Dear Colleagues,

1996:Q4 Inventories have come in about 9 billion weaker than the BEA had assumed. In addition, small downward revisions are likely for international trade and state and local construction. Therefore, it appears that real GDP growth in 96:Q4 will be revised down to about 4.0 percent growth (from 4.7 percent). Although more data will arrive before the Feb 28 the release of revised GDP, no other major adjustments are likely.

1997:q1 Motor vehicle sales (at a 15.36 million unit annual rate in January) were a bit on the strong side. MV production schedules are also up for the first quarter as a whole. The employment report was disappointing (because of the drop in the workweek). Retail sales are anemic. My best guess is 2.2 percent (plus or minus 2 percentage points).

In that context, I was wondering if the volatility of new businesses could lend some support to that rationale. If there is info asymmetry here, one would expect (a) interest rates to be too high, and (b) borrowing only by very risky firms. In other words (to bring coals to Newcastle), only the lemons borrow. I have colleagues who would ostracize me forever if it became known that I suggested anything that could be converted into a rationale for anything like the SBA, so please don't quote me!

This is to alert you to an issue that has come up in the TPSC (Trade Policy Staff Committee) on Japan telecoms and request your concurrence with my course of action. Dan Tarullo has requested that agency positions on this issue be cleared with principals. If possible, I would like a response this evening. USTR wants to tell FCC to put on hold two current applications from the two large Japanese telecoms firms, NTT and KDD, for certain services (related to international networks involving the U.S.) and to any further applications. This hold could last until the end of the year, when we would be obligated under to just signed WTO Agreement on Basic Telecoms (ABT) to approve the applications (although the U.S. could conceivably decide to take WTO-inconsistent actions to achieve a foreign trade objective).

USTR wants this for two reasons: (1) to provide leverage to negotiate a reduction or eliminations of Japan's restrictions on foreign ownership or directors for either NTT or KDD; (2) to provide leverage for a renewal of an agreement on procurement by NTT, which expires in September. In the ABT, Japan and Canada did not agree to allow foreign ownership of their dominant telecoms companies, unlike the U.S. and most other countries, but Japan agreed to continue to negotiate the issue. Therefore, reason 1 will be the stated reason to Japan, but 2 is likely to be where real progress will be made.

An important reason for this action is objection by Congressman Markey and Sen. Hollings about the ABT, that the U.S. did not get a good deal and that the agreement should be subject to Congressional approval. It is hoped that one or both will have their concerns assuaged by this action, which would allow the ABT to go forward without Congress attempting to conduct a review of the agreement. USTR would like our response this evening (the original deadline had been noon today, but they were tardy in returning my phone calls, and I was also in a

meeting much of the afternoon). I think we should agree to this action, but possible concerns are:

1. The interagency mandate to USTR would be open-ended, allowing them to ask FCC to delay approval (until year-end) of all NTT and KDD licenses. This would impede the ability of these companies to provide international telecoms services, raising costs to consumers of those services, including U.S. companies. We might ask USTR to go back to the TPSC on any future application received from NTT/KDD, so we can judge each case on its economic impact. But this would tie their negotiating hands and might be less satisfying to Congressional critics of the ABT.
2. One of the possible outcomes of the negotiation with the Japanese is an agreement that NTT and KDD would not invest in any U.S. telecommunication company above the ceiling share that foreign companies can invest in NTT and KDD. USTR is inserting language in the TPSC agreement that Treasury and CEA prefer a different outcome (raising the investment ceiling in Japan), but this still leaves investment restraints as a possible outcome, and in fact is the preferred outcome from the Japanese point of view. But it is not economically desirable to limit foreign direct investment in the United States.

Folks,

Last night, the Senate passed an extension of the aviation taxes through September 30. These taxes are: a 10 percent airline ticket tax; a 6.25 percent tax on air freight, and a \$6 per international departure tax. Since the Senate bill is exactly the same as the one passed by the House, the bill will go directly to the President, who is expected to sign it. The taxes go into effect 7 days after signing.

This probably will not be a big deal, though we might see airline prices increase as the excise tax is passed on to consumers. Any effect on the CPI should certainly be less than .1 percent, since the taxes raise only about \$6 billion per year.

Before I discuss my meeting with President Yeltsin, I want to say something about the budget.

I just finished a very productive meeting with the bipartisan leadership of the Senate and House Budget Committees. I repeated to them what I have told the nation: our first order of business must be to finish the job of balancing the budget, and doing it in a way that reflects the balance of our values. Recent statements by Republican leaders have given us new cause for hope that we can reach agreement this year to balance the budget.

[Today we began to build on that momentum. We agreed that my budget team, led by Erskine Bowles, Secretary Rubin, Director Raines, NEC chair Sperling, and legislative director Hilley, will begin to meet with their counterparts on the Senate and House budget committees. They will deal in detail with topics including Medicare, Medicaid and other entitlements; national defense, domestic

spending, revenues and other issues. Their goal is to narrow the issues so that when I meet with the bipartisan leadership after Congress, Easter Recess, we are ready to make rapid progress on the budget.]

We agree on the goal; we have agreed to a schedule to start discussions; now comes the hard work of writing a bipartisan agreement to balance the budget. We have circled around these issues long enough. Let's put aside partisanship for the American people. I am confident we will be able to do so.

Janet,

I met yesterday with Okita, Vice-Minister of the Japanese EPA, and several of his colleagues. We discussed, among other things, the role of the economic advisers in the annual APEC summit meeting. Based on what I learned, I would not recommend that you attend in Vancouver later this year. At most, if we wanted to try to build further momentum on what Joe started, then I would go.

The basic point is that most countries do not have Ph.D. economists in cabinet rank or even sub-cabinet rank positions, which makes it sound hopeless to get even approximate counterparts to CEA members from most countries. (Japan is the closest, i.e. Okita, and perhaps the Philippines and a few others.) Some countries, apparently Australia and New Zealand, are actively opposed. Canada doesn't have a natural counterpart; but we should ascertain their position eventually, because they are the host.

There is lots of time. We can discuss it with John when he gets back, monitor the situation, and later in the year sound out the other countries on whether they want to have a meeting around the APEC summit, and if so at what level of representation.

I tried to reach Janet after my meeting with Bennett Bertenthal but she was tied up in a meeting.
