Dear Mr. Vorenberg:

I wish to thank you for your letter of March 24th.

Before the final blue prints are drawn up on the President's Commission on Law Enforcement I would like to present some very historic facts to the President and to the Crime Commission itself.

In the 1952-3 Presidential Campaign I submitted the answers to Congress, the answers for the root causes of crime and corruption and recommendations for its cure and prevention. In later years I sent the Justice Department \$16.00 worth of photostats of the original carbon copies to verify my charges to reduce the rising crime wave in the United States. Copies were sent to the House Judiciary Committee and also to the United States Senate.

I ask you and the President to utilize all of the resources I have at my own personal command to "repel the threat of crime to our well being."

My own personal national strategy for the prevention of crime in the United States was 13 years ahead and advanced over and beyond the comprehension and intelligence of the Congress of the United States and all of the law enforcement agencies combined.

Due to an unusual and unexpected nuclear age communication phenomenon on May 7, 1952, I have been privileged to be in possession of a very distinct and decisive and colossal advantage over the Congress, the Justice Department, all of the Attorney Generals and Governors of the United States and all of the "consulting 2, 200 law enforcement agencies in our nation with the astro intelligence I un-

expectedly received to and from the cosmos on May 7, 1952, in order to make a determined effort for the final blue prints and the successful conclusion for the President's Crime Commission, especially attacking crime at the roots.

Besides flying saucers in space today, I am in possession of a cosmic first report from Supernatural Headquarters for the success of the Crime Commission for the final blue prints, especially in the third-stage national strategy.

I do have the answers. Have had them for over 13 years. One especially was located in old Jewish Law several thousands of years ago, and this is why I asked President Johnson for a job on the subject compatible with my talents and abilities to conclude the draft on the Commissions Blue Prints.

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two months of research in the Library of Congress.

Congressman McGregor's Secretary had the Library of Congress to complete the search and I received their carbon copies, the complete report from the Library of Congress on vital and important legislation back to January 16, 1786.

I continued the search and my conclusions came out 100% + for the final blue prints for the success of the President's Crime Commission on Law Enforcement, the same blue prints I submitted to Congress in 1952, blue prints which Congress was unable to read or understand or comprehend.

(with answers complete)

In order to secure the right blue prints for the final draft of the President's Crime Commission, I have also spent more than 13,000 hours of my own personal spare time and money for the final conclusion of the Commissions work.

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I am not only in possession of the Master's Degree in astro intelligence for the root causes of crime in the third-stage national strategy, I am not only in possession of the ultimate answers for our \$27 Billion Dollar National Crime bill every year but I am also in possession of the boldest and strongest cosmic antidote known to man or all of civilization for the root causes of crime in the third-stage national strategy with a "clear plan for the future as well as the present." (2000 years in the future if the Lord will permit us sinful people to live that long here on earth.

I am in possession of a cosmic first which will "open opportunity and hope (which) will prevent crime and foster responsibility." LBJ.

I bombarded President Kennedy's Cabinet with my charges and President Kennedy's Chief Counsel, Theodore Sorensen asked me where I could verify some of my conclusions and charges on national education and I supplied him and the President with more than 20 typed pages of facts from some of the worlds leading scholars and our nations leading forefathers, evidence and facts, bold facts which would reduce and prevent crime in our nation and foster the highest national responsibility, an asset for our nation and for the rest of mankind.

In the President's Message to Congress on Crime of March 9, 1966, on page 11... -he said: "We are committed to these goals because they are right". The Creator of the Universe demands that they be right.

The President's National Strategy being a three-stage strategy.

The third-stage is the stage of Cosmic astro-intelligence I am in possession of. The Master's Degree in Cosmic intelligence to attack crime at its roots from which it springs.

I am capable of filling the third-stage gap with the right answers and I dont mean maybe or perhaps.

I am able to fill the third-stage gap with the answers which the President dont have yet. Flying saucers or no flying saucers.

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The scientists in the free world seemed to have no choice but to go forward in secrecy with the unfolding of their awful plans. They had not begun with any such end in mind; and they had not dreamed they would continue with the quest for an atomic explosion after it was made plain, at the time of the overrunning of Germany, that the Germans neither possessed nor were anywhere near possessing a nuclear weapon. But even that was not the end. After the power of the bomb had been made manifest against Japan, there were the still greater powers of fusion waiting to be loosed.

