BACKGROUND: Congressman Joseph Crowley's father, Joseph Crowley Sr., passed away Wednesday, December 27th as a result of a heart attack. He was 70 years old.

An Irish native, Mr. Crowley came to the United States in 1930. He was a Korean War Veteran, serving in the Army. Upon his return from the war, he became a detective for the New York Police Department. Mr. Crowley attended St. John's Law School while working for the NYPD, and passed the state bar in 1965. In 1977, he formed his own law firm, Crowley & Crowley, and has been a trial lawyer in Queens ever since. He was waiting for a proceeding at the U.S. Bankruptcy court at the time of his death.

Mr. Crowley is survived by his wife Eileen, four children; Congressman Joseph Crowley, Maura Martinez, Eileen Clinton, and Sean Crowley, and nine grandchildren.

The funeral took place on Tuesday, January 2, in Woodside, New York.
