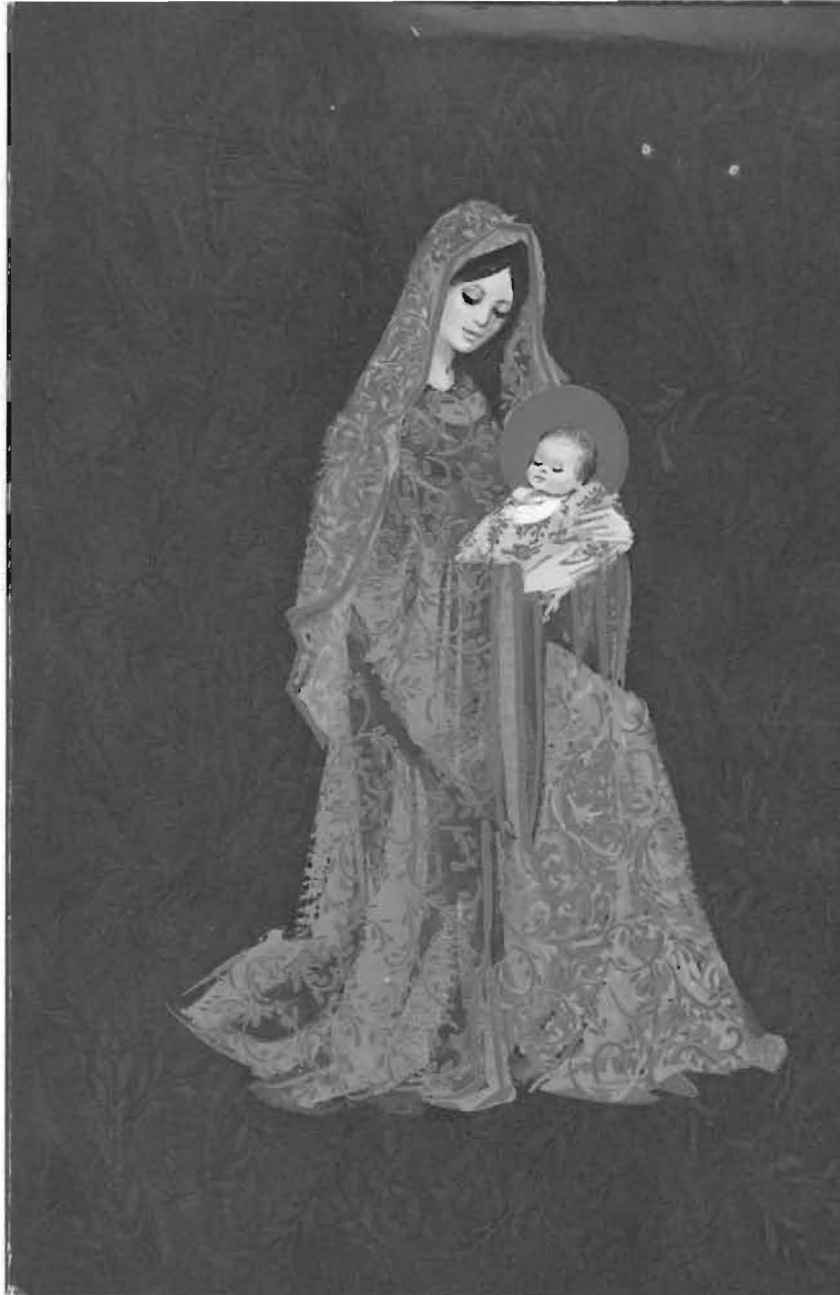

Flu's Been A Killer, But Worst to Come

ATLANTA, Ga. (AP)—Influenza is nothing to sneeze at. It can kill you.

Since major outbreaks were first reported for the week ending Dec. 7, a total of 3,504 influenza-pneumonia deaths have been reported from 122 cities which make up the National Communicable Disease Center's mortality reporting system.