This book deals at length with the moral factors of the atomic age. From this comes much of its controversial nature. Our society has not entirely accepted, even now, the idea that scientists should judge the results of their work and determine the ends to which it should be put. Research and discovery for its own sake has been what was asked of them; and the rest of the citizens, working within the dogmas of the national state, were expected to shape such policies as they saw fit. But the revolution in physics inevitably shifted the burden. The scientists found themselves compelled to make explicit, first to the chief statesmen and then to the public, the significance of what they were doing; they began to feel their way toward the limits and conditions under which they would continue their search. They were inexperienced; they were embarking on a new terrain, and it is no wonder that strains and tensions arose not only between the public and the scientists, but within the scientific community itself.

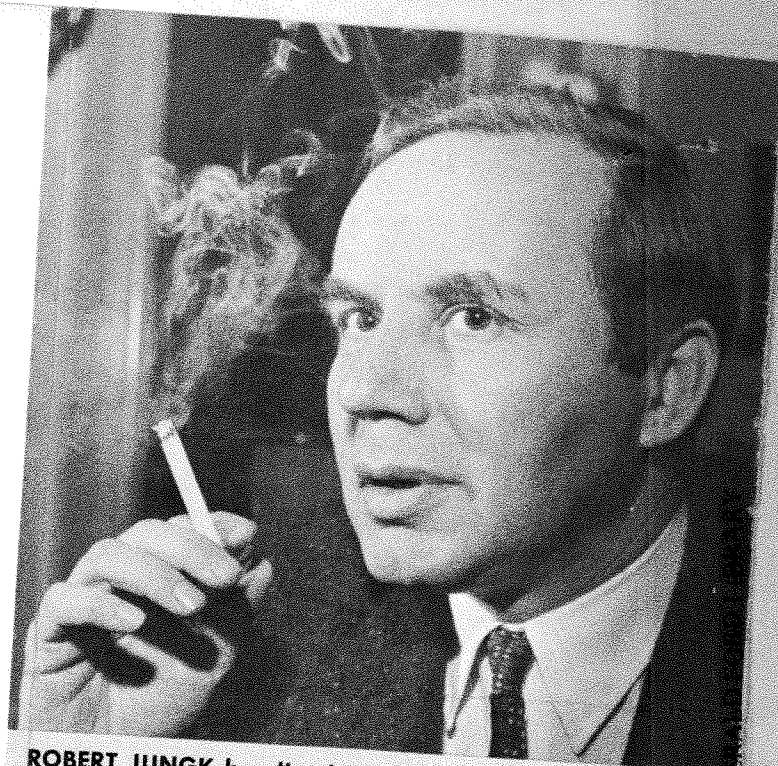
Some of Mr. Jungk's own evaluations must inevitably be challenged. One cannot but feel that he attributes to the German physicists a degree of moral sensitivity which, in different circumstances, would not have characterized them. If Hitler had presented them with the means to make an atom bomb, would they have held back? Our own physicists, despite an underlying horror, could not resist the "technically sweet" prospects of thermo-nuclear development. Moreover in upholding the right of the scientists to their own judgments, Mr. Jungk arrives at a rather tortuous

interpretation of Robert Oppenheimer's role. While fully admitting Oppenheimer's genius and ability, he pictures him as having let down the scientific community through his relations with the men of power in government. It is usually charged, on the contrary, that he let down the government through his indifference to its smaller concerns and restrictions. In fact, Oppenheimer was the scientist who, more subtly than any other, pioneered a new relationship between the scientist and the citizen; it was inevitable that he should be assailed from both sides.

England's role in the later phases of atomic development appears to be minimized; and of course the obscurity surrounding the Soviet scientists cannot be pierced. Yet despite such flaws, the book remains a notable achievement. It is hard to imagine any single volume which could more strikingly bring home to the citizen the unique character of his age or more vividly and humanly recall some of its greatest moments.

ROBERT JUNGK has lived a life symbolic of our times.

THE AUTHOR of *Brighter Than a Thousand Suns* is a reporter of our times; he has also been part of the history about which he writes. Born in Berlin of Austrian Jewish parents, he was nineteen when Hitler came to power. The day after the Reichstag fire he was arrested for anti-Nazi activities. Released (because of good fortune and good friends), he went to Paris to study at the Sorbonne. Two years later, although deprived of his German nationality and of all status, he returned to the Reich illegally to start an underground press service. A year later he was forced to flee again, this time to Czechoslovakia, where he founded another anti-Nazi information bulletin. When Prague fell in 1939 he transferred his activities to Paris. When Paris fell in 1940 he transferred them to Switzerland.

HERE AGAIN he was arrested and interned, in 1943, because his anti-Nazi writings were too strong for neutral nerves. He was soon released through the offices of an American friend, and in 1944 and 1945 he was Central European correspondent for the *London Observer*. Meanwhile he completed his much-disturbed education, taking his degree at Zurich. After the war he covered most of the international conferences in the old and new world for Swiss and other European publications. A citizen of the United States since 1950, Dr. Jungk now makes his home in Los Angeles. His articles and books have been published in more than a dozen countries. His much-discussed and highly praised work, *Tomorrow is Already Here*, was a Book Find Club selection several years ago.

