George Henry Robinson converted to the Republican Party after the 1972 election while in pursuit of the SBA District Director's job in Baltimore, and following the urging of someone within SBA. He was not selected.

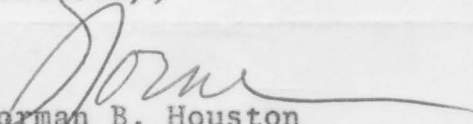
On behalf of our organization, I want to thank you and your associates for meeting with us on July 17.

Dear Barber:

As you know, I have long been working to expand the base of the Republican Party to include more blacks and minorities, and am an advocate of placing blacks in more "non-race related" positions within the administration.

It is apparent to me that President Ford has an excellent opportunity to do all of the above and at the same time restore the confidence of minorities in the Republican Party and to expand its base. I need not tell you that I often find myself in the position of defending the Party to minorities.

Therefore, and because of your leadership position in the House, and the fact that the President and his staff have and will continue in the future to seek your counsel, I am taking the liberty of setting forth those possible positions within the administration to which I feel the President and his staff should consider naming blacks--either directly or through his cabinet.

"Where Blacks Ought To Be In The Ford Administration"

1. Special Counsel to the President for Domestic Affairs, or
2. Assistant Counselor for Domestic Affairs
3. Deputy Director of the Federal Bureau of Prisons
4. Deputy Administrator or Assistant Administrator of LEAA
5. Deputy Administrator or Assistant Administrator of the Drug Enforcement Administration
6. Special Assistant to the Attorney General
7. Assistant Attorney General
8. Deputy Assistant Attorney General
(There has never really been a black in Justice with any meaningful position other than the Solicitor's Office to my knowledge).

9. Special Assistant to, Deputy Assistant Secretary, or Assistant Secretary of State
10. Special Assistant to, Deputy Assistant Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Treasury
11. Assistant Secretary of Agriculture
12. Commissioner of the regulatory agencies, e.g., ICC, FTC, SEC, etc.

This by no means is an all-inclusive list, however, it could be used as a starting point for talent searching (and talent is available) by the President's staff. Although the above mentioned positions did not include the top Cabinet posts, I am concentrating on those line positions which often can be just as important as the top job.

I hope that these suggestions from "your man in Scottsville" will be helpful to you and the President.

Enclosed I am sending you a copy of a speech to be given in Louisville to the Urban League Youth Banquet this week.
