Dear Mr. Tegmeier:

We have carefully examined the captioned application for financial assistance and regret that the business does not meet this Agency's definition of being a small business. The Small Business Administration policies and directives require that when determining if a business meets the size standard, we must take into consideration the gross sales of the applying business as well as affiliated businesses. Information in file and from other sources indicates that the Regal Cab Company, Inc. is an affiliate of the Regal Package Liquor, Inc. by a fifty percent common stock ownership of Mr. Charles Merritts, Sr. The combined sales of the two companies exceed this Agency's definition of being a small business.

During our review of the application, it was noted that most of the funds to be used for debt payment were to refinance debts to two banks and the National Cash Register Co. It appears that it would not be unrealistic for the applicant to approach these lenders regarding refinancing the debts over a reasonable maturity.

We also had difficulty determining how the business can be operated at a profit sufficient to repay the desired loan. The desired loan would require repayment at the rate of \$2,750 per month and the business has not demonstrated the ability to service this size of loan. The projected profit margin of 4.8 percent of sales is difficult to reconcile with a high of .66 percent of sales for fiscal year ending September 30, 1973.

I regret that we are unable to fit this loan request within the framework of our policy and authority.

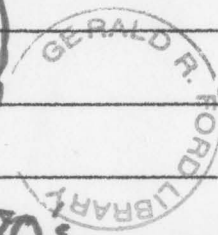

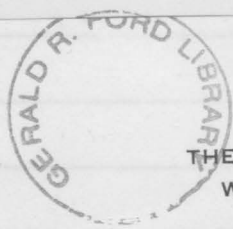