ON RARE OCCASIONS one picks up a book which leads one, quietly and without fuss, into a new realm of vision and understanding. This is such a book. We have all of us lived through the birth of the atomic age; its great moments have been part of the news which we avidly devoured. Yet the inwardness of its discoveries, the underlying character of its decisive scenes and personages, have been largely beyond our reach. We knew we were living through history; but all we really got, like the shadows on Plato's cave, were the large headlines and the loud voices on TV. Now a skilled journalist takes us back over the story of the atomic scientists, beginning with the revolution in the theoretical basis of physics which occurred at the end of the first world war. He carries us through its successive stages with an eye for detail and a mind unusually alert to the moral dilemmas of the period.

Mr. Jungk's book has been published in Germany and in Great Britain. It has been read widely in both countries and has been the focus of controversy. In the United States the controversy will certainly re-echo; it can be predicted that the wide readership will also be repeated. For here is a new area of history opened up, a large body of facts brought out of the realms of privacy and obscurity. Men and women whose names we have known (yet often scarcely know) step onto the lighted stage, playing their parts before us as they will without question continue to play them as long as the history of this age is written and read. The generals and the statesmen, the party leaders and diplomats, have held the spotlight. Now the scientists come into their own.

It might have been guessed that the story of the atomic scientists, when it was unearthed and recounted, would be a fascinating one. For as the twentieth century entered upon its third decade physics was the field of intellectual pioneering which drew the boldest and most imaginative minds. Men who might have turned elsewhere—for the best of them had diverse gifts—came to this fountain to drink. It was here that everything seemed to be made new. At Cambridge, England, under Ernest Rutherford, in Copenhagen under Niels Bohr, in Göttingen under Max Born and others, the candles were lit which were eventually to blaze in the awe-inspiring explosions over the sands of New Mexico and the cities of Japan. But at this time such consequences were far from the minds of the scientists, still working within the unquestioned assumption that scientific discovery is by itself good and that progress in knowledge is necessarily progress toward virtue and truth.

Mr. Jungk is at his best in describing the happy, creative period of the twenties. At Göttingen, in particular, it seemed that men's minds were freed and that matter was as an open book to be read. That period, however, passed quickly enough. From Russia came disturbing indications that the new approach to physics was not in line with Marxist materialism and was therefore to be condemned. In Germany, National Socialism began its ugly work. Scientific research was disrupted and many of the best men went into exile.

As a result of Nazism the scientists faced for the first time the realization that from freedom of intercourse among them might come the destruction of free inquiry, and indeed of civilization itself. Hitler was advancing into war, amid dread that he might be the first to achieve an atom bomb.

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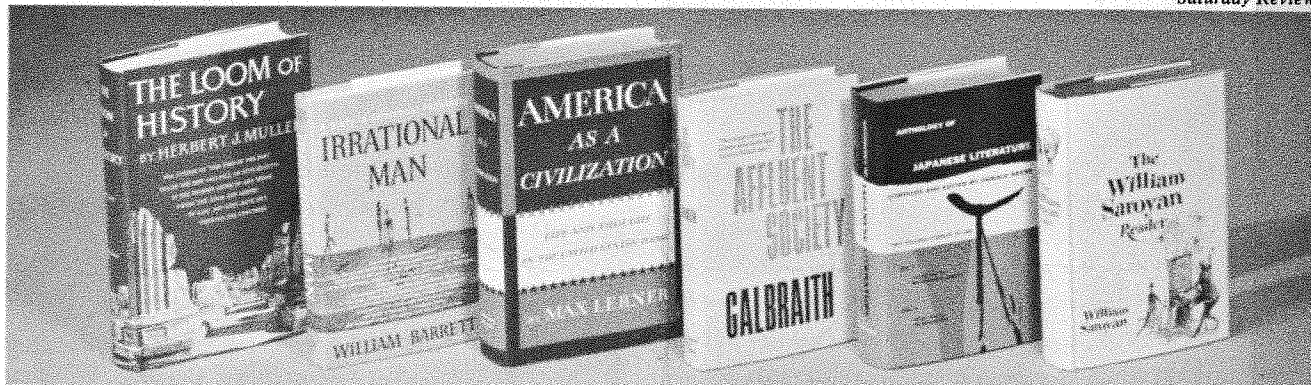
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# Former Publisher Tells Of Seeing Flying Saucer

WICHITA FALLS, Texas (AP)—Friends call Eddie Laxson, 56, a "calm, solid sort" and that's what the former newspaperman wants to stay.