This is 1608 more deaths than normally would have occurred in the fourth week period Dec. 1-28, according to the nation's epidemiologists.

The NCDC says the report from 122 cities is a barometer to determine the nation's mortality rate, but the number of actual deaths is somewhat greater.

For the fourth consecutive week, deaths from influenza and pneumonia mounted, but the NCDC says the epidemic is expected to reach its peak in another week or two.

The current epidemic involves a strain of Asian flu called Hong Kong flu because it was first isolated in Hong Kong. It differs from the Asian flu which made its appearance in the winter of 1957-58.

The epidemic this year is similar, in effect, to that of last year. But there are some major differences.

Dangerous Atom Fallout Reported By Utah Expert

SALT LAKE CITY (UPI)—A thorn in the Salt Lake Valley. University of Utah scientist said. However, Pendleton said further Wednesday that a weekend checking will show highest nuclear test by the Atomic Energy Commission in Nevada showered Utah with dangerous radioactivity.

Dr. Robert C. Pendleton, director of the university radiological health program, said radioactivity increased sharply Monday and Tuesday.

Pendleton said, "The people of Utah are once more being showered with radioactive materials, a very serious type of pollution which will remain with us for years to come. This was merely an engineering test and as such cannot be defended or justified as being vital to the national security."

Pendleton said there would not be any immediate hazard to the people and no contamination of the state's milk supply as in 1966, but the new radiation would be added on top of that already accumulated from past plumes.

The fallout was distributed in great spots of that from which, though the fall-out period of Utah with its nuclear tests was limited, however, falling from the sky.

Pendleton blasted earlier AEC reports that amounts of radiation released in Sunday's blast were "infinitesimal," calling them "gobbledy gook... the sort of thing they have been telling us since 1962."

He said "inhalation of these small, radioactive particles can be dangerous, possibly producing in the future lung cancer, lymph node carcinomas and possibly other malignant neoplasms."

Keep the booklet and read it whenever you feel that way. I only wish he was near enough so that I could attend his church.

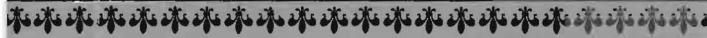

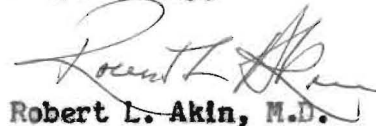

Re: Book: THE SECULAR MEANING OF THE GOSPEL by Paul M. Van Buren, MacMillan Co. N. Y. and London, 1963: paper copy \$1. 95. Van Buren a professor of theology at Temple University and consultant to the Detroit Mission; book helps those who do not believe in God to ~~adjust~~ adjust to the Christian Gospel. (pp. 82 - 84 etc.)

JESUS: an exceptionally free man: he made freedom contagious, meaning freedom from the past to pursue a new future: free from "familial claims": free from the need of status, etc. (pp 74, 121, 122 etc.) also, freedom from sin after Easter, the only listed sins being "fear, anxiety, mistrust, and self concern". (pp. 163, 164, 178)

EASTER THEOLOGY: authentic existence. (p. 74)

EMPIRICAL ATTITUDES AND EXISTENTIALISM: Empirical attitudes preferred, i.e.: learning through observation, experience, and experiment rather than under a system: empirical approach more suited to a secular and scientific and industrialized society. (pp. 5, 14, 76 etc.)

ANTI-COMMUNISM: error of Western Christians. (p. 196)

PATRIOTISM: love of a free country takes away from the gospel, i.e.- love of the freedom of Jesus. (p. 142.)

BLIK: a statement of faith or doctrine founded on truth. (pp. 85-91)

THE CHURCH: a building and an "odd sort of club": it has been cooperating in bringing the message of Jesus Christ to the world. (p. 184)
As described, the church seems to be an independent local church of which the members carry the message into the world. No mention of Church order: the local church would, apparently, be without ties of fellowship.

