Washington Hilton Hotel, October 17

Planning by a national Black GOP Citizens Committee is presently underway to hold a \$100 per plate fund-raising dinner for President Ford on Friday, October 17, 1975. It is anticipated that two-thousand Americans--black and white-- will attend this kick-off event on behalf of the President. Tentative plans call for turning the money over to whatever campaign committee the President has designated at that time. Bill Casselman is presently researching the financial guidelines which this national group will use. Our office is working closely with Warren Rustand to assure that the President will be in the country and able to attend this event. While the dinner will not be held under the auspices of the Republican National Committee, the individual supporters in the various states represent a nucleus of the people we will look to in 1976 for campaign support.

If there are no major objections, we would like to cash Flip Wilson's due bill for this event. (see attachment)