So when Laxson saw what he described as a fish-shaped flying saucer, he decided to say nothing about it. But then he talked to C. W. Anderson, a truck driver, and decided to tell his story. Anderson said he also saw the strange craft.

"It takes more courage to report a thing like this than it does to forget it," he said. "I know people will say that Laxson is durned crazy. But that's what I saw."

Laxson was driving west on U.S. 70 in South Oklahoma about 5 a.m. Wednesday. "I saw what I first believed to be a huge

van, or a house being moved, stalled on the highway," he related. "I got this impression because of red lights that flashed on and off.

"SINCE I COULDN'T get by it, I parked my car about 100 yards away and walked toward the object, thinking that I might render some assistance.

"As I got closer, I saw that the vehicle was in the shape of a perch fish, seen from the side. I noticed also a plastic bubble in the front. In the side I made out the figures TL4 with the last two letters 38." He said the figure between the 4 and 3 was either 7 or 1 but he could not be sure.

"When a man wearing what appeared to be a mechanic's hat, with the brim rolled up, climbed a ladder into the object, I thought about the camera I carried in my car and turned to get it," he said.

"But just then the object rose from the ground with the sound of hissing geese or a welding torch and took off toward Red River to the south."

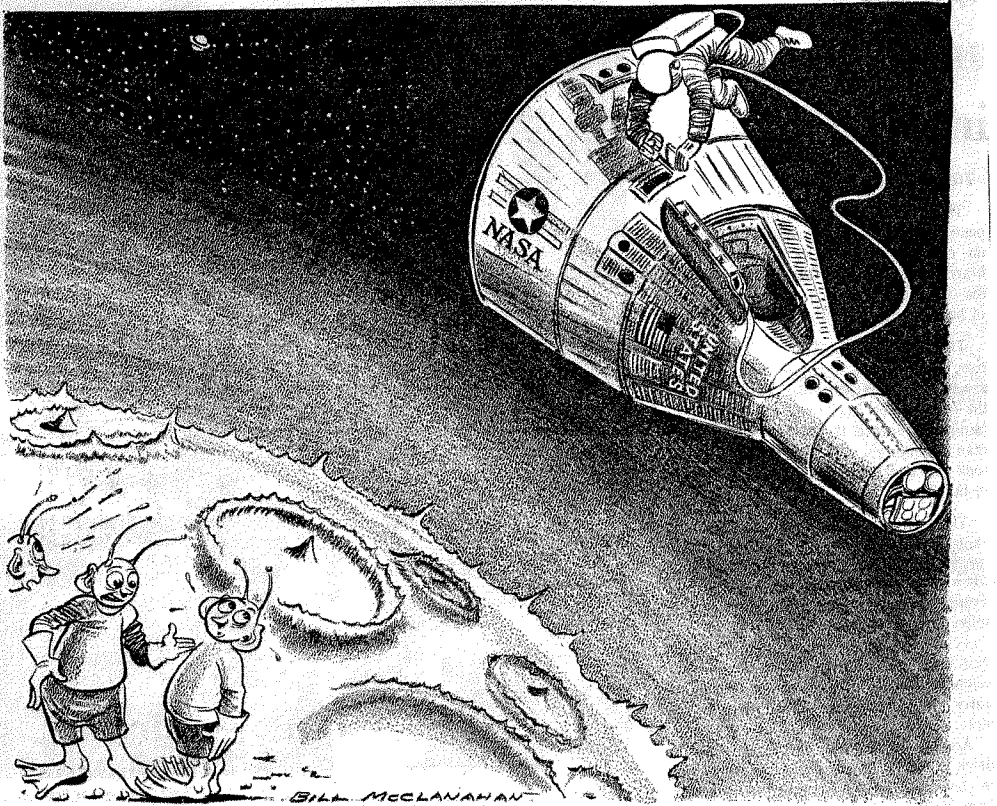
LAXSON HAD MADE up his mind not to tell the story, he said, but about a mile down the highway he came upon Anderson standing beside the truck which the Snyder, Okla., resident drives for Mangum Oil & Gas Co.

Anderson said he, too, had watched the strange flying object and that he believed it had been following him. He said he watched it in his rear-view mirror for several miles. The truck driver said the object's lights were intense and that three or four red lights were on the side of the vehicle.

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## The Saga of the Saucer

# Is Someone Up There Really Watching?

THOSE 87 COEDS, their dean, 12 police- men and 40 other assorted and sundry Michigan citizens—can they all be seeing things? Did a football-shaped spacecraft made of waffled material and covered with antennas and linking lights zoom over Ann Arbor and land in farmer Frank Mannor's swamp?

