Sandy,

Sakoda gave me a readout of the Perry-Mondale meeting this morning.

SECDEF took the CINC's 4200 reclaimed land runway off the table.

The idea of a Mobile Offshore Base (MOB) was discussed. Modular, with enough storage capacity to make Camp Kinser obsolete. This is seriously being studied. A runway internal to Schwab is also being studied. If you tilt it just right, the Japanese figure you can build a 4000 ft runway.

Looking to come out with a statement at the 2+2 that rules out options and emphasizes work being done on other options. Convene a second 2+2 in November and announce closure.

A task force is being formed (led by Adm Wright and deputied by Mary Tighe) to work out the details and feasibility of actual options.

Talking Points for POTUS Pre-brief

The President will travel to New York to participate in the 51st UN General Assembly. His fourth trip to New York will be highlighted by the signing of the CTBT and his subsequent speech.

Introduction and Events

- ☐ This year's trip to New York will be relatively brief. Last year the 50th anniversary gathered the largest grouping of heads of state in history. This year will be mostly attended by Foreign Ministers. About 30 heads of state are expected to attend.
- ☐ Hashimoto is the only G-7 leader expected to arrive and you will meet with him briefly. Your other bilateral is with Saudi Foreign Minister Saud Al-Faisal.
- ☐ The signing of the CTBT will be the biggest event and will set a very positive tone for the visit
- ☐ Your speech will celebrate the conclusion and signature of the CTBT; and sets forth our future goals in arms control and nonproliferation.
- ☐ In addition, it calls for zero tolerance for aggression, terrorism, and other lawless behavior.

The Secretary General

- ☐ The real "buzz" in New York -- in both the press and the international diplomatic corps will be the status of the Secretary General.
- ☐ It is important to deal with the issue; to duck the issue will fuel speculation of a deal and delay the selection process and undermine the process of getting an effective leader for the next term.
- ☐ The best way to handle the issue is with a low key, short yet clear statement of your position during the camera spray at the beginning of the bilateral with Hashimoto.
- ☐ Your decision is irrevocable, encourage the Council to start the selection process

UN Reform and Finance

- ☐ Last year we did well in the add back -- getting most of our obligations paid for FY 96 (although nothing on arrears)
- ☐ This year, we should be ok on current peacekeeping, may get some on arrears -- but funding for Burundi is still problematic.
- ☐ Funding for the regular budget is in trouble. The Senate mark (\$550m) is well short of the Administration request (\$1.0b)
- ☐ We will need another big push again this year. Leon Panetta has been helpful on Burundi

Bilaterals

For Saud:

On Iraq: Thank him for King Fahd's assurance to Perry we will have full Saudi support if we need to take actions to protect our pilots. Access to Saudi bases may be necessary if we get into a sustained confrontation with Iraq; we don't need to ask for anything more now.

On Khobar Towers: Recall that you've given King Fahd your personal assurance we will take no actions which could affect Saudi interests without consulting them. By same token, you can't be surprised by Saudi revelations. When can we expect full read-out?

For Hashimoto:

On Iraq: Thank Hashimoto for his public support and stress the importance of that to our ability to complete operation successfully.
On Bosnia, note Japanese past support and urge continued financial contribution to reconstruction.

On Okinawa: Note the just concluded 2 plus 2 meeting that agreed we would press for solution by November to relocation of Marines from Futenma, but reiterate the new site must allow for preservation

of
readiness levels.

On economic issues: Urge that opening to Japanese companies of insurance market be put on hold until we can resolve outstanding issues between us; similarly on civil aviation, note it is difficult to advance market opportunities for both U.S. and Japan carriers while current rights of U.S. carriers are being infringed.

Additional Qs & As

Q: What is the status on the relocation of Futenma Air Station?
What do you think of the FOF - Floating Off-shore Facility as a viable option?

A: We are committed to arriving at a solution to consolidate and

reduce our military presence on Okinawa in a way that does not compromise readiness or capabilities. As a result of last month's 2 +

2 meeting between the secretaries of Defense and State of the two countries, we are examining 3 options. Relocation to Kadena Air Base, Camp Schwab, or an off-shore floating facility. There were technical level meetings here in Washington earlier this week to examine the requirements and feasibility of an off-shore facility.

Its too early to say which of these options or a combination of them

will be selected. We expect a decision sometime next month.

Q: What is the status of KEDO and the canning operation?

A: KEDO is on track. The U.S. is committed to maintaining our obligations. We have secured funding for next year and anticipate EU contributing as well. The canning operation continues on schedule.

It is important to note that despite recent unfortunate submarine incursion by the North, the Agreed Framework and KEDO have remained on track.

Q: What is the U.S position regarding the recent dispute involving the Senkaku Islands?

A: We have consistently called on the parties involved to solve their dispute in a peaceful manner. IF pressed: The U.S. does not take a position on the question of sovereignty.

Q: What is the status of our civair relations with Japan?

A: The last round of Civil Aviation talks broke down over Japan's unwillingness to allow our carriers to operate routes they have the right to operate under the bilateral.

O: Since then, we have continued to discuss Civil Aviation with the Japanese and have made known our interest in an Open Skies agreement. The dialogue is continuing.

O: No talks with Japan have yet been scheduled.

Q: What do you expect as the outcome of our ongoing dispute with Japan over our 1994 Insurance Agreement?

A: The critical issue in our dispute with Japan on insurance is the integrity of bilateral agreements signed by the Government of Japan. Our 1994 agreement on insurance is one of the more than 22 trade agreements signed with Japan under this administration. It is our clear intention to ensure that this and all of the other agreements, including those signed under earlier administrations, are implemented fully by the Japanese. Our negotiators in the insurance talks have this as their primary goal.

We will be reengaging with the Japanese sometime next month, following our and their elections, and we are intent on resolving this dispute before the December 15 deadline set recently by acting USTR Barshefsky and Finance Minister Kubo.

Q: You mentioned a new architecture to address issues in Asia. Do you think ARF can effectively address such issues as the Spratlys?

A: The ARF is a nascent organization that has a lot of potential. It is a forum where such issues as the Spratlys can indeed be addressed. Witness China's acquiescence to discuss the Spratlys in a multi-national forum vice having to engage each competing claimant in a series of bilateral discussions.

Q: Reports of North Korea missile testing raises the question of TMD. What is the U.S. doing in this area in Asia?

A:

☐ Our first priority in the area of missile defense is to provide effective theater missile defenses, or TMDs, against short-range missile threats we face today in the Middle East and Asia.

☐ Over the past four years, we requested more than \$6 billion for research, development and procurement of effective TMDs.

☐ In South Korea, we deployed upgraded Patriot (PAC-2) missiles in 1994.

☐ Japan is upgrading all of their Patriot battalions to the more capable "PAC-2" system and we are currently engaged in a government to government DOD-MOD study to examine the threat and future requirements for TMD.

☐ The advanced Patriot "PAC-3" system will be available for deployment in 1999.

☐ To address longer range threats, the U.S. will have a limited number of THAAD missiles available for deployment in 1998.

Q: Isn't there an immediate threat to Alaska and Hawaii posed by North Korea?

☐ The Intelligence community has said that it does not believe the North Koreans will have an operational missile which might have the range to reach western Hawaii or Alaska within the next 5 years. We are watching this closely.

☐ Moreover, the administration's program for national missile defense (NMD) will develop by the year 2000 an NMD system that could be deployed in three years.

Q: Is the Administration doing anything to protect Taiwan from the threat of missile attack?

☐ We have recently reached an agreement with Taiwan that will provide them with a TMD capability.
