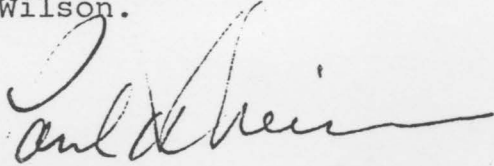
MEMORANDUM FOR STANLEY S. SCOTT

This responds to your request that we analyze and prepare comments on materials developed by the Cooperative College Development Program of the Phelps-Stokes Fund. Please excuse the delay.

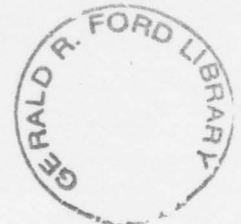
Attached is an analysis which indicates:
