Fred Rhodes advised me that under 42 USC 2031-32 the members of the AEC are appointed for staggered terms and that members have tenure for the term for which appointed. However, the law also provides that the President shall designate the Chairman from time to time at his pleasure and under this provision the President has the right to select a new Chairman whenever he wishes, without prejudice, however, to the right of the former Chairman to complete his term of office as a member.