The Air Force sent its top Unidentified Flying Object (UFO) adviser, Dr. H. Allen Hynek, to the scene to find out. But it's a good bet that we'll never know for sure.

Of the 10,000 UFO investigations it has conducted since it first began looking for ghost ships in 1947, the Air Force has never publicly admitted that there might—just maybe—be such a thing as a "flying saucer." It has been unable to explain at least 647 of the UFO sightings, but staunchly maintains that they could be written off as known phenomena, either natural or man-made, if more information were available.

BUT HYNEK is not so sure.

Since that day in 1878 when John Martin, a Denison, Texas, farmer, sighted the first UFO, the number of sightings has grown and the reliability of the people making the reports has improved. Since then an impressive number of observations have been described by airline pilots, radar operators, police, university professors and other folk likely to be technically sophisticated enough not to be fooled by a vagrant weather balloon.

Hynek explains that "the level of intelligence of the observers of UFOs is certainly at least average and, in many cases, decidedly above average. In some cases, embarrassingly above average."

Last July a spate of sightings was

reported in South America. The best eyewitness account came from a Peruvian chemist and his wife.

They said they saw a bright flashing object land on a hill near their ranch. They claimed it stayed on the ground for 45 minutes and then zoomed off in a burst of speed. They rushed out to investigate the spot where it landed and found singed plants, overturned rocks and a blackened area.

A group of farmers supported the couple's report. And, indirectly, so did a body of Peruvian scientists which had assembled in Lima to study the flight of Mariner IV, the U.S. space probe which took pictures of the planet Mars.

The organization, Peruvian Institute of Interplanetary Relations, issued a statement saying that flying saucers did exist and that South American observatories had been on a 24-hour alert for most of the month trying to track down one of those whatever-they-were.

UFOs CAN BE found in the Encyclopaedia Britannica between "unicorn" and "unified field theory," a rather appropriate setting that ranges from myth to unproved scientific hypothesis. But can we continue to deny the possibility of interplanetary travel a great deal more sophisticated than ours? In an age when we aim giant missiles at the moon, the UFO syndrome is getting harder to scoff at.

The 5,000-member National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP) is, perhaps, not the most scientifically oriented group in the nation. But neither is it a madcap group of amateur bird watchers given to strange visions.

NICAP maintains a full-time staff to examine UFO reports, one goal apparently being to interest Congress in a full-scale investigation. Spokesmen for the organization say they have reports of UFOs flying in formation, pacing airliners, appearing to maneuver with a purpose and reacting to such stimuli as a spotlight being flashed on them.

They recall reports that UFOs have been tracked on radar at speeds up to

nearly 9,000 m.p.h.—and then have made 90-degree turns at those speeds, a complete impossibility for earth craft. These observations, according to NICAP, also discount meteors because meteors last only for seconds in the earth's atmosphere and some UFOs have been tracked for more than an hour.

IN HIS BOOK, "Anatomy of a Phenomenon," French-born astronomer Jacques Vallee declares that "either an entirely new type of mental aberration . . . has taken an important place in the life of our civilization, or the UFO phenomenon is unique in nature . . . and thus deserves a special investigation."

In calling for an unbiased scientific probe of the UFO, Vallee can flash a handful of impressive credentials. He is a data analyst, a consultant to the National Aeronautics and Space Administration on its Mars-mapping project and a former research associate at McDonald Observatory, near Fort Davis in West Texas.

Such an investigation might earn great dividends for this nation. For if there is life somewhere out there, living beings who regularly inspect our planet, isn't it a bit foolish for us to try to get to the moon?

Wouldn't it be wiser to find out why whoever-they-are make the effort of flying their funny little machines over farmer Mannor's swamp? Wouldn't it be smarter to try to make contact with one of the visitors—if they really exist—to find out what the devil they're doing here on earth?

The mere suggestion of such an approach is incredible, even to this type-writer-bound muser. But nevertheless, it is entirely possible that someone up there is watching.

And those who would scoff and sputter at such a suggestion are directed to those immortal words of English Astronomer Royal Sir Richard van der Riet Woolley, who glanced upward at the skies early in 1957—just before the Russians launched the first Sputnik—and declared: "Space travel is utter bilge."

# THE PRESS, UFOs, AND THE AF

Mr. Bulkley S. Griffin, veteran Washington news correspondent for several New England newspapers, recently made two visits to Project Blue Book, AF UFO investigative agency. Mr. Griffin, highly respected by the Washington press corps for his careful research, has periodically checked on the UFOs and AF explanations since 1957.

