EVENT: Working breakfast/bilateral

DATE: July 10, 1993

TIME: 8:00 am - 9:20 am

LOCATION: Ambassador's Residence

ATTENDEES: The President, Strobe Talbot, Anthony Lake, Nicholas Burns, President Yeltsin and (Russian officials)

Press: Photo Opportunity/ Closed Press for meetings.
Open press coverage for News Comments at conclusion of meetings.

Scenario: The President will walk to the Ambassador's residence departing the Okura Hotel at 7:45 a.m. Upon arrival, the President will greet Ambassador Armacost in the foyer and together with Ambassador Armacost will proceed to the arrival area at the front door to greet President Yeltsin. The greeting will be covered by a press pool.

President Clinton, President Yeltsin and Ambassador Armacost will proceed to the library for a brief greeting (official photos only) where they will be joined by Mr. Talbot, Mr. Lake, Mr Burns and three Russian aides. Ambassador Armacost will depart and at 8:15 a.m. the President will escort President Yeltsin to the small dining room where they will take their seats along with the other participants. Press pools will have a photo opportunity of the participants before breakfast is served.

The participants will have light breakfast during the meeting. At the conclusion of the meetings, President Clinton will escort President Yeltsin through the large dining room for a walk around the garden to a location where they will give comments to the press. Each President will speak from a presidential podium with headsets for simultaneous translation. At the conclusion of the press statements and answers, President Clinton will escort President Yeltsin around the garden, through the reception area and to the front door where President Yeltsin will board his motorcade and depart at 9:20 am.

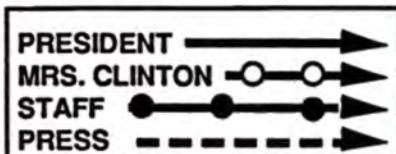
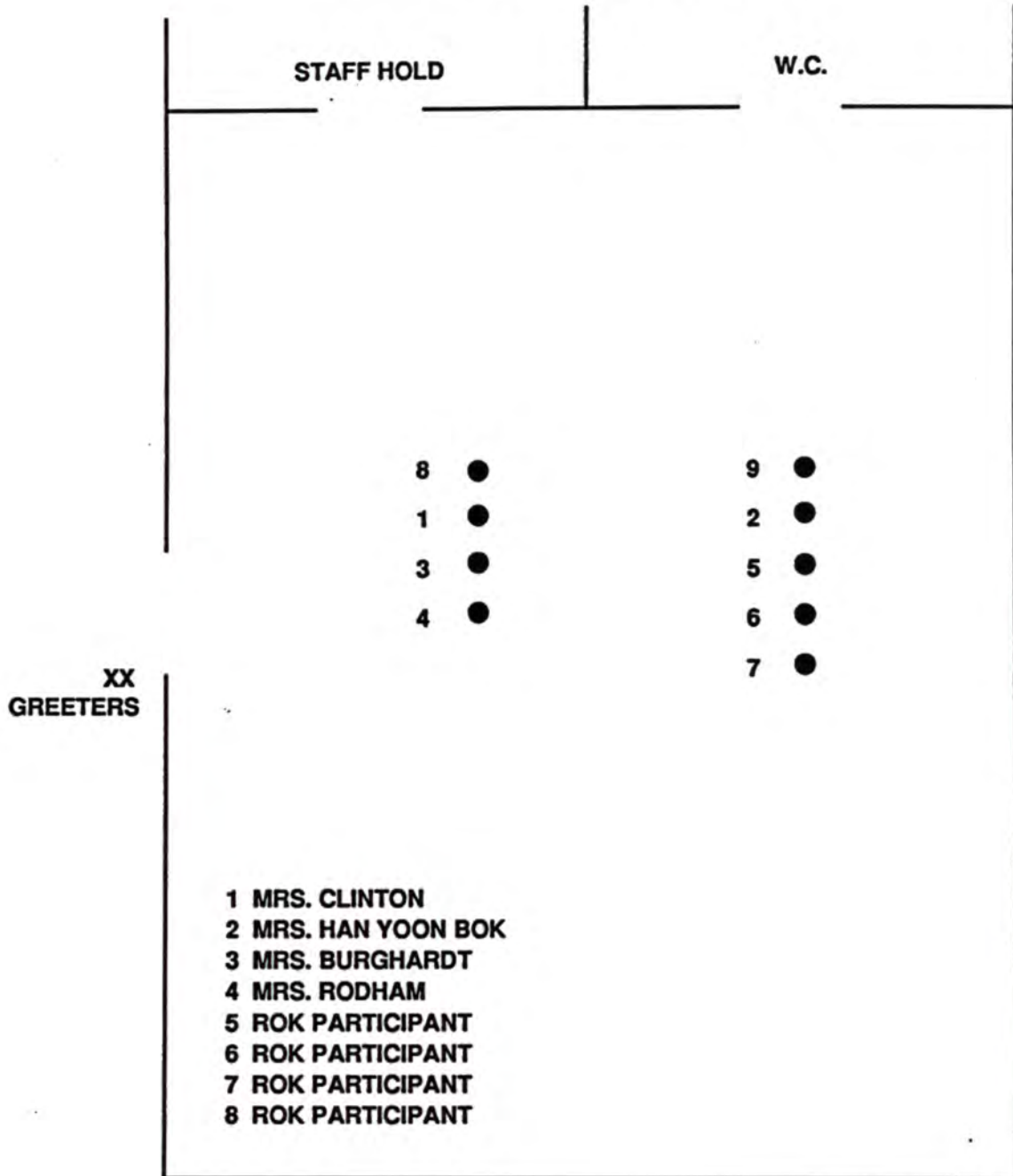

