San Francisco – In an effort to monitor the role of the United States government's participation in the encouragement of peace negotiations and the improvement of human rights conditions in Northern Ireland, *Northern Ireland Alert* today issued a comprehensive Northern Ireland Congressional Scorecard.

The scorecard, which records actions taken by both the House of Representatives and the Senate, ranks Congressional members on 23 activities taken to date this year. Categories of action include involvement in the Northern Ireland peace process, expressions of concern pertaining to human rights abuses, sponsorship of pending Irish-related resolutions and bills, the call for release or leniency regarding political prisoners, and the encouragement of Irish cultural concerns.

After carefully collecting and evaluating a considerable amount of news articles, Internet sites, legislative histories, hearing transcripts, and other assorted publicly available documents on Northern Ireland Congressional action, *Northern Ireland Alert* considers the following Congresspersons to be **DEDICATED PARTICIPANTS** on Northern Ireland-related issues:

Northern Ireland Alert publishes its scorecard, the first of future scorecards and/or bulletins, to update a broad American audience on where their elected representatives stand with regard to expressing concern over the ongoing human rights abuses and peace process setbacks which have troubled the residents of Northern Ireland for a generation. *Northern Ireland Alert* believes that active United States involvement as an honest broker in the upcoming all-party talks and beyond could assist in effectuating change to this troubled region of the world, much as international concern has had a positive, healing influence in the Middle East, South Africa, and other countries over the past decade.

Northern Ireland Alert takes no position on the success or failure of any political party in Northern Ireland, but rather focuses its attention on the human rights concerns endemic to Northern Ireland society (particularly economic and religious discrimination as experienced by the Catholic minority) and the United States government's need, on behalf of its approximately 40 million citizens of Irish descent, to become actively involved in bringing about change to what should be a significant international concern.

During 1997 to date, the United States Congress has participated in the following significant actions to improve the human rights conditions in Northern Ireland, as well as to support the ongoing peace process, Irish political prisoners, and Irish education initiatives:

1) *Hearing On Deportees*

On February 6, The Ad Hoc Committee on Irish Affairs conducted a hearing on Capitol Hill concerning the current status of Irish deportees in the United States. The Committee heard testimony from the Immigration and Naturalization Service, families affected by the pending deportation proceedings, assorted Irish-American organizations, and lawyers pleading on behalf of the families. The Scorecard reflects those Congressional members who attended the hearing. 2) *Congressional Letter To Clinton - Deportees*

On February 12, as a result of the February 6th deportation hearing on Capitol Hill, several Congressional members sent a letter to President Clinton, requesting that he review the testimony from the hearing and intervene in the government's deportation efforts against seven Irish nationals. 3) *Congressional Letter to Reno - Deportees*

In late March, various Congresspersons sent a letter to Attorney General Janet Reno, urging her not to challenge federal immigration Judge Williams' decision to block the deportation of Brian Pearson. A week prior to the letter, Judge Williams had ruled that Pearson's past crimes, while in Northern Ireland, were "political offenses" which did

not come under the New Immigration and Nationality Act. Williams also stated that Pearson was entitled to political asylum. (Source: "Congress Ask That Ex-IRA Man Be Let Stay," *Irish Times*, April 4. Note: The INS eventually appealed the Pearson ruling.)

4) *Congressional Members Speak Out Regarding Deportees*

On May 14 and 15, several Congressional members spoke in the House of Representatives to oppose the deportation of seven men from Northern Ireland convicted of "political offenses." The members spoke in support of Noel Gaynor, Robert McErlean, Gabriel Megahey, Matt Morrison, Charles Caulfield, Kevin Crossan, and Brian Pearson, both individually and collectively. 5) *Congressional Letter Urging Sentence Reduction For Jimmy Smyth*

