### Bob Jones 'Fine' After Light Attack

ATLANTA, Mar. 29 (AP).— Bobby Jones was in a hospital today, being treated for what may have been a minor heart attack.

His physician said the famous golfer was doing fine, but would be kept under observation at Emory Hospital for a few days.

"We are presuming that he may have had a minor heart attack until proved otherwise," the physician said.

Jones, 56, suffered what was described as a circulatory collapse shortly before midnight last night at his home. His blood pressure dropped but there was no pain, the doctor said.
