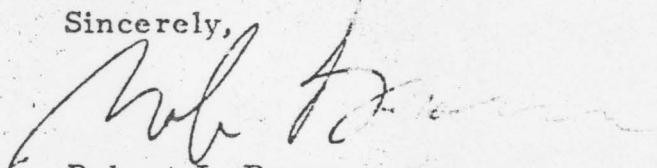
As I prepare to take my final leave of the White House Staff, I wanted to let you know how very deeply I have appreciated the support and assistance you have rendered to me over the past few years.

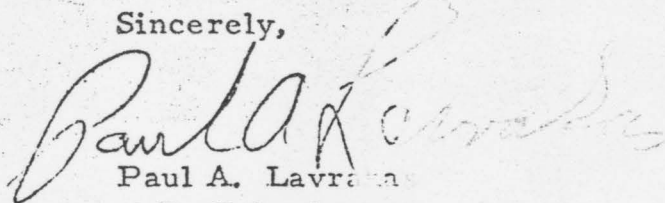

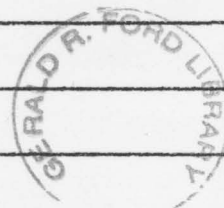
