasure and delight, someone you would enjoy having dinner with on a private basis. He was head of the OECD directorate of Industry, Technology and all that. Now he is back in Japan as Director of Industrial Finance Division of MITI. When he went back, I asked him if this was "forced re-education" after years abroad. He is younger, but a long term favorite for real power.

Watanabe, Koji. He is a good friend of Suzanne Berger from her University days. He is now the Ambassador to Russia, but may be back in town for these meetings. He was/is one of the three or four ranking figures in the foreign ministry. Previously, he was Ambassador to Italy and Saudi Arabia. He handled the structural negotiations a few years ago. Apart from everything else, he is charming with perfect English.

I hope to see you soon. I may be in Washington in December. Give my regards to Erik.

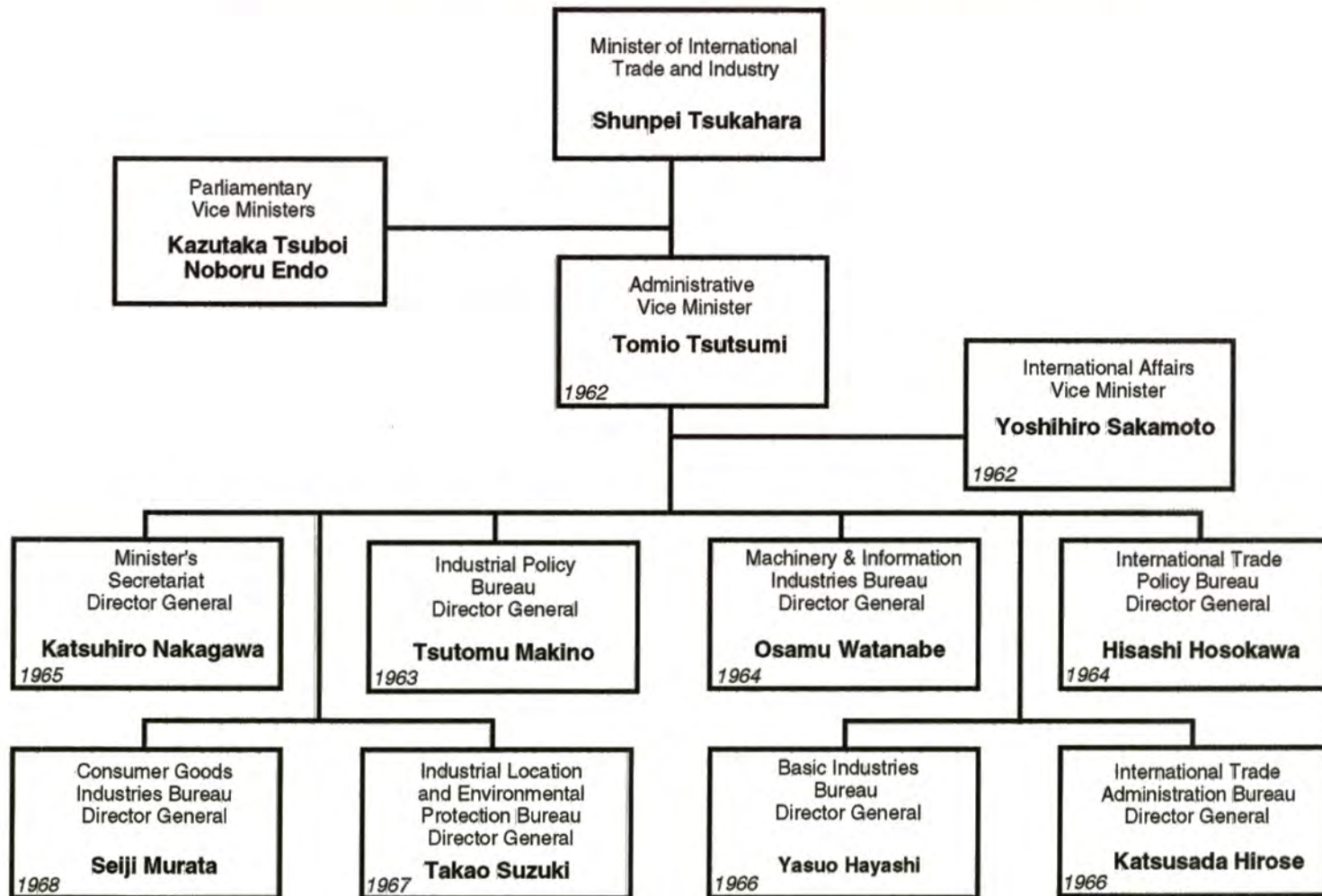

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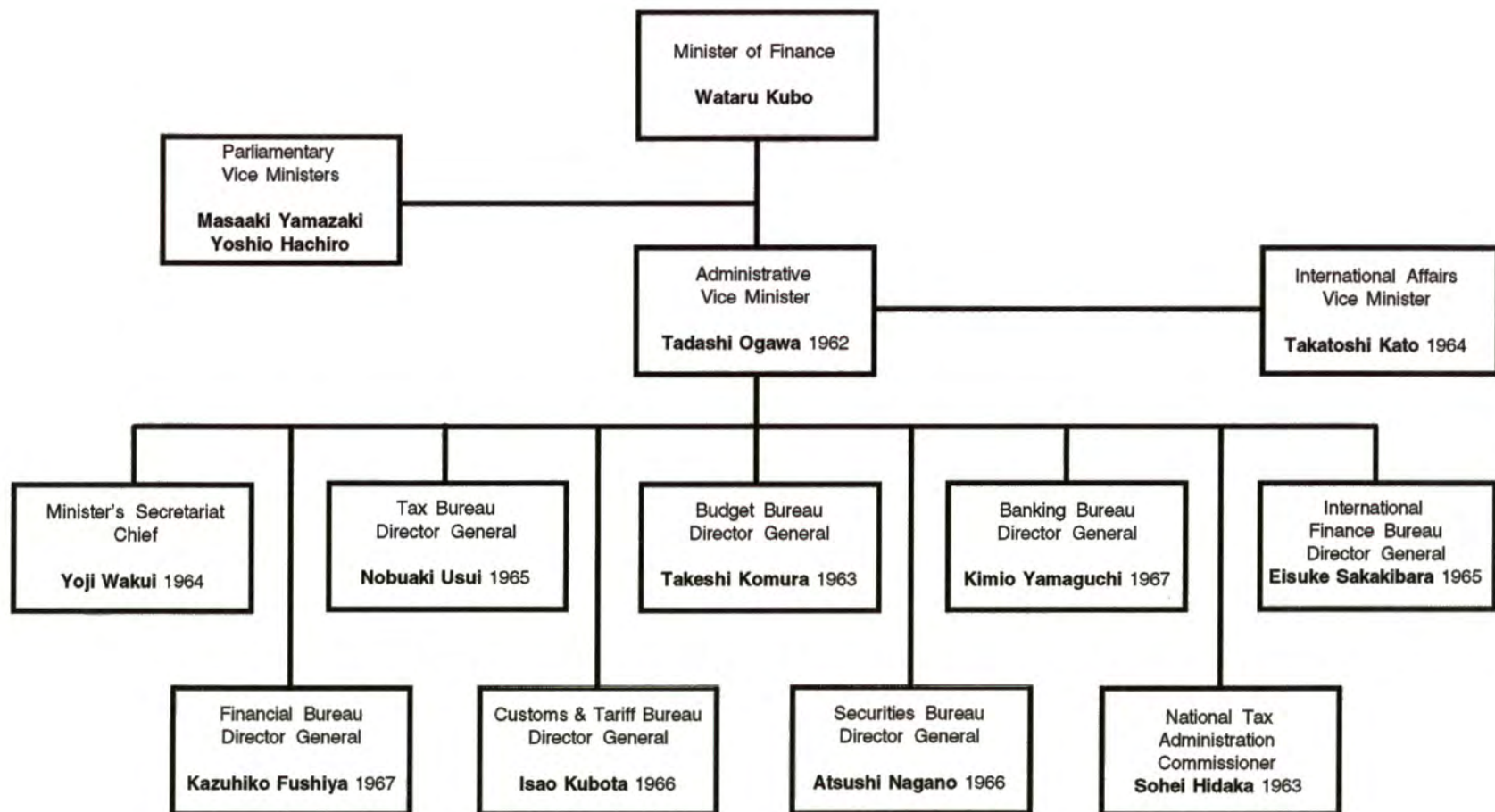

