MEMORANDUM

While we were in San Clemente Sheldon Beeson called to say that he would like to let the President know about the voluntary integration school busing plan they had at the school where he taught in Long Beach. He said parents in the ghetto could send their children by public transportation to any of the outlying schools, and his all-white school had 45 blacks out of 550 students. The people in the area accepted the children into the school and the program met all the qualifications that are set up under the Civil Rights Act.

He said he wanted to help the President as much as he could and he felt busing was the number one issue.

I wonder if you would be good enough to get in touch with him and let him know how much the President appreciates his support and ideas -- perhaps there is someone at the Committee he could be working with.
