5. Mr. Scott at a dinner with an unidentified man and woman.
6. Another photograph at the same dinner, this time including the woman to the other side of Mr. Scott
7. Four 35 mm negatives apparently of dental work.
8. Unidentified group picture - all men except one woman.
9. Nixon White House photo 9708-04 (8/1/72) of President Nixon with Stan Scott and another Black man who is probably Robert J. Brown of the White House staff.
10. White House photo E211-09 (2/13/73) of Stan Scott standing outside the White House soon after he took over the position of Special Assistant to the President for Minority Affairs.
11. Mr. Scott shaking hands with an unidentified man, possibly Randall L. Woods, Assistant Administrator for Congressional and Public Affairs of the Small Business Administration. The cover letter transmitting the photo is from Mr. Woods and is dated 2/24/74.
12. White House photo A0753-20 (9/13/74) of Highland Park, MI Mayor Robert Blackwell and Mr. Scott conducting a press briefing.
13. White House photo A1173-06A (10/3/74) - color portrait of Mr. Scott.
14. White House photo A3801-04 (3/26/75) - participants in a Tuesday at the White House meeting on community health care.
15. Mr. Scott and unidentified individuals on the National Urban League "line-up" at Atlanta in July 1975.

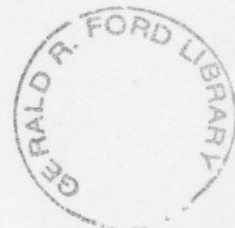
I think the photographer in New York who took