MITI: Structure and Selected Personnel

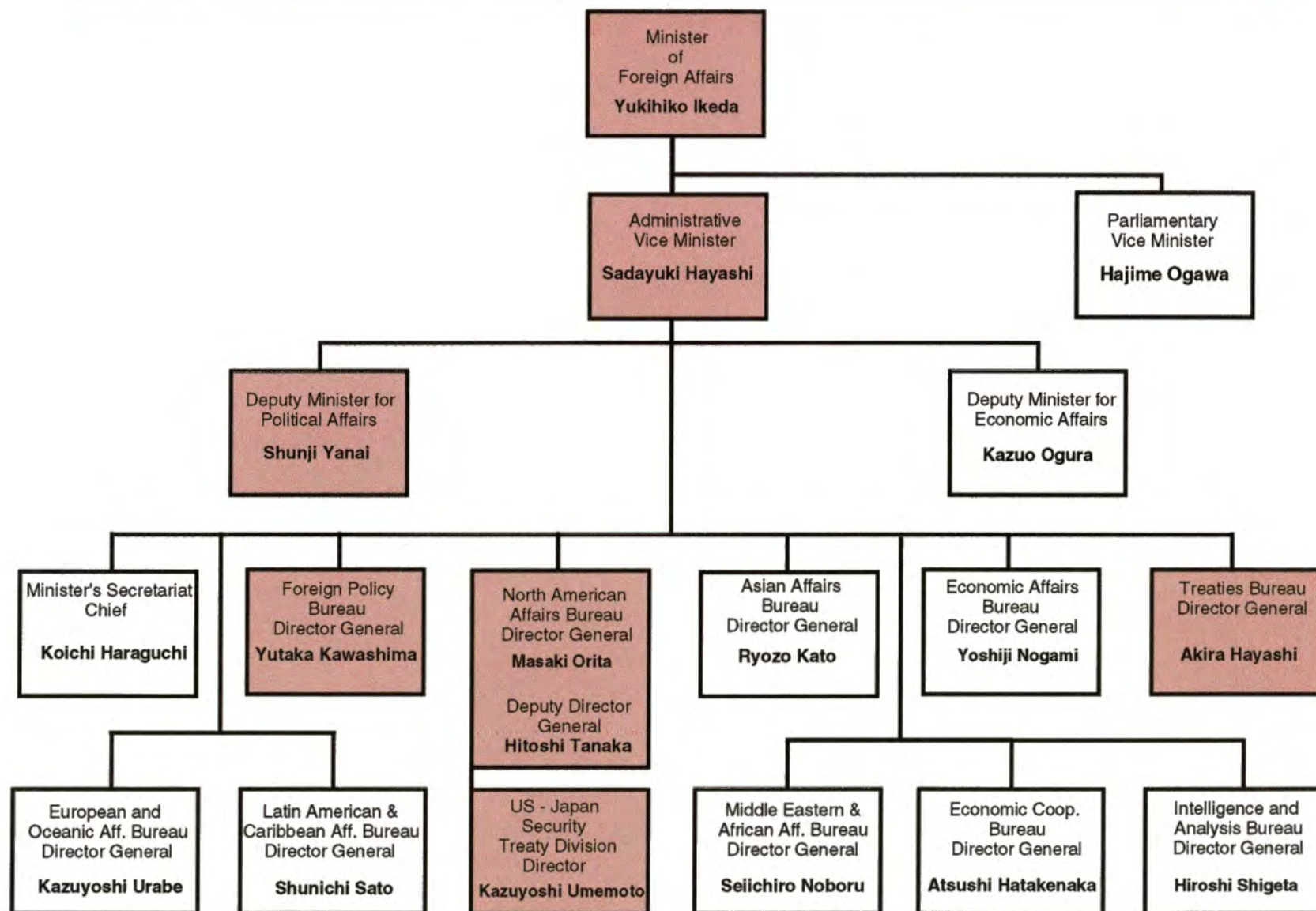


NOTE: Number in Italics is year person entered ministry.
