SUBJECT: PRIME MINISTER GUTERRES' WIFE DIED JANUARY 28

1. PORTUGUESE PRIME MINISTER ANTONIO GUTERRES' WIFE, LUISA AMELIA GUTERRES, DIED IN LONDON THIS MORNING FOLLOWING A LONG BATTLE WITH KIDNEY DISEASE. THE PRIME MINISTER IS EXPECTED TO ACCOMPANY HIS WIFE'S REMAINS BACK TO LISBON TODAY (WEDNESDAY), AND A FUNERAL IS CURRENTLY PLANNED FOR THURSDAY, JANUARY 29.
2. THE PRESIDENT AND MRS CLINTON WILL RECALL THAT THEY HOSTED THE GUTERRES AT THE WHITE HOUSE IN APRIL AND THAT MRS CLINTON HAD LUNCH WITH MRS GUTERRES WHEN THE FIRST LADY VISITED LISBON IN JULY.
3. ACTION REQUESTED: CONDOLENCE MESSAGES FROM U.S. OFFICIALS THAT HAVE MET PRIME MINISTER AND MRS GUTERRES, INCLUDING PRESIDENT AND MRS CLINTON, VICE PRESIDENT GORE, SECRETARY ALBRIGHT, AND SECRETARY COHEN, WOULD BE MOST APPRECIATED.