On June 15, a Congressional letter was sent to Northern Ireland Secretary of State Mo Mowlam, requesting that 2-1/2 years be cut off the sentence of Jimmy Smyth, who was extradited from California last year and is currently incarcerated at the Maze Prison (Long Kesh) in Northern Ireland. The signers urged a reduction in Smith's sentence as a confidence-building measure for the nationalist community. The 2-1/2 year period represents the time Smyth served in prison in California while fighting extradition. 6) *Congressional Letters In Support Of Rosin McAliskey*

In late April, several Congressional members sent a letter to German Ambassador Juergen Chrobog, requesting that the German government vacate its extradition warrant for Rosin McAliskey. A similar letter was sent to British Ambassador Sir John Kerr. McAliskey, the daughter of Irish civil rights leader and former MP Bernadette McAliskey, was, at the time, pregnant and being held without bail in Holloway prison in England. Due to the tenuous evidence supporting her arrest, as well as the inadequate treatment she received while in Holloway (including a poor diet, denial of proper pre-natal care, and repeated strip-searching), McAliskey's confinement received intense international criticism. 7) *Congressional Letter In Support Of Damien Sullivan*

On February 6, a Congressional letter was sent to (then) Northern Ireland Secretary of State Sir Patrick Mayhew and Northern Ireland Lord Chief Justice Sir Robert Carswell to call attention to the miscarriage of justice-related case of Damien Sullivan. At the time, Sullivan was serving a life sentence at the Maze Prison for his 1996 conviction of the murder of a former RIR soldier, based on faulty video evidence and specious RUC reports. Sullivan was eventually released from prison in March after the

8) Two Irish Committees Meet With Clinton Administration

On May 27, the co-chairmen of the Congressional Ad Hoc Committee for Irish Affairs and the chairman of the Congressional Friends of Ireland met with top Clinton Administration officials to discuss the peace process in Northern Ireland. 9) Congressional Letters To Mo Mowlam And Tony Blair

On June 6, over 100 Congressional members signed a letter congratulating Mo Mowlam, the new Northern Ireland Secretary of State, on her recent appointment and urging her to place the peace process at the top of her agenda. The four chairmen of the Congressional Ad Hoc Committee for Irish Affairs sent a similar letter to Prime Minister Tony Blair. 10) U.S. Senate Friends Of Ireland And Concerned Irish Americans Call For Cease-Fire

In late June, members of the Senate Friends of Ireland group called for a restoration of the IRA's cease-fire and urged the loyalist paramilitaries to halt *their* violence. The members also praised initiatives by the Irish and British governments to move the peace process forward. Their statement was notable in its call for an end to violence from *both* sides of the conflict (at the time, journalistic and political opinion was almost exclusively directed at Sinn Fein due to the IRA murder of two RUC officers in Lurgan earlier in the month).

Also in June, a prominent group of Irish-Americans under the banner Concerned Irish Americans issued a statement calling for a cessation of violence by all sides, an end to the unionist parties' policies of "obstruction" and "sectarianism," and the admission of Sinn Fein to all-party talks following an IRA cease-fire. The group included the four Congressional co-chairmen of the Ad Hoc Committee for Irish Affairs, author Frank McCourt, journalist Pete Hamill, director Terry George, attorney/activist Paul O'Dwyer, and Americans For A New Irish Agenda chairman Frank Durkin. 11) *Other Cease-Fire Involvement And Miscellaneous Support*

A. *Involvement With Current IRA Cease-Fire*

During the final days of negotiating the current cease-fire, Sinn Fein asked Reps. Peter King and Richard Neal to make news of the imminent cease-fire known to the White House, and to ask that the party receive the same even-handed treatment from the government that they experienced after the 1994 cease-fire. The message was taken to a senior member of the White House national security team, who subsequently gave a positive response. Senators Edward Kennedy and Christopher Dodd were also named as participants in news accounts regarding the negotiations. B. *Support For Northern Ireland Women's Coalition*

On March 20, Sen. Edward Kennedy spoke before the Senate regarding his recent meeting with two members of the Northern Ireland Women's Coalition. At the time, the two women were the *only two* women participating in the Northern Ireland peace talks. Sen. Kennedy also asked that a news article about the Coalition be printed in the record. C. *Support For 25th Anniversary Of Bloody Sunday*

