Kate,

While it is not strictly necessary -- meaning, we will get some feedback from other agencies that meet with Nukaga. However, there are some actual reasons to see him.

We do not routinely have access to members of the Prime Minister's Office. The best source to cultivate would be the Chief Cabinet Secretary, but he will never travel to the U.S. Next best may be the Deputy Chief Cabinet Secretary - Nukaga.

As I mentioned below, this is an opportunity to hear and if necessary give our thoughts on what is happening vis-a-vis Okinawa. Again, not absolutely necessary because DOD and State will bend his ear.

As in ALL Japanese visitors, who they see is important. We may not like it, but it is a fact of life. We would prefer he see us, but that is not going to happen.

I recommend, schedule permitting, that Jim see him. But if he cannot, we will survive.

Deputy Chief Cabinet Secretary Nukaga will be in Washington January 8-9, 1998 and would like an appointment to see you. Nukaga, among other duties, has a direct interest in Okinawa and our efforts to implement the Special Action Committee on Okinawa final report (calling

for the relocation of Futenma Marine Corps Air Station to a Sea-based Facility).

Given the likely no vote on the December 21 Nago City, Okinawa referendum on relocating Futenma functions to a SBF near the city, I recommend you see Nukaga to discuss how the Government of Japan plans to handle this situation. A no vote and a pulling back by the central government in implementing a Futenma relocation will set us up for additional confrontations on Okinawa that conceivably could reignite the 1995 anti-military sentiment.