PREACHING: presenting a situation of the world and suggesting how it looks to "the eyes of faith" and, also, suggesting that if the "hearer" has the Christian historical perspective, he will see the problem in a certain way and act on it accordingly. (pp. 185, 186)

THE WILL OF GOD: an explanation of what we ought to do in the light of historical Christianity. (p. 187)

MISSION: Christian mission is not one of the church but of Christian man who has learned through Jesus to stand on his own feet without God and who is to love his neighbor but not convert him: the church, says the book, has talked too much to the world. (p. 191)

Question for us: In reaction to this book, what is the nature of our Christian involvement in the world?

ANSWER: Is it not to convert people to the true Christian faith embodying a belief in God and Jesus Christ with freedom of worship in a variety of churches differing in order and system so there may be freedom of expression of that faith; also, to encourage cooperation and fellowship among churches to carry out the work of the churches and to aid where the true gospel is accepted; also, to work out meaningful ~~and~~ terminology with a modern explanation of the true gospel and its application to the world?

Honorable Sir:

Since one of your recent TV appearances the word "priorities" has become a popular topic. I beg your permission to offer a few comments.

1. Budget. At the top of the list, #1 Priority - "We should itemize "Retirement of Debt". And then set the target. I would like to see a minimum of \$10 Billion, or as much as \$25 Billion, annually. At the bottom of the budget tabulation should appear in order of unimportance the items that can be lopped off; so that we come out with a balanced budget after writing off Item #1. This would do more to correct the 'balance-of-payments' and the 'money crises' than any other device. Now, will you please? Then establish this procedure for four years, yea for eight years and restore sanity to our fiscal policy. War, Peace, War, Peace, I want #1 to be retirement of debt and no excuses. There are billions in subsidies that should be eliminated, discontinued.

I have some other thoughts.

2. Crime. How to reverse this trend. The black people, 11% of the population commit 55% of the five major crimes. The U.S.A. should acquire a site in western Africa and establish there a Federal Penitentiary. The U.S.A. should pass legislation to permit or require deporting anyone guilty of any of the five major crimes; to that penitentiary. 5. Federal Aid to Schools. All the hell now in our colleges I can blame on to Federal Aid and sending 'scholars' in to our schools who should not be there. Our culture is being destroyed by "these people". I see it as a part of the conspiracy to destroy us from within. I had no such help in attending college fifty years ago and God knows I was worthy.

And now I am being taxed to send these shiftless scoundrels to college. Our cultural standards are being contaminated and degenerated by the influence of the Negro in our music, the dance, the arts, etc. etc.

6. The labor unions. These interests are injuring us oldsters. For Heaven's sake stop this increasing of wages more and more money for less and less work, raising hell with our competitive position in the world and drawing away the savings of us oldsters. I would like to see wages 'frozen' at \$5.00 per hour for every craft, every union, throughout the economy until we can get some sanity into our economy.

7. Welfare. Stop this subsidized bastardry. There was no welfare for my dear mother and seven children and God knows she was in need and worthy; and now I am being taxed to support those who refuse to work. From the Bible: those that do not work shall not eat.

8. Job Corps. Stop this costly drain on us tax-payers. Annual cost per student for this sub-standard education is enough to put a boy through four years of college. Ridiculous. The Job Corps for girls near Astoria, Oregon has been followed by a city-wide infestation of syphilis amongst the high school boys in Astoria.

9. Foreign Aid. Not one damned nickel in any year in which we have a budget deficit. e.g. If I had a cousin who was in need and each month I sent him a check for his grocery bill; then suddenly I found I could not pay my own grocery bill; would I still send him the monthly check? I pray that God will inspire, guard, guide and govern; sustain, protect and direct Richard Nixon and that he will listen. You are out last chance. Either you will get this nation back on the track or it is going down the drain. I am 71 and including social security have an income of less than \$3,000.00/yr.
