Dear Senator Jackson:

I am writing this to inform you that I do not approve of the appointment of Gov. Walter J. Hinkley as Secretary of Interior. I therefore request that you use your influence to prevent his appointment as Secretary of Interior.

We need a Secretary who realizes the need of Conservation in all of our varied natural resources.

His press conferences indicate that he has little comprehension of the basic meanings and purposes of Conservation.

During the past four years great progress has been made in Conservation. We want to see progress continue instead of retrogression in the future development of these areas.

From Gov. Hinkley's statements to the press we observe that he is opposed to Conservation such as Wilderness Areas and National Parks, unless multiple uses in the land in the Park is made possible. He fears that pollution control will damage industrial developments. He seeks the interest of oil Companies in Alaska and has recently made the Vice President of one large Texas Oil Co. Commissioner of Natural Resources of Alaska.

The "Oil Daily" has expressed satisfaction over Gov. Hinkel's appointment as Secretary of Interior and has stated he "deserves full industry, good will, and cooperation".

Does it appear logical that a man with such beliefs as we have noted here should be placed in Guardianship of all that is so rich and valuable to us?

I think not, and again regret that you do oppose the appointment of Gov. Walter J. Hinkel as Secretary of Interior.

Dear Sirs:

I am just an average American housewife and mother. I too seldom avail myself of the opportunity to voice my opinion in my government "of the people,...". Because I am motivated very deeply by recent history-making events, I do so at this time.

I am deeply, and reverently, proud of my American heritage. It is with humble gratitude that I thank God for the privilege of having been born in the greatest country on Earth. Four years ago, for the first time in my life, a long-saved-for vacation took me outside the boundaries of my native land. While traveling through parts of South America and the Caribbean, I was shaken to see an image of my beloved land which was shockingly poor. I came back home with a defensive attitude, ready to get on the nearest soapbox and try to open the eyes of the world concerning these, 'my' United States. With a new interest, I avidly watched the headlines and became more aware than ever that what I was reading at home was also being read abroad. I saw prayer taken out of the schools through the leadership of one atheistic woman. And, if this decision set a precedent for future action, then the Scriptures will probably be taken from outer space, because once again this woman's ugly mouth has been opened in protest. (Perhaps she should go along as a passenger on the next flight to the moon and be encouraged to remain there!) I have seen rulings made by the Supreme Court of the land, for which I sought understanding,.....but, could find none. As a result of these rulings, I have watched my wonderful country seemingly deteriorate before my very eyes. As the mother of three teen-agers, a growing concern has been building within my chest which has caused many a sleepless night. I have read articles on the malignant spread of Communism into all the nations of the Earth. I wept tears for the suffering of the Vietnamese people and terrible atrocities to which they have been subjected, especially before the intervention of the United States. I am proud of every boy who has set foot on foreign soil to say to the world, "I care!"

On Christmas Eve, 1968, I watched with prayerful wonder as three young American men explored the mysteries of outer space. I thought of the genius, the technical know-how, the dedication which put them there,.....and, I was proud! Then, coming to my ears from the lips of these three young American men 200,000 miles out in space, were the familiar words of the creation as told in the Book of Genesis in the Holy Bible. Men? Yes, real men!!! For it takes a man to unashamedly stand up for his faith in God in this seemingly Godless day and age. I looked at the face of my young fourteen-year-old son as he watched and listened, and my eyes brimmed with tears. I thought of all the other young men in our country watching and I wanted to shout, "These are men, kids! These are real men!" I pictured the broken and weary people behind the Iron and Bamboo Curtains, and thought, "Thank God, here's hope for them! They know that God is not dead in the heart of all men!" I felt certain at that moment that the mission would be a success, for surely God would bless these young men with a safe trip home.

This was, to me, the most miraculous and touching television broadcast ever to be telecast, especially when T.V. programming has become so violent, obscene

and lewd that program selection for the average family viewing has become a real problem. In the name and guise of "art", uncensored reading materials, movies, television programs, the theater, etc., are tearing down the moral, law-abiding, reverent and respectful approach to life by young and old Americans at a fast pace. I think the theater advertisement page of my local paper could be cited as lewd and not even fit "for adult viewing only". When the common monthly magazines to which I unwisely subscribed are delivered I must turn them "cover down" on the table, for their covers often aren't decent for displayal on the living room table.

However, in the face of discouragement and fear, on December 24, 1968, came renewed faith! For me, I'm sure there will never be another Christmas Eve like it. Never will I hear the creation story without a tearful recollection of the Christmas Eve when those beautiful words came to the whole world from outer space.

God bless you, Astronauts Borman, Lovell and Anders. And thank you for the hope you restored in the heart of one American mother. I shall be praying to a God who is not dead for my Country, its leaders, and all the other men who dedicate themselves to serve in the name of freedom around this world and wherever else it takes them.