On March 17, Sen. Robert Torricelli spoke before the Senate to commemorate the 25th anniversary of Bloody Sunday, at which time in Derry 14 civil rights marchers were killed by a British regiment. Torricelli urged the British government to recognize the innocence of those killed or injured and to work toward establishing justice for them and their families. (Source: *Thomas Internet site*)

12) *Congressional Hearing Regarding Northern Ireland Human Rights*

On June 24, the House International Relations Subcommittee on Human Rights held a hearing on the current human rights conditions in Northern Ireland. The subcommittee members, chaired by Rep. Christopher Smith, heard testimony from representatives of various human rights, legal, and Irish organizations. The Scorecard reflects those Congressional members who attended the hearing. 13) *Congressmen Visits To Northern Ireland Regarding Human Rights, Peace Process*

In early August, Rep. Chris Smith and staff visited Northern Ireland and London to meet with human rights leaders and to lobby the British government on a range of issues. The trip followed Smith's chairing of the June 24 hearing on Northern Ireland

human rights before the House International Relations Subcommittee on Human Rights. A previous Congressional trip abroad occurred in February, during which time members of the House International Relations Committee held discussions with representatives of the political parties in Northern Ireland. 14) *Congressional Letter To Tony Blair Regarding Plastic Bullets*

On June 27, a Congressional letter was written to Northern Ireland Secretary of State Mo Mowlam, urging an immediate ban on the use of plastic bullets. This action was initiated by Rep. Chris Smith, and stemmed from testimony on plastic bullets and other human rights violations in Northern Ireland presented at the June 24 hearing before the House International Relations Subcommittee on Human Rights. 15) *Congressional Letter Regarding Rerouting Unionist/Loyalist Marches*

On July 10, several Congresspersons sent a letter to British Ambassador Sir John Kerr, urging the British government to prohibit or re-route unionist and loyalist marches through nationalist neighborhoods. Their request came in the wake of severe security forces' abuses and civil unrest throughout Northern Ireland following the decision by the British government and the RUC to allow the Orange Order to parade along the Garvaghy Road in Portadown. 16) *H. Con. Res. 12: National Curriculum Regarding Irish Famine*

This resolution expresses the sense of Congress for the development of a model curriculum designed to educate elementary and secondary school-aged children about the Irish famine. The Department of Education would develop the model curriculum, which would be available to educational institutions and the public. Sponsor: Rep. Robert Menendez. Status: Referred to House Education and the Workforce Committee and House Early Childhood, Youth and Families Subcommittee; pending committee hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference)

17) *H.R. 150: MacBride Principles Of Economic Justice Act Of 1997*

This bill would amend the Anglo-Irish Agreement Support Act of 1986 to require that disbursements from the International Fund for Ireland ("IFI") are distributed in accordance with the MacBride Principles of economic justice. This would make MacBride for the IFI law as opposed to its current status, whereby it is renewed by successive Presidents. Sponsor: Rep. Eliot Engel. Status: Referred to Committee on

International Relations; hearings to be scheduled. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference) (Note: Last year, President Clinton issued directives to the Agency for International Development and the U.S. Observer for the IFI, effectively mandating MacBride for the IFI. Source: Irish-American Unity Conference)

18) *H.R. 178: Northern Ireland Fair Employment Practices And Principles Of Economic Justice Act Of 1997*

This bill would provide for adherence with the MacBride Principles of economic justice by U.S. persons doing business in Northern Ireland. Sponsor: Rep. Benjamin Gilman. Status: Pending Committee Hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference) (Note: The MacBride Principles have currently been passed in approximately 17 states and over 40 municipalities. At the federal level, MacBride was part of foreign aid package vetoed by President Clinton last year. (Source: Irish-American Unity Conference, Irish National Caucus, *Irish Voice*, and Irish Northern Aid Committee web sites)