In a November series of six newspaper articles, Mr. Griffin made these points: The AF is deliberately misleading the public. Its persistent explaining-away of UFOs as stars, balloons, and other ordinary objects is increasing public suspicion of AF answers. The AF "explanations" of recent key sightings, such as the Exeter, N.H. close-range observation of a huge hovering UFO, simply do not make sense.

Because of Mr. Griffin's calm, reasoned approach, we hope to publish in the next issue interesting sidelights on his Project Blue Book visits and several enlightening AF statements.

Meantime, here are a few other press statements indicating the increased rejection of official answers.

Seattle Times: "Do you ever get the feeling that when it comes to flying saucers, the Air Force makes its denials six months in advance?"

Dallas Morning News: The AF says all sightings can be explained in terms of known phenomena and then adds that it can't explain 633 of the reports it has had. Which reminds us of the English Astronomer Royal, who spoke up in 1957 just before the Soviet Union startled the world with its first sputnik launching: "Space travel is utter bilge."

Springfield, Ohio, Sun: "...the public is entitled to the best answers available. Possibly a national hearing on the matter,

long sought by dedicated saucer-watchers, wouldn't be too bad an idea."

Meriden, Conn., Journal: "...if we can whiz things at the moon and other planets, it is possible that other planets are whizzing things by earth.... There are many reports in USAF files made by qualified pilots who, in flight, have encountered UFOs with fantastic flight patterns. These officers are not quacks, nor are many of the intelligent people who have spotted phenomenal objects in the sky."

Medford, Oregon, Mail Tribune: "If some of these flying objects are indeed interplanetary spacecraft, it is logical to assume that government officials, assuming they do have such evidence, may be keeping the news quiet for fear that a sudden disclosure might have drastic emotional and economic effects."

Shawville, Quebec, Equity: "There is a strong belief that the military chiefs know more about unidentified flying objects than they are letting on, but are keeping it a well-guarded secret so as not to panic the public."

Wichita Eagle: "The subject of UFOs remains not only an area of sustained interest but one which legitimately demands additional investigation."

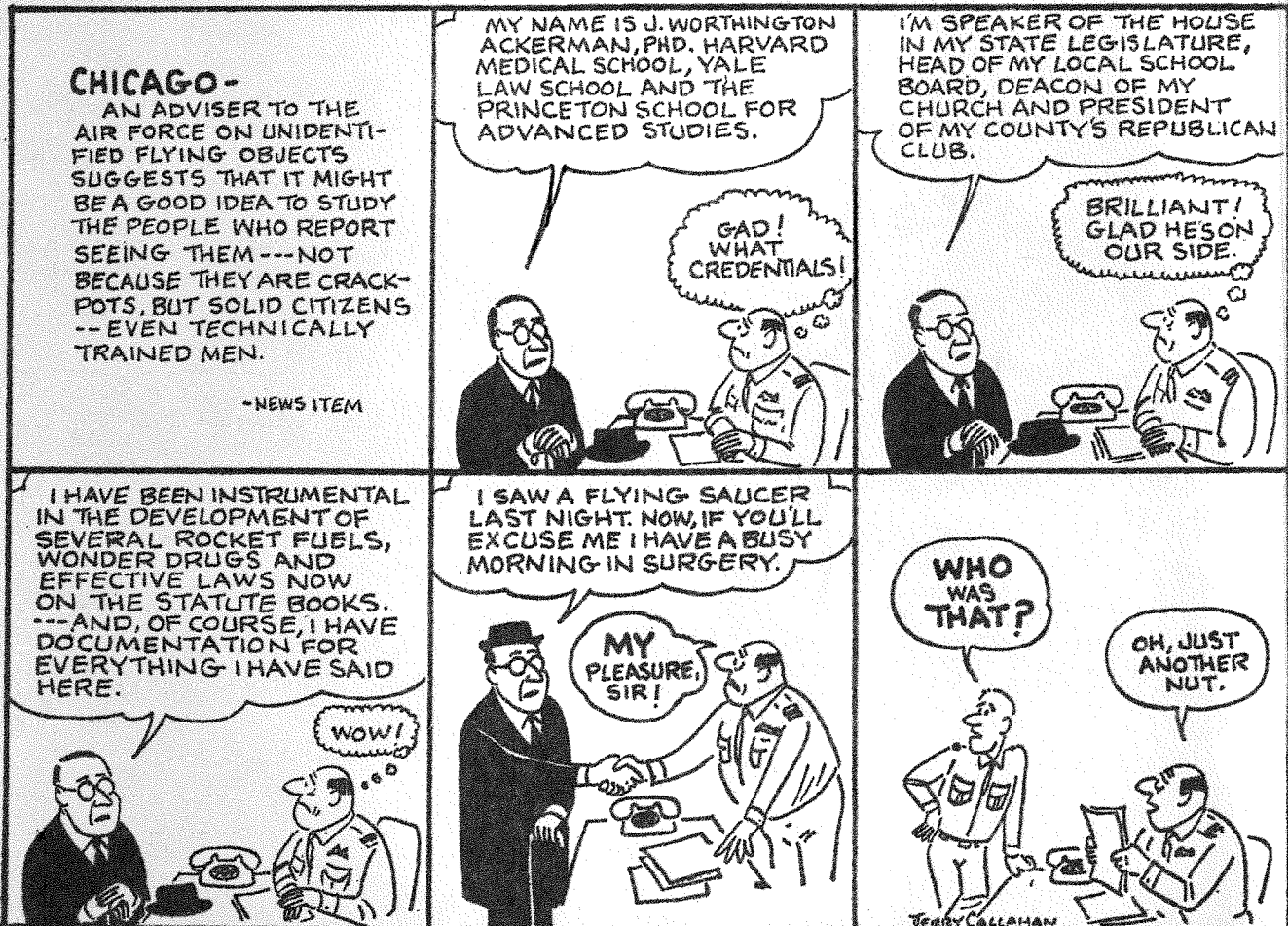
Cascade, Idaho, News: "The official government policy is to follow the well established practice of denying the existence of anything that it can't explain... There is absolutely no reason to deny the UFOs existence because we don't understand them."

