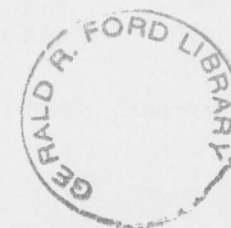
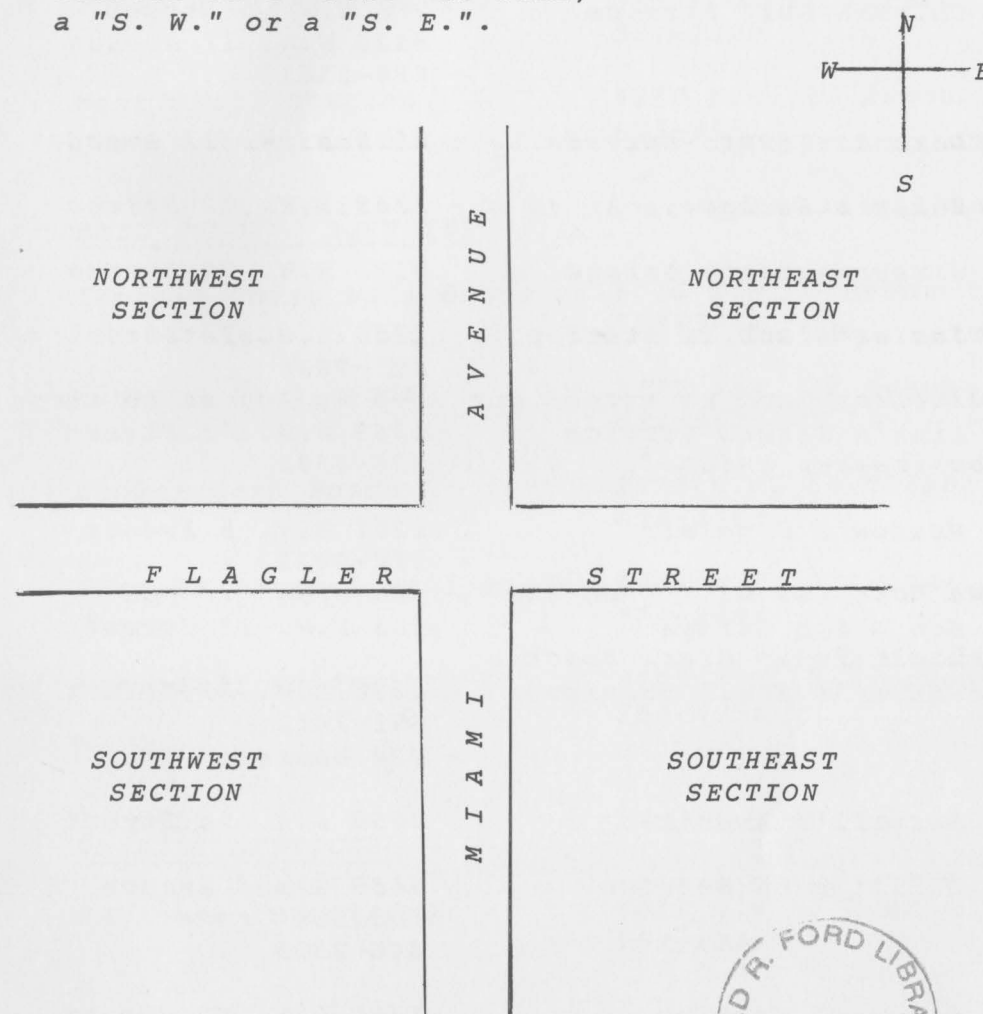
BLACK BUSINESSES (F.Y.I.)
