Once more, the philosophers of the Buenos Aires Yoga School have the honor of writing to you.

As you know, for several years we have been denouncing before U. S. authorities, from whom we've received constant and valuable support, the constant violations of human rights perpetrated against BAYS' members by the Argentine Judicial System.

Last Friday, October 27th, our delegation in Washington met with State Department Officials: Peter Higgins, Human Rights for Latin America, and Jeff Irwing, Argentina Desk Officer, and informed them in an extended interview, about the dangerous Stalinist domination of the Argentine Government.

Before the end of your presidential term that has brought so many successes to the ideals of democracy and progress that United States of America so strongly defends, we would like to request the honor of meeting with you in person to discuss the dangerous ideology that each day, unfortunately gains more ground in Argentina.

Dear Mr. President,