The Coos Bay, Oregon, World: "We think the time has come when the Air Force's knowledge of these objects and the results of the investigations which have been carried out should be made public."

(Romans 3:10.) My paralyzed arm was healed instantly, and hate was taken out of me; when I became weightless (and yet I believed I was caught between some kind of a flying saucer gravitation and the earth's gravitation) which caused weightlessness, and what I felt was not of this earth. After three newspaper items came out about this UFO, and what happened to me for the next three years, neither I nor anyone else even suggested that this may be the Lord's work until after the mystery was revealed to me three years later. Now read carefully.

To begin with, I left on a trip on December 23, 1956 and I told the following person, "I'll be back in three months." I returned on March 22nd. This person died the 23rd (3 months to the day); and while the dying person's head lay on my arm, in the hospital, it left a long numb spot in that arm the instant death took place. This felt like a rope about a foot long had entered my arm. I believe this was a demon. I did not say this in my 1st and 2nd editions for obvious reasons. No one likes the word "demon", but it is in the Bible. My doctor could do nothing to help! It only got worse during the next three years. Several weeks before this arm was healed, the fingers began to twitch and tremble. I had no control of it. I would lie on it at night and massage it during the day. I started to attend UFO and flying saucer meetings. I became Coos Bay area representative for the Aerial Phenomena Research Group of Seattle, Washington, until... my UFO mystery was revealed three years later in September, 1962, at a crusade in Portland, Oregon. This was my first experience and I was skeptical. We were asked to concentrate on God for our greatest needs. I didn't get my greatest needs but I did get my greatest answer; when for some unknown reason I looked up and silently said, "Oh God, who art Thou?" Then suddenly my entire left arm which had been healed felt like a sparkling electric contact; yet wonderful! And then suddenly I heard these words, "How did you like your answer?" This took me by surprise. I did not intend to ask that question. "Oh God, who art Thou?" This didn't make sense. Suddenly I knew God changed my question then answered it by using my left arm, and then asked me (perhaps through someone near by), "How did you like your answer?", because then I remembered (three years back) the UFO experience of September 27, 1959 when my left arm was healed by a miracle. God's answer was fool-proof! Three things took place here which jolted my belief. Remember, satan is a liar, a deceiver, and creates fear. His UFOs, if any, would only be counterfeit, deceiving and fearful, to get your eyes off God's real UFOs and keep you from looking up. God's word says, "Look up, and lift up your heads; (Luke 21:28). These flying rolls, wheels, fire-chariots and other UFOs in the Bible, and my testimony, get many interpretations. I had a shaking dream with visions about Jesus which inspired me to write. I felt this was a warning and that the explanation of this would be revealed if my heart, mind and soul were cleansed and ready for it. So I accepted an invitation to a small Pentecostal church. My mother was a Polish Catholic and my father was a German Lutheran. I was nothing because I had it from all sides, which made me skeptical and very suspicious. A Medical Doctor, who was a Baptist, happened to be speaking at this mixed meeting, and the way this doctor spoke surprised me so, because I once had a dislike

This is in answer to your letter of October 15, 1964.