As long as America stays "one Nation, under God,.....", -- as long as its leaders look to a sovereign Deity for wisdom and guidance, -- I'm sure there is hope for mankind!

"For the wages of sin is death,"

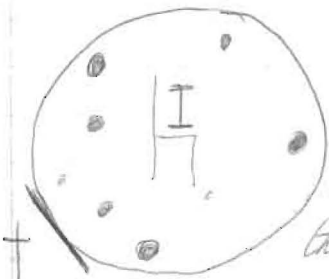

that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us." Corresponding to this is John 14:6: "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father but by me."

Just believing that Christ is the only means of salvation, however, is not enough. You must confess your sins to God and turn away from them and ask God to forgive you for committing them. Acts 3:19 says: "Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out,". I John 1:9 also says: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

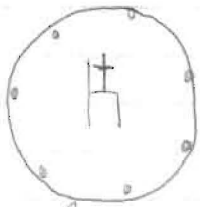
After you repent of your sins and ask for forgiveness, you must receive Christ as your Saviour and Lord by personal invitation. This means that you let Christ have command of your life. In this first picture the circle represents your heart. Inside you are sitting on the throne running things your way. You may be putting too much stress on some things and not enough on others, thus making your life unbalanced. It may be that your church life has been affected and it's become nothing more than a mere social function. I hope you can block his appointment and encourage the selection of a vigorous advocate of protection for what remains of our priceless natural environment.

I want to thank you also for your recent efforts to preserve the Fort Lawton site for public recreation purposes.

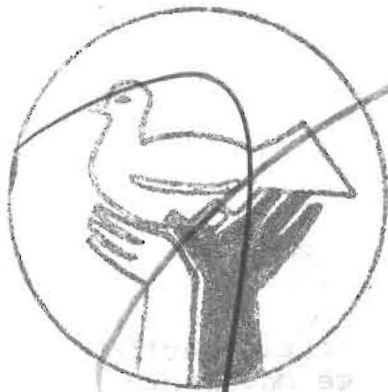

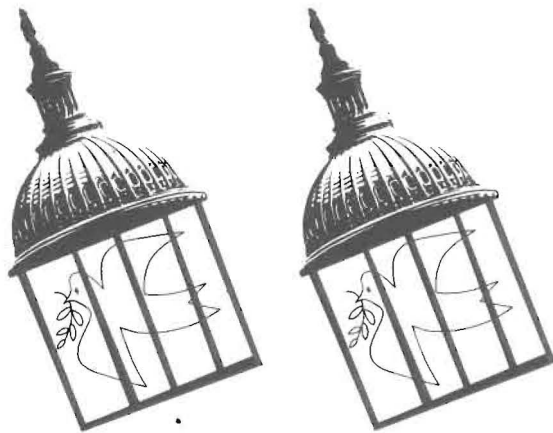

I wish to add my voice to those who oppose confirmation of Walter O. Hickel as Secretary of Interior.

From statements Mr. Hickel has made, and which he may now try to gloss over, he does not have a very high regard for the efforts of conservationists to preserve what belongs to all the people for all the people, such as the wilderness and national parks, from exploitation by and for certain powerful special interests.

Also, it is my understanding that as Governor of Alaska, Mr. Hickel simply brushed aside the problems of Indians and Eskimos. Could this be because they may have some claim to the lands the oil interests are intending to exploit? Reportedly, Mr. Hickel was actually recommended to Mr. Nixon by Robert O. Anderson, head of Atlantic-Richfield Oil Company, which is one of the oil companies having its tentacles now groping and grasping for the riches of the Alaskan oil regions. Could there be another "Fall Scandal" in the making if this man is appointed Secretary of Interior?

Another, rather unrelated subject about which I feel strongly, is the protection of increasingly scarce wildlife, such as the polar bears and mountain goats which are being ruthlessly hunted down by hunters in airplanes.

READ ALL ABOUT THE JEWS NEW STOGE PEOPLE

TEDDY KENNEDY in his last desperate appeal to the voters of Massachusetts before the election levelled an attack at Gerald L. K. Smith. He is among the cunning politicians who realize that the center of gravity and the balance of power has shifted from the ghettos to the great mainstream of real people, personified by George Wallace, Gerald Smith, etc.

GEORGE WALLACE may be more powerful today than if he had become the President of the United States. If he had won the presidency, the conspirators of the Establishment all over the world would have moved in to sabotage his regime, create a money panic and take other steps designed to bring about his hoped-for impeachment. As it now stands, Mr. Wallace personifies that group of American citizens that might well be referred to as the balance of power. It is estimated that beyond the ten million votes he received there were some five to ten million votes that were cast for Nixon, because in the last two days they panicked for fear Humphrey might win. Every mature commentator who is free from the propaganda tyranny of the Establishment insists that Nixon in order to fulfill his promises to the people must co-operate with the George Wallace element, and this represents not less than fifty million people. The center of political gravity is no longer in the ghettos or the slums. It is in the hearts of the mainstream of "regular folks" personified and symbolized by the Wallace vote. A recent survey reveals that a high percentage of the Nixon voters liked George Wallace. They were afraid to vote for Wallace for fear they would divide the opposition's vote and put the ghetto tyrants back in power for another four years.

