Mi Gobierno desea aclarar su posición respecto a los vuelos de la Cruz Roja Internacional a Biafra y deshacer los equívocos que hayan podido producirse, como consecuencia de una campaña tendenciosa de un sector interesado de la prensa internacional, que ha procurado desfigurar los hechos para soliviantar a la opinión pública.

En primer lugar, quiero hacer constar que tales vuelos no han sido prohibidos con carácter absoluto, ni tan sólo poco suspendidos temporal o indefinidamente. Eso sí, se ha indicado con firmeza a los representantes de la Cruz Roja Internacional que los servicios habrán de ser diurnos y en ningún caso nocturnos, según estaba estipulado, con la finalidad de poder ejercer un control efectivo que salvaguarde la responsabilidad de este Gobierno.

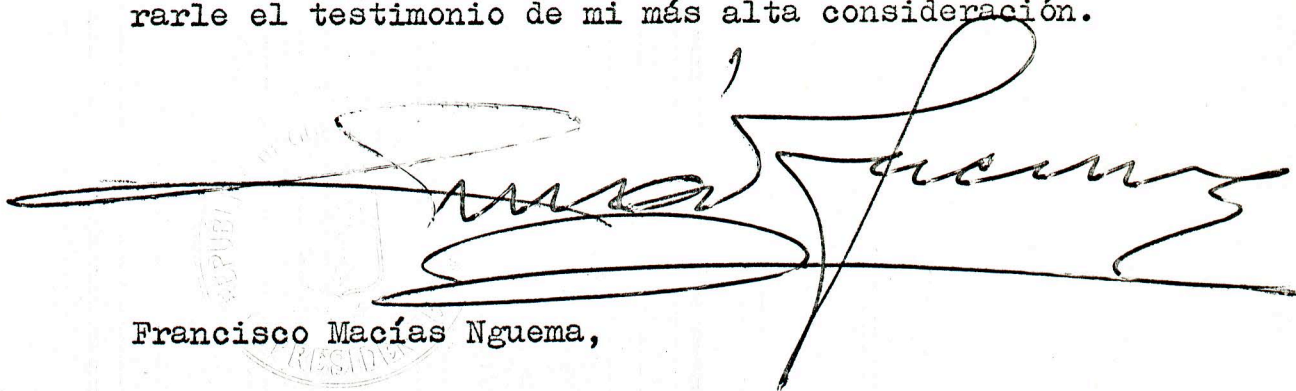
Deseo, por otra parte, dejar bien deslindada la posición política de la República de Guinea Ecuatorial respecto al conflicto armado nigeriano y su actitud humanitaria en favor de los niños, mujeres y ancianos, víctimas inocentes de la conflagración. Precisamente en esta doble consideración están inspiradas las medidas adoptadas, que pretend

parte mi Gobierno desea permanecer al margen del conflicto, dentro de las directrices de la Organización de la Unidad - Africana, y por ello trata de evitar el riesgo de que con - el pretexto de la ayuda se efectúen eventuales suministros de materiales estratégicos o de valor militar, que sirvan - para prolongar la lucha. Por otra, es también nuestro propó - sito facilitar al máximo la misión humanitaria de la Cruz - Roja Internacional, manteniéndola dentro de sus estrictos - límites caritativos, para el abastecimiento de la población civil que sufre las consecuencias de la guerra.

Aprovecho la ocasión, Señor Presidente, para reite - rarle el testimonio de mi más alta consideración.

The enclosed letter to the President from President Macias of Equatorial Guinea was apparently received several weeks after its dispatch, and its contents have been overtaken by events. The Government of Equatorial Guinea in March permitted the resumption of ICRC relief flights to Biafra, and these are proceeding normally at present. This subject was covered in the letter of January 26 to President Macias from the Secretary, so no reply to the enclosure is recommended.