I am happy to be able to verify for you the newspaper report quoting me as saying, in effect, that Zamora's story was simply told and told without any intent to perpetrate a hoax. The story was indeed told by a man who obviously was frightened badly by what he did see. I am not absolutely certain that the wording of the quote is precise, but certainly the sense is.

I would further confirm that I made the statement that we had no evidence to lead us to believe that we were being visited by spaceships from other planets. We do have a few sightings like the Socorro sighting which are extremely difficult to explain. In fact, we do not yet have an explanation for the Socorro sighting, but that fact alone does not entitle us, I believe, to jump to the conclusion that we have interplanetary visitors. It is of interest, and it is quite necessary from a scientific standpoint, however, to look carefully into such cases to attempt to find out what the physical cause for the report was. If a sufficient number of such sightings occur, we should look for a pattern which, in turn, could lead us to the eventual solution. I wish I could, for my own peace of mind, dismiss the Socorro sighting as a hoax or a hallucination, but in all honesty I cannot.

I trust this will be of some help to you. Should your psychiatrist friend wish to get in touch with me directly, please ask him to feel free to do so.

# UFO Expert Probes NM Flying Object

SOCORRO (AP)—An astronomer from the Dearborn Observatory at Northwestern University was in Socorro today to examine the secluded hill where a policeman reported seeing a mysterious, egg-shaped unidentified flying object.

Dr. J. Allen Hynek, special UFO consultant to the Air Force, was sent to New Mexico after a rash of reports.

He was to visit the place where officer Lonnie Zamora said he spotted the object Friday.

Zamora said the object he saw was a brilliant white. He said there was a red marking on it like an upside down V with three lines across the top, through the middle and at the bottom. He said that from a distance there appeared to be two figures in white coveralls outside the object. It flew off with a roar when he approached, Zamora said.

Since Zamora's sighting several reports have been made to authorities including one from a youth who said he fired several shots at something about 100 feet in the air near Edgewood.

T Sgt. David Moody of the Aerial Phenomena Branch at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, is in New Mexico to assist Dr. Hynek, a Wright-Patterson spokesman said.

An Albuquerque grade school girl who was treated for face burns Tuesday, Sharon Stull, 10, told police she had been looking at an egg-shaped object hovering in the air near her school.

Sharon, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Max Stull, told police Lt. C. K. Jolly a "queer looking thing" bounced up and down in the sky while she watched. Jolly said Sharon's sister, Robin, 8, also saw the object but did not watch it continuously.

Sharon's physician said the

girl "saw something and it burned her."

The girl insisted the sun was at her back while she was watching the object.

At Tucson, Ariz., the director of the Aerial Phenomena Research Organization said she believes intelligent beings from another planet made several landings in New Mexico in the past few days.

"We are convinced the Socor-

ro policeman saw what he said he saw," Coral Lorenzon, the director, said after her return from investigating the Socorro report.

The organization was formed by Mrs. Lorenzon in 1952 and she says it now has nearly 800 members around the world. She says there are some 6-12 such incidences a year and she believes they are made by beings from another planet.

### Air Force UFO Expert to Check 'Saucer' Reports

SOCORRO (AP) — Dr. J. Allen Hynek, special unidentified flying object consultant for the Air Force, arrived in Socorro Tuesday night to begin his investigation of a Socorro policeman's report that he saw a mysterious flying object last Friday.

Dr. Hynek said he hoped to talk to the policeman, Lonnie Zamora, and then visit the site where Zamora says he saw the object this morning.

Dr. Hynek, of the Dearborn Observatory at Northwestern University, said he would decide whether to visit Espanola, where another object was reportedly spotted over the weekend, after his investigation of the Socorro incident.

He said he had not been advised by the Air Force if his presence here indicates that the government has eliminated the possibility of U. S. aircraft having caused the reports.

Capt. Hector Quintanilla, chief of the Aerial Phenomena Branch at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, said T. Sgt. David Moody of the office already was in New Mexico and would assist Dr. Hynek in the investigation. **Fired at Object**

The most recent report of the objects came early Tuesday morning from State Policeman Tommy Richardson of the US-66 community of Moriarty.

He said he had a call from Don Adams of Edgewood, near Moriarty, who told of seeing an object about 100 feet off the ground. He said it appeared to be a fluorescent or green-colored glowing object.

Adams told the officer he drove his car under the object and his car stalled. The youth reported he then got out and fired six shots at the object, reloaded and fired again.

The report was another in a series which have kept New Mexico and military authorities busy since Zamora's original report Friday. The reports, until Tuesday, had come from points following a line from south of Truth or Consequences to an area near Espanola.