19) *H.R. 1075: Northern Ireland Peace Act*

This bill would ban the sale or export of plastic bullets to the United Kingdom. The bill notes the widespread human rights-related criticism of the use of plastic bullets by the Northern Ireland security forces. Sponsor: Rep. Donald Payne. Status: Referred to House International Relations Committee; pending committee hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference)

20) *H.R. 1181: Free Trade Zone For Northern Ireland*

This bill would authorize the President to enter into a trade agreement establishing a free trade zone, among other conditions, concerning Northern Ireland and certain border counties of the Republic of Ireland. Sponsor: Rep. Martin Meehan. Status: Referred to House Ways and Means Committee; pending committee hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference) (Note: S.184 is a Senate version of this bill, which includes the MacBride Principles.)

21) *H. Res. 182: Congressional Concern Regarding Sectarian Marches*

This resolution expresses the concern of the House regarding recent sectarian marches throughout Northern Ireland. It also calls on the British government to prohibit marches in areas in which the residents are opposed to them. Sponsor: Rep. Joseph Kennedy. Status: Referred to House Committee on International Relations; pending committee hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference) (Note: Rep. Sue Kelly spoke before Congress on July 11 to express Congressional concern regarding this issue.)

22) ***S. 184: Northern Ireland Fair Employment Practices And Principles Of Economic Justice Act Of 1997***

This bill would provide for adherence with the MacBride Principles of economic justice by U.S. persons doing business in Northern Ireland. Sponsor: Sen. Alfonse D'Amato. Status: Pending Senate Finance Committee Hearings. (Source: *Thomas* Internet site, Irish American Unity Conference)

23) ***Membership In Irish Organizations***

The Ad Hoc Congressional Committee For Irish Affairs and the Friends Of Ireland are the two principle Congressional organizations devoted to monitoring and acting upon the current political situation and human rights conditions in Northern Ireland. The Scorecard records a "+" for each group that a particular Congressperson is a member. (Source: Membership lists received from offices of Reps. Thomas Manton and James Walsh)

ACTIONS BY OTHER KEY INDIVIDUALS

In addition to the Congressional action previously detailed, the following persons and actions deserve tribute:

- ★ Senior U.S. Administration officials met with Northern Ireland Minister of State **Adam Ingram** on August 6 to discuss economic development and the post-cease-fire peace process in Northern Ireland. Participants included National Security Council Deputy Assistant **Jim Steinberg**, **congressional staff members**, **U.S. trade and State Department representatives**, and Northern Ireland politicians **Jeffrey Donaldson** and **Mark Durkan**. A White House spokesman claimed the talks were "very positive." The scorecard notes with disappointment, however, a statement by Ingram to the press that the British government has no intention of banning the use of plastic bullets as they offer "the most effective means of containing public disorder situations." - ★ A group of prominent Irish-Americans who played a key role in brokering the original IRA cease-fire visited Northern Ireland in July and met with key politicians on both sides of the conflict. The group consisted of *Irish Voice* publisher **Niall O'Dowd**, Mutual American chief executive **Bill Flynn**, and businessman **Chuck Feeney**. Former Congressman **Bruce Morrison**, who was part of the earlier delegations, pledged his support for the group's work but was unable to attend due to scheduling problems. - ★ Professor **Padraig O'Malley**, of the John W. The late-May/early June conference, held near Cape Town, was attended by most Northern Ireland political parties, as well as several South African parties and organizations, including South African President **Nelson Mandela**. The conference allowed politicians to observe the parallels between Northern Ireland and South Africa, and to learn how South Africa resolved its political differences. The unionist parties and Sinn Fein, however, did not engage in direct political negotiations during the conference. The group also traveled to the Garvaghy Road in Portadown as part of a group of international human rights observers. - ★ The **Massachusetts House of Representatives** adopted a resolution sponsored by **Rep. Harold Naughton Jr. (D)** urging President Clinton to appeal to the British Prime Minister, unionist, and nationalist groups to call an end to violence. The resolution was in response to the rioting which took place throughout Northern Ireland following the Orange Order's march in Portadown on July 6.
