DOROTHY DUKE, H. R. ^xCRAWFORD AND
THE NATIONAL HOUSING CENTER

Dorothy Duke, who is a Republican woman of some energy, came to me awhile back to talk about things at HUD in general and about the National Center for Housing Management in particular, of which she is a member of the Board. She is also a supporter of Gloria Toote, which should be of some interest to you. Evidently, Gloria and H. R. 's fued has gotten out into the real world and in the process Dorothy Duke has taken up the cudgel for Gloria. Nevertheless, she claims that H. R. has set out to destroy the Center for Housing Management. I don't know how true that is but she claims that HUD is cutting off their money, that their development grants have been constrained and that what they would really like to do is get out from under the HUD budget completely.

I don't know how much truth there is in all of this, but you might do some nosing around on the subject. She has asked me if I would like to have a briefing and I told her to set it up. I'd like you to come when they have it. It might be of some interest just to find out what this thing is all about.