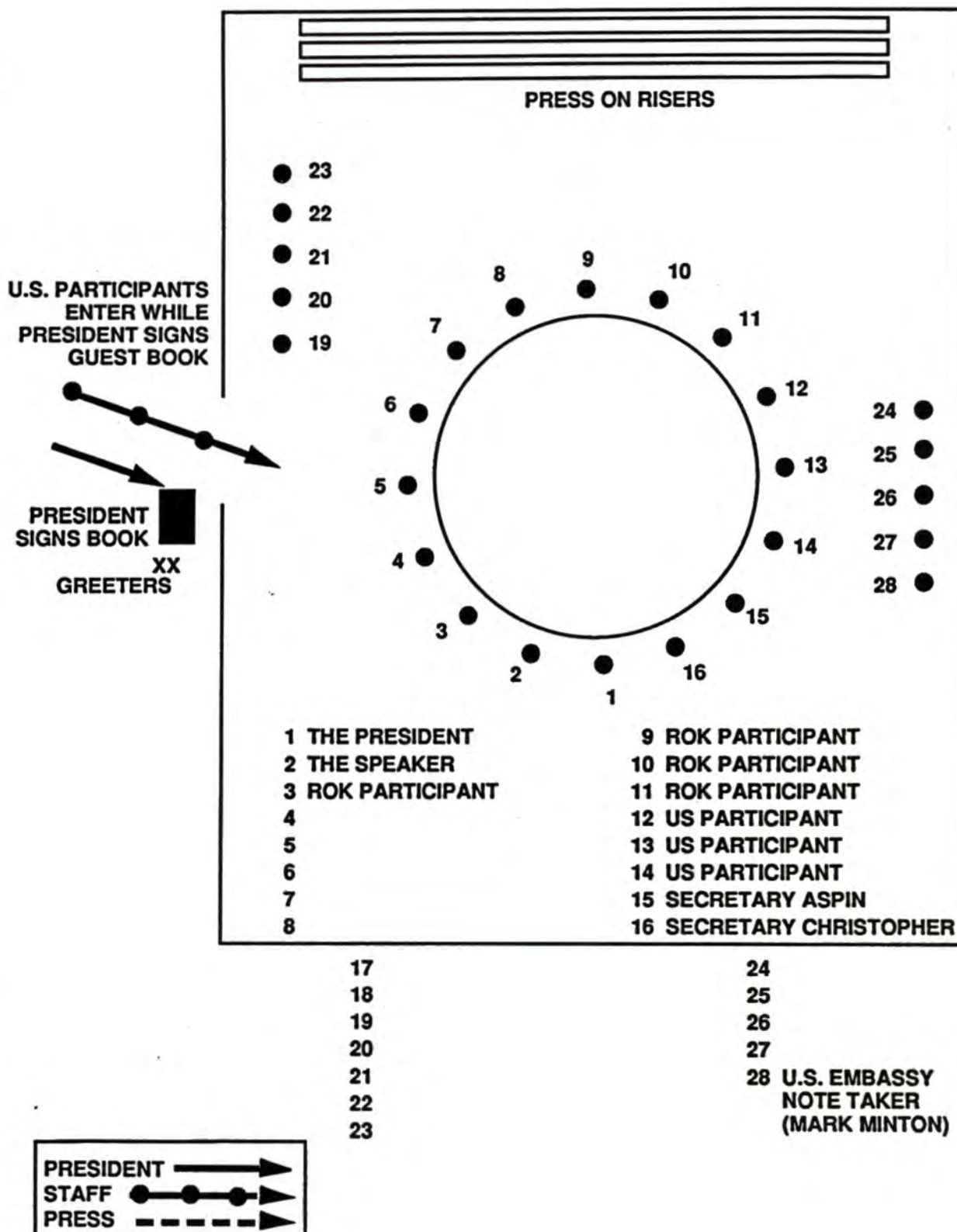
