President and Mrs. Clinton hosted the members of the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial Commission and major donors to the FDR Memorial construction fund at a reception at the White House today.

In welcoming the guests and commissioners, President Clinton, honorary chairman of the Commission, said, "I have always admired President Roosevelt. His presidency truly molded this century, and his political legacy profoundly shaped my own life. This Memorial will be a fitting tribute to his many contributions to our nation."

Senator Daniel K. Inouye, co-chair of the FDR Memorial Commission, said, "My co-chair, Senator Mark Hatfield, and I are very pleased that the construction of the FDR Memorial is under way. I personally will never forget that President Roosevelt was my Commander in Chief when I served in the military in World War II. President Roosevelt's great leadership and courage will be remembered forever in this magnificent Memorial."

The FDR Memorial Commission is conducting a \$10 million Capital Campaign, headed by David B. Roosevelt, grandson of President Roosevelt, and Jack Valenti, President and CEO of the Motion Picture Association of America. The Commission's goal is to raise most of the needed funds by the end of 1995, the 50th anniversary of President Roosevelt's death.

Major construction is beginning on the FDR Memorial, which will encompass seven and one-half acres at a site on the Tidal Basin between the Jefferson and Lincoln Memorials in Washington, D.C. The construction contract was awarded September 30, 1994, to William Walsh Construction of Rockville, Md. The projected completion date of the Memorial is late 1996.

As you know, when the FDR Memorial Commission had the photo opportunity with President Clinton in November, the President, in his capacity as the Honorary Chairman of the FDR Memorial Commission, agreed to host a private event at the White House in order to recognize high donors to the FDR Memorial.

We anticipate four or five people who will give gifts of \$500,000 and more to the Memorial fund. We would like for these people to be able to have fifteen minutes privately with the President before the reception for approximately twenty additional people begins.

The dates we would like for an afternoon event are: June 20, or June 27, 1994.

It is very important that we get confirmation of the date as soon as possible because there will be guests coming from Hong Kong and Taipei, Taiwan for the event and they must have time to make their travel arrangements.

Here are the addresses, places of birth and passport numbers we sent to the White House in preparation for the expected recognition event hosted by President Clinton.

**Background:**

**Dr. Ho** - Billionaire, owns hotels and casinos in Macau; owns ferry company; Dr. Ho established an astronautics training foundation in Hong Kong to promote international exchange between China and other countries. He pledged \$500,000 through Mrs. Chennault to the FDR Memorial, and upon receipt of an invitation to the White House event he will contribute \$250,000 with the second \$250,000 to be contributed in 1995.

**Mr. Wang** - He is second generation owner of the United Daily News in Taipei. He has already sent \$150,000 through Mrs. Chennault with the second \$150,000 to be contributed in 1995.

**Mr. Mou** - He has pledged \$300,000 through Mrs. Chennault. He owns the Land Group with offices in Beijing and New York City (copy of brochure attached.) On August 30, 1992 Mr. Mou gave a three hour interview to the New York Times about his business ventures in China. He appears to be a pioneering entrepreneur and capitalist. He is in tourism, investments, manufacturing and barter trade. Mrs. Chennault is holding a \$50,000 check from him.