DR. CHARLES WILLIE, chairman of the Department of Sociology at Syracuse University, recently said: "Student riots are a sign of progress." He made this statement to 500 educators attending the 53rd annual conference of the National University Extension Association. The delegates represented 134 major colleges. **Note:** This is a mere sample of the lunacy which has now infected the American campus.

DR. J. DONALD PHILLIPS, President of Hillsdale College in Michigan, recently issued an ultimatum, saying: "Any student interfering with the normal functioning of this school will face suspension and expulsion." Continuing, he said: "We refuse to recognize anarchy as a solution for any problem regardless of what the problem is."

J. EDGAR HOOVER, has prophesied that there will be much rioting and revolutionary organization on the American college and university campus this year. The whole project has been organized by hidden hand Communists.

RICHARD NIXON, who was chosen as the Republican candidate for the American Presidential election

at the Party's Miami Convention has paid a visit to Israel in each of the last two years. His message to the American Israel Public Affairs Committee during his campaign in May was unequivocal. He said that America must see to it that Israel's military strength "is never at a level vis-a-vis the Arab militants that it will invite a war of revenge." In June last year, when he arrived in Israel soon after the Six-Day War, Mr. Nixon declared that Israel could not be expected to withdraw from the territories which were previously bases of aggression against her until a settlement was reached.

LYNDON B. JOHNSON, when he retires from the White House, will go down in history as one of the most repudiated presidents ever to have lived. It will be remembered that the vice-president under Abraham Lincoln barely escaped impeachment and if the election had not come this Fall and the presidential term had had another two years to run, there is no doubt but that impeachment proceedings would have started against LBJ. The irresponsible elements including the slum votes and the Jews for whom he did the most, have cursed him even as much or more than his normal political enemies.

REPRESENTATIVE OTTO PASSMAN of Louisiana, reminded Congress that Cicero advised the politicians of Rome 2,000 years ago: "The budget should be balanced, the Treasury should be refilled, the public debt should be reduced, the arrogance of officialdom should be tempered and controlled. Assistance to foreign lands should be curtailed lest Rome become bankrupt. The mob should be forced to work and not depend on government for subsistence." Rome, Mr. Passman noted, didn't take that advice and fell.

DR. AUSTIN J. APP is one of the significant personalities in the realm of historical research. He has devoted much of his time in producing literature and documented material concerning the attempts of the international Jews and others to liquidate the entire German race. He recently resigned as professor at LaSalle College in order to devote full time to his writing and research.

HUEY NEWTON, the Black Panther, killed a policeman in Oakland and was let off with a two year sentence. What goes on in this country?

STOKELY CARMICHAEL, the Black Power revolutionist recently addressed 300 students. He said, "We will become the fifth column of America. They cannot stop us."

EUGENE McCARTHY is being considered for the Presidency of Columbia University. The image of this historic school has been destroyed because they have allowed the rioters and radicals to determine its policy and force the resignation of its President.

ARTHUR GOLDBERG has now been made the President of the American Jewish Committee, the most powerful committee of Jews in the world. Rich, ruth-

9/52 — You take office one week from today at which time you will address us when you have the nation's ear. I read that the theme of your administration will be taken from the placard held by the young girl from Ohio in the campaign — "Bring us Together" — and you will doubtless develop the thought in your inaugural speech.

The thought expressed in the slogan is a good one, but it is appropriate as an expression, in prayer, by Christians of their dependent worship of God. It is addressed to God. Perhaps it is foremost of what is in the hearts of a congregation in Church. It should not be addressed to a President.

Americans should not look to you, nor to your administration, to be brought together. Only the Lord can do this.

But to be united by God, we must abide by His principles and teachings, and we must have faith. You must remind us of this, and I pray that you do so in your speech. Perhaps your administration's theme could be dedicated to the re-discovery of proper first principles so that God can bring us

together and inspire us to go forward in His light.

"Bring us some principles" could be the note. Those who heed the call will be brought together. Those who don't will be shown of their sheep's clothing for all to see.

Somehow I am reminded of Whitaker Chambers' description in Witness of the irreconcilable conflict between the "Kingdom of Man" (Communism, humanism etc.) and the "Kingdom of God". Mr. Nixon, we can't all be brought together (any more than we could all "reason" together in the recent past) but we can all be witnesses to the healing example of your articulated dedication to God's First Principles.
