The Baptist denominational winds are blowing hard and major changes are in the offing. Mr. Carter's announcement will do major damage to the SBC's desire to demand conformity among its constituent state conventions and churches. Therefore, it is virtually certain that SBC leaders will want to brand him a liberal whose Baptist leanings are not consistent with where they are. In addition, it would not be surprising for them to try and gain political leverage with the upcoming presidential election by bringing you, and possibly Vice-President Gore, into the situation as well.
