In compliance with your request of Thursday, February 13, the report on the President's foreign travel since 1947 is submitted.

Please note the statistics for Mexico and Canada. Rather than specify the dates upon which visits were made to these countries, the explanatory note "On Numerous Occasions" was inserted. This was done for two reasons:

1. The visits to these two countries which are contiguous to the United States are numerous and many specific visits are unrecorded. To list any specific number would result in a restrictive figure.
2. In view of the fact that these lists of foreign countries visited might be given to the Press, and in view of one or two recent editorials somewhat critical of the President for failing to pay the ritual first visit to neighboring Canada, I felt it better to suggest on the list that Canada and Mexico are areas that the President has visited frequently.

HOUSE GROUP HERE DRIFT ON WAY TO EUROPE

Geneva Herter Predicts Its Findings
Will Be Base for U. S. Grant
for Marshall Plan

Warning within the orbit of the Marshall Plan will be based in all likelihood on the recommendations to Congress by a nineteen-member special House Committee on Foreign Aid, its acting chairman asserted here yesterday.

On the eve of the group's departure for Southampton aboard the Queen Mary, Representative Christian A. Herter, Republican of Massachusetts, declared its purpose was to implement the Marshall policy for Europe's economic rehabilitation. It will be difficult, he said in an interview, to prevent political considerations from influencing the committee's ultimate decisions.

He stressed, however, the hope that the members of the committee would retain an "open mind" in their investigations. The growing importance of the economic side of our foreign affairs, he explained, necessitates initiative by the House, where the bills of expenditure must originate.

Mr. Herter, who toured eastern Europe in 1945 in a liaison capacity for the State Department, the Department of Agriculture and United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration, emphasized the "terrific seriousness" of the situation. The forty-five-day inquiry in fifteen countries does not constitute a junket, he said. Divided into five subcommittees, the group will seek to determine which agencies here are best suited to cope with Europe's economic problems.

Representative Charles A. Eaton, veteran New Jersey legislator and titular chairman of the committee, said he would not accompany his colleagues, as he preferred to keep an eye on developments here. He declared that upon the committee's return, he would report on the economic hopes.

After a survey of the Krupp Works and coal mines in Essen, Germany, the whole committee is slated to arrive in Frankfurt on the Main Sept. 6, where it will split up.

Subcommittee headquarters will be established thereafter in London, Frankfurt, Paris and Rome, while the agriculture subcommittee will keep on the move through a dozen countries. Among the countries that will be inspected by various House members are England, Germany, Austria, Czechoslovakia, France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Italy, Trieste, Greece, Norway, Denmark, Sweden, Poland and Luxembourg.

Mr. Herter said the group would not attempt to travel in countries behind the "iron curtain" and would make only courtesy diplomatic calls in Warsaw and Prague. He joined with Mr. Eaton in deploring the political developments in Czechoslovakia.

House body, the acting chairman said, probably will hold no formal hearings, but undoubtedly will discuss with an assortment of officials the economic needs, the extent of possible future loan negotiations, currency reforms, coal and the industrial situation.

Of outstanding importance, he added, will be efforts to solve the British and German economic status.

By resolution of the House, the committee is authorized to study actual and prospective needs of foreign nations and peoples, including those within United States military zones, both for relief in terms of food, clothing and the like and of economic rehabilitation. Its report to the House is due not later than March 1, 1948. The general European situation, as Mr. Herter pointed out, perhaps will be

employed in different localities. It held an executive session and private dinner yesterday in the Biltmore Hotel.

SUBMARINES GO UNDER ICE

Navy Reveals Maneuvers in Arctic Circle Off Alaska

JUNEAU, Alaska, Aug. 26 (UP) —A five-unit submarine task force has been engaging in maneuvers under the solid ice pack off the Alaska coast in the Arctic Circle between the United States and Russian territory, the Navy revealed today.

The fleet, including the submarines Boarfish, Caiman, Chub and Cabezon and the tender Nereus, is bound for Vancouver, B. C., the Navy said.

Capt. L. H. Chappell, commander of the task fleet, described the maneuvers, held west of Point Barrow, as "routine" and declared he had no knowledge of purported Navy Department concern over the number, type and disposition of the Soviet submarine fleet.

The fleet flagship, the Boarfish, went three or four miles under the ice, Captain Chappell reported.
